

Giardini Naxos-Taormina, Sicily, Italy

Ships anchor in the shadow of Mount Etna while passengers tender ashore to a dual destination: the sun-soaked Greek colony at sea level and the impossibly photogenic clifftop town of Taormina looming 200 metres above.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor in Bay of Naxos; 10–15 min boat ride to shore

Best For: Ancient ruins, clifftop views, beaches, Sicilian food & wine

Walk to center: 5 min to Giardini Naxos waterfront; Taormina requires bus or taxi (30 min)

Don't Miss: Teatro Antico di Taormina at sunrise before the tour buses arrive

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Teatro Antico di Taormina** — One of the world's most dramatic ancient theaters: 3rd-century BC Greek-Roman ruins framing a natural backdrop of the...
 - **Isola Bella Marine Reserve** — A tear-shaped island connected to the mainland by a narrow pebbly spit — submerged at high tide.
- **Giardini Naxos Archaeological Park** — Walk among ruins of Sicily's first Greek colony (734 BC) on the Capo Schisò peninsula — just 15 minutes on foot from...
 - **Corso Umberto & Piazza IX Aprile, Taormina** — Taormina's pedestrian main street is lined with luxury boutiques, pastry shops, and café terraces.
 - **Giardini Naxos Beach Day** — Fine sand and gravel beaches stretch right from the tender pier.

BEST WALKS

- **Giardini Naxos Waterfront to Archaeological Park** 1.2 km · 15 min · Flat — From the tender pier head south along the waterfront promenade past the Nike sculpture to the Capo Schisò peninsula and the entrance...
- **Taormina Old Town: Duomo to Greek Theater** 0.9 km · 20 min · Hilly cobblestones — Start at the Taormina bus terminal, walk Corso Umberto past the Duomo and Piazza IX Aprile balcony, then continue uphill to the Teatro...

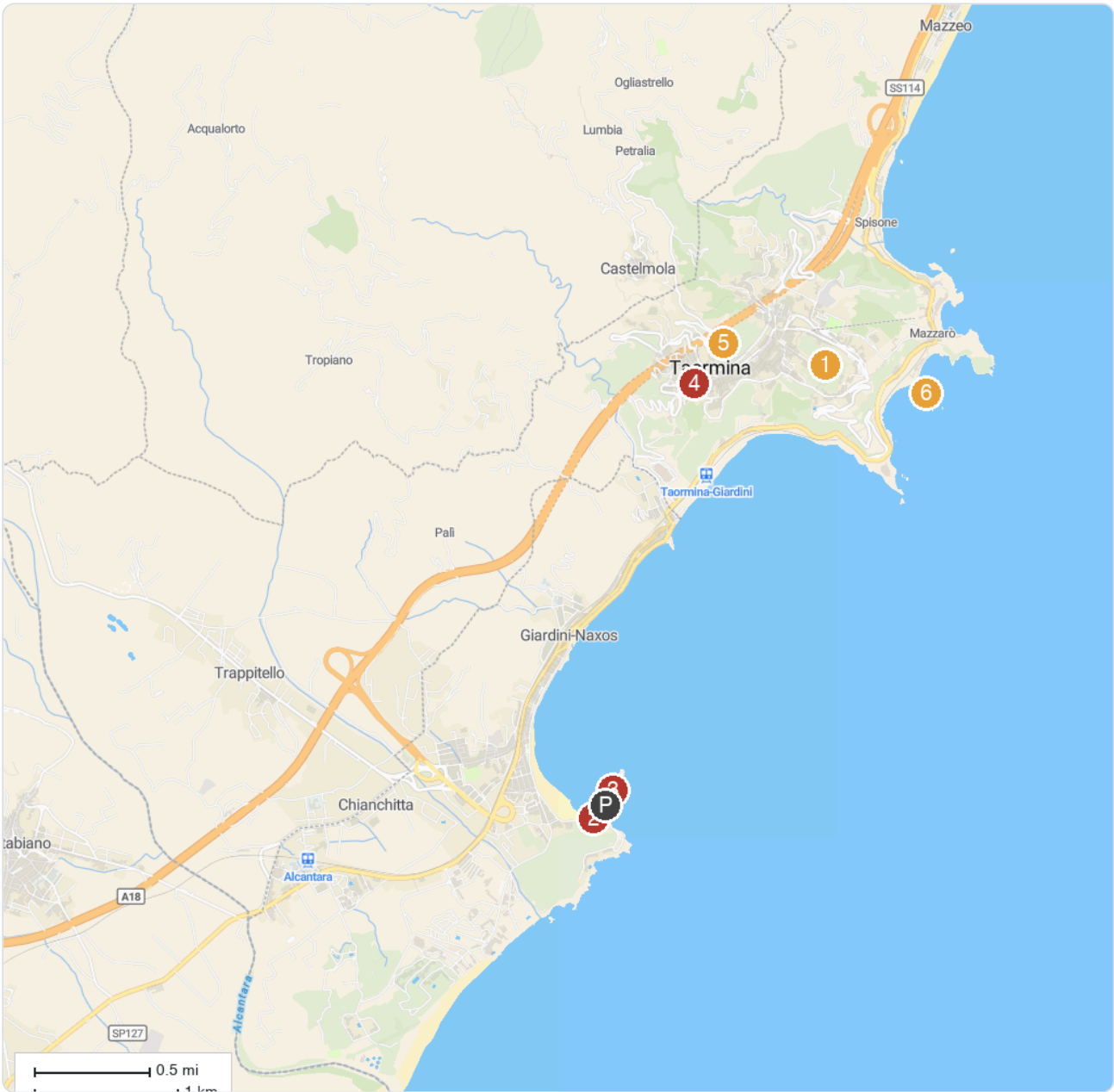
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Leave Taormina early. The tender queue swells in the late afternoon. Be back at the pier at least 90 minutes before all-aboard, or you risk a very expensive taxi chase.
- Wear proper shoes. Taormina's cobblestones are steep and slick. Flip flops or heels will punish you. Comfortable walking shoes
