GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tied directly to canal wall — no tender needed

Best For: History fans, day cyclists, German small-town atmosphere

Walk to center: ~10–15 min (800 m) from pier to Marktplatz

Don't Miss: Jerichow Monastery — one of Germany's oldest Romanesque brick buildings

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Jerichow Monastery** — Founded in 1144, Kloster Jerichow is one of the oldest and most significant Romanesque brick buildings in northern...
- **Persil Town Walk & Kreismuseum** — Genthin built its identity around Henkel's Persil factory.
- **Elbe-Havel Canal Cycling** — Germany's flat canal-side cycling paths are excellent around Genthin.
- **Water Tower & Town Center Stroll** — The 48-metre brick Wasserturm (built 1935) is Genthin's defining landmark.

BEST WALKS

- **Canal Quay to Marktplatz** 1.5 km round trip · 25–35 min · Easy — Walk south from the ship along Jerichower Straße, past the Water Tower park, to the central Marktplatz.
- **Canal Towpath North** 2–6 km one-way · 30–90 min · Easy/flat — Follow the canal towpath northward from the dock for as far as your time allows.

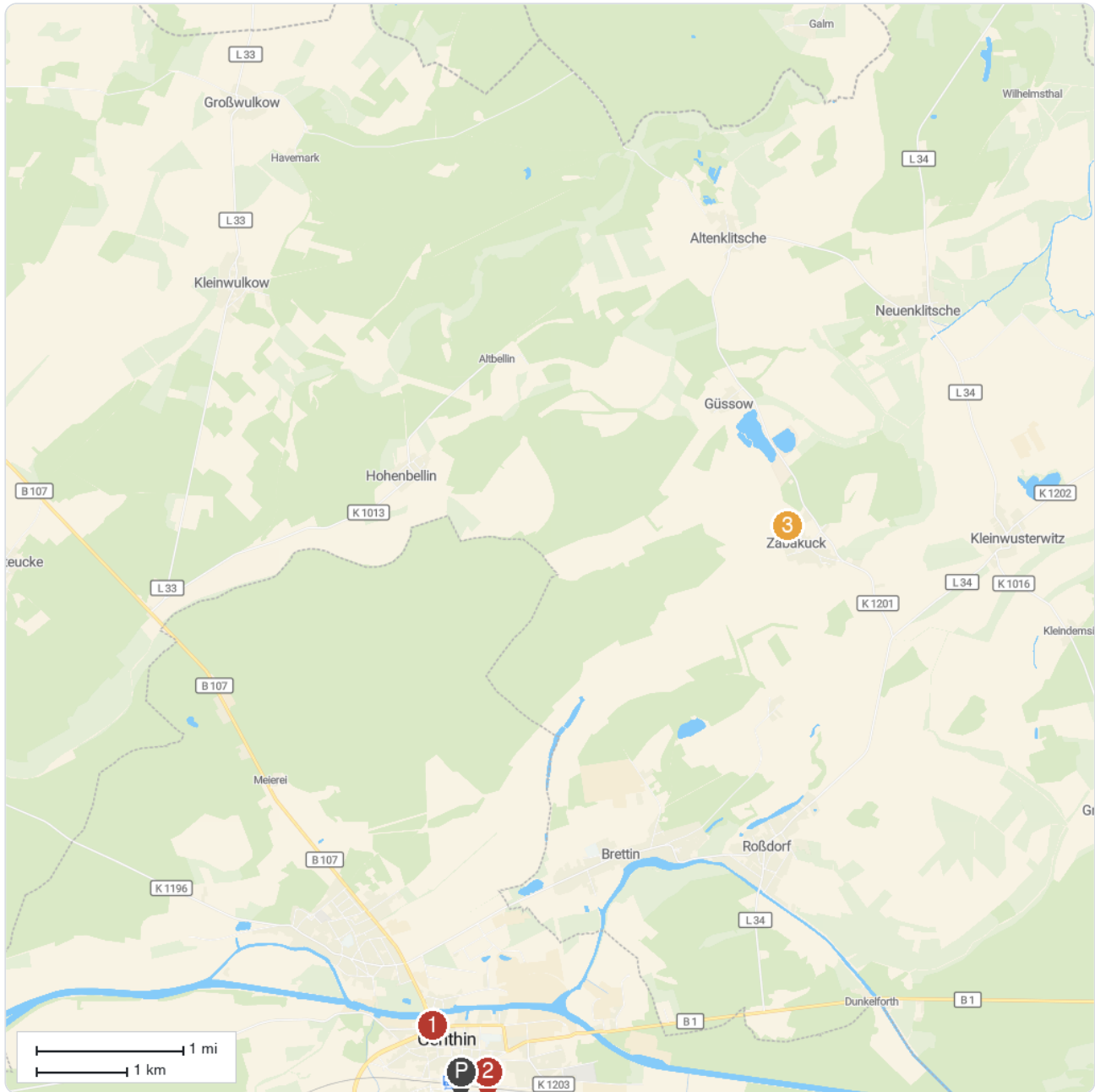
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Bring cash. Small Saxony-Anhalt towns still run mostly on Euros — many bakeries, cafés, and the museum won't take cards.
- Pre-book taxis. Genthin has few taxis on call. For Jerichow Monastery or Zabakuck Lake, ask the ship reception to arrange a cab in advance.
- Asparagus season (April–June). The region is famous for fresh white Spargel — order it with Hollandaise, potatoes, and ham at any local restaurant.
