GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — river cruise ships berth at the Grootdok (Rigakaai) quay; no tendering

Best For: Medieval architecture, the Ghent Altarpiece, canal boat tours, Belgian beer & frites

Walk to centre: Berth is ~1.5-2 km north of the historic core; most lines run a free shuttle, or take Tram 4 to Korenmarkt

Don't Miss: The three-tower view from Sint-Michielsbrug and a cuberdon candy from Groentenmarkt stalls

Getting around: **Taxi** ✓ €25–€30 · **Rideshare** ✓ Uber, Bolt

TOP THINGS TO DO

- The Ghent Altarpiece & St. Bavo's Cathedral** — The Van Eyck brothers' 1432 masterpiece — the most-stolen painting in history — is now displayed in a state-of-the-art...
- Gravensteen Castle** — A hulking 10th-century castle complete with moat, battlements, and a famously hilarious audio guide.
- Canal Boat Tour** — A 40-50 minute guided boat ride along the Leie gives you Graslei's guildhalls, the Gravensteen, and the medieval...
- Belgian Food & Beer Tasting** — Sample Gentse Waterzooi (creamy chicken stew), double-fried frites from Frituur Jozef, and a Gruut herb beer brewed in...
- Ghent Belfry (Belfort)** — This 91-metre UNESCO World Heritage tower anchors Ghent's skyline.

BEST WALKS

- Ghent Medieval Highlights Loop** ⌚ 2-3 hrs · 📏 ~4 km · 🚶 Easy — flat cobblestones · 🏰 Three-tower view included — From the shuttle drop-off (or Korenmarkt tram stop) head to Graslei, cross to Korenlei for the guildhall view, continue to Gravensteen...
- Patershol & Street Art Stroll** ⌚ 1-1.5 hrs · 📏 ~2 km · 🏡 Atmospheric lanes · 🎨 Street art — From Gravensteen, duck into the cobblestone alleys of Patershol for lunch or a Belgian beer, then cut south to Werregarenstraat...

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

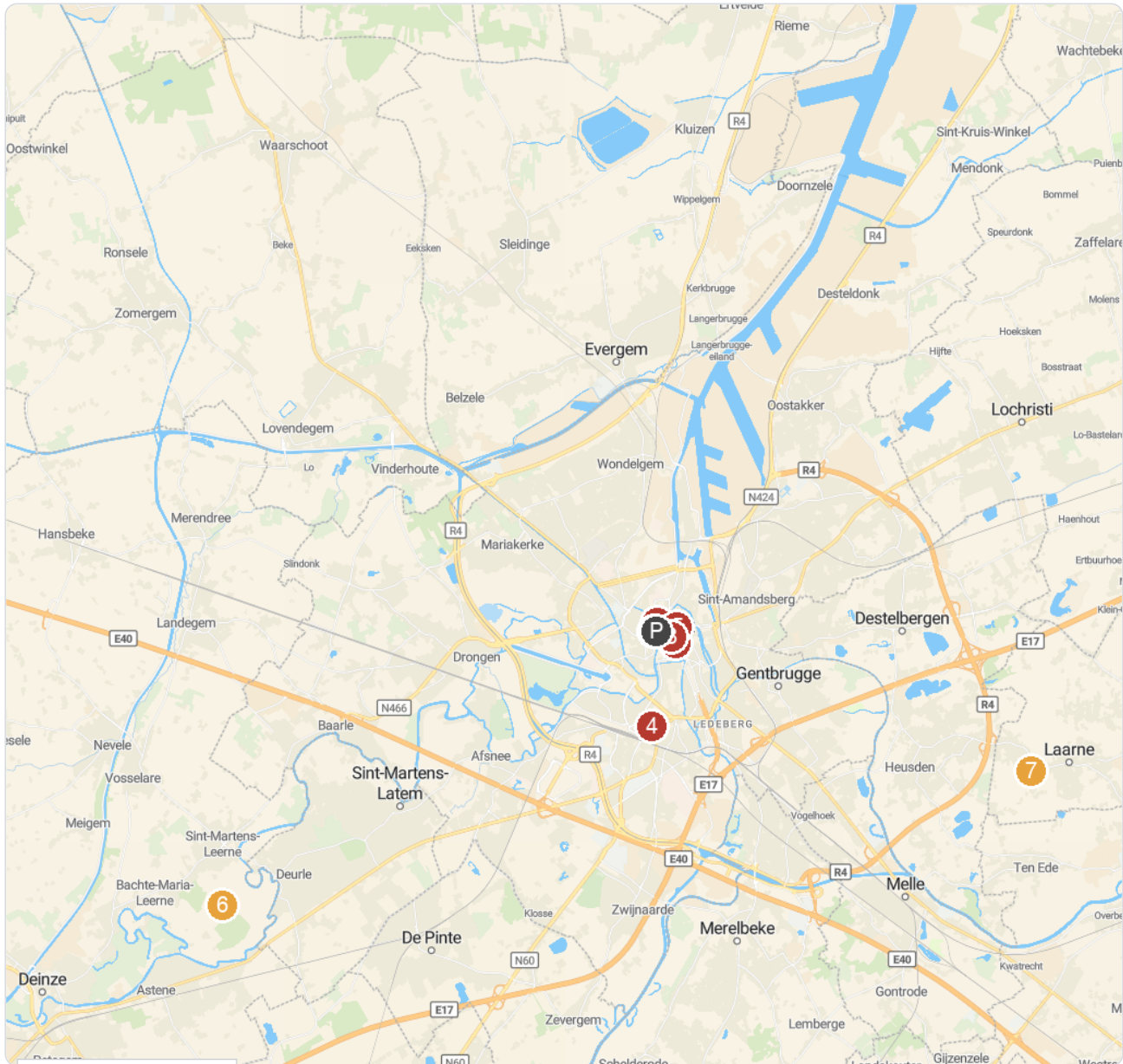
- Watch the bike lanes. Ghent's centre is car-free but bikes move fast. Never stand or walk in the red-marked cycle lanes — they are not pedestrian space.

Buy Cuberdons at Groentenmarkt. These purple cone-shaped 'Ghent Noses' — raspberry flavoured hard outside, gooey inside
