GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Docked at Berth 4, Geraldton Port (active commercial harbour — no pedestrian access through port)

Best For: History buffs, beach walkers, seafood lovers, scenic flight to Abrolhos Islands

Walk to centre: Free shuttle bus to CBD (5–10 min); city centre then flat and walkable

Don't Miss: HMAS Sydney II Memorial & Museum of Geraldton (Dutch shipwrecks — both free)

- **HMAS Sydney II Memorial & Museum of Geraldton** — Two must-dos, both free.
- **St Francis Xavier Cathedral & Monsignor Hawes Trail** — A striking striped Romanesque-Spanish cathedral designed by priest-architect Monsignor Hawes — one of the most unusual...
- **Abrolhos Islands Scenic Flight** — The Houtman Abrolhos are 122 low-lying islands ringed by coral reefs — the site of the 1629 Batavia wreck and home to...
- **Town Beach & Foreshore Walk** — Champion Bay (Town Beach) sits right next to the CBD drop-off — calm, sheltered waters good for a swim, with a...
- **Western Rock Lobster Lunch** — Geraldton sits at the heart of WA's western rock lobster ("crayfish") industry — Australia's most valuable...

BEST WALKS

- **Foreshore & Museum Loop** 2.5 km · 40–60 min · Easy — From the shuttle drop-off at Marine Terrace, walk north along the foreshore boardwalk past Town Beach, continuing to the Museum of...
- **Mount Scott Memorial Walk** 3 km return · 50–70 min · Moderate (uphill) — From the Cathedral, head up Hermitage Road to Mount Scott for the HMAS Sydney II Memorial and sweeping 360-degree views over the city...

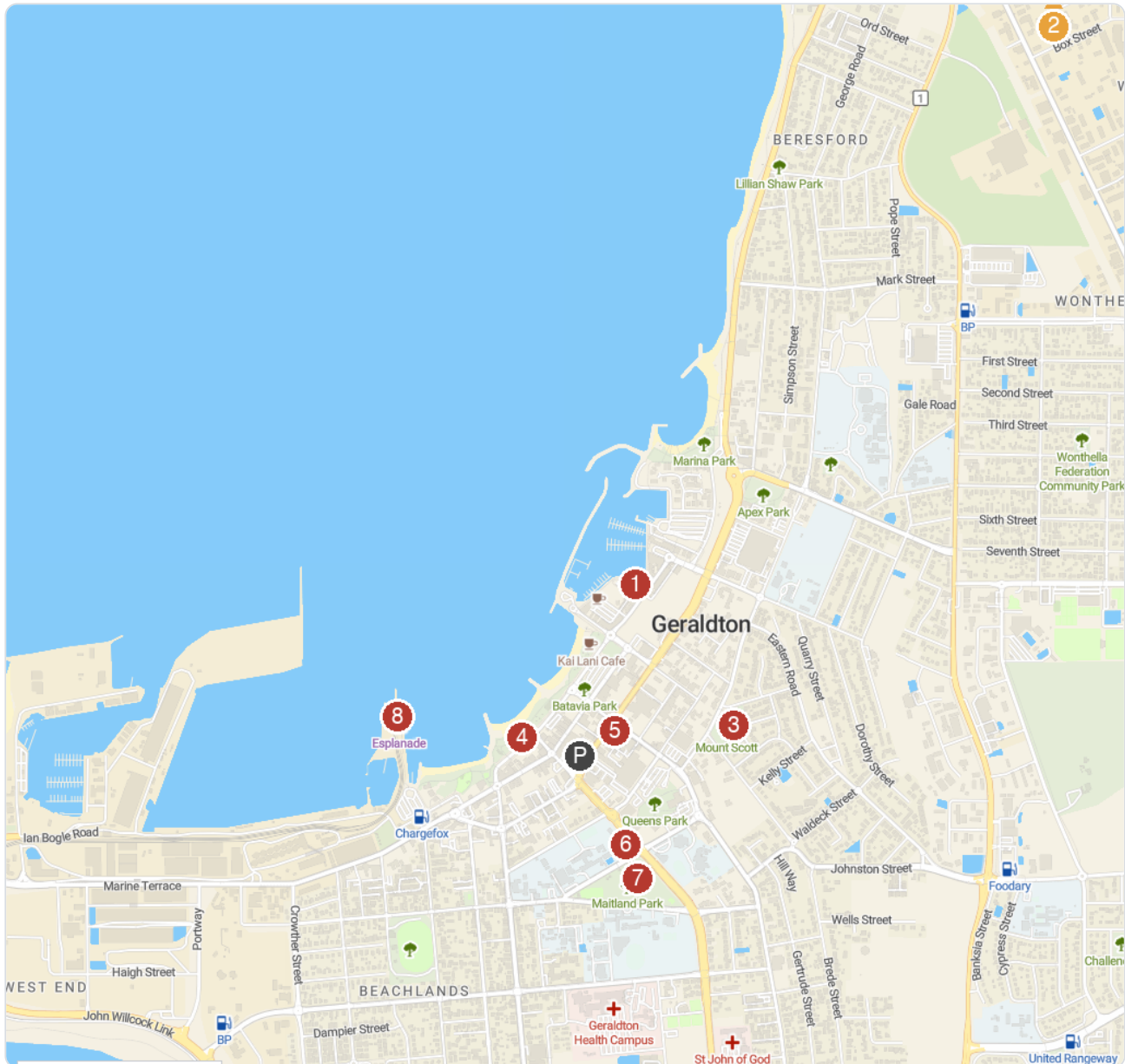
