- **Bucharest City Highlights** — Romania's capital rewards a full day: the colossal Palace of Parliament (world's 2nd-largest administrative building...
 - **Bran Castle & Brașov** — The Gothic hilltop castle associated with Dracula mythology plus the gorgeous medieval city of Brașov in the Carpathian...
- **Peleș Castle & Sinaia** — The Neo-Renaissance royal summer palace in the Carpathians is Romania's most visited castle — ornate rooms, mountain...
 - **Comana Natural Park & Monastery** — One of Romania's largest wetland reserves, 30 km from Giurgiu.
 - **Giurgiu Town Walk: Ottoman Legacy** — Stroll the octagonal old town — a Ottoman defensive design — to the 1771 Clock Tower, Giurgiu Fortress ruins, St.

BEST WALKS

- **Port to Old Town Loop** 1.5 km · 20-30 min · Easy — Walk from the port entrance along the Danube promenade to the Clock Tower, then loop through the octagonal central grid past St.
- **Danube Promenade & Friendship Bridge View** 2 km · 30 min · Easy — Head south along the riverbank promenade for clear views of the Giurgiu-Rousse Friendship Bridge and the Bulgarian shore.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Use Romanian Leu (RON). Exchange or withdraw from ATMs in town. Credit cards accepted in most restaurants. Bulgaria uses Bulgarian Lev — don't mix them up if crossing the border.
- Carry your passport. Romania and Bulgaria both fully joined the Schengen Area (land and river borders) on 1 January 2025, ending routine checks at the Giurgiu–Ruse crossing. Keep
