GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — most ships dock directly; very large vessels may tender

Walk to center: 5 min to town, 5-10 min to nearest beach

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Dolphin-Watching Boat Trip** — Eco-boats patrol the waters around Figarolo Island where bottlenose dolphins are regularly spotted.
- **La Maddalena Archipelago Day Trip** — Boat excursion to this protected national park reveals deserted beaches, pink sands of Budelli, and crystalline coves...
- **Costa Smeralda & Porto Cervo** — A 40-minute drive north delivers you to the world's most glamorous yacht harbour.
- **Capo Figari Hike & Lighthouse** — Trail up the headland above town leads to a working lighthouse with sweeping views over the gulf, Tavolara Island, and...
- **Tavolara & Molara Island Snorkel** — Boat trips south to the dramatic limestone tower of Tavolara and the pristine natural pools of Molara combine swimming...

BEST WALKS

- **Seafront Promenade & Town Beaches** 1.5 km · Flat · 20 min one-way — Stroll from the port along the promenade past Prima Spiaggia (most central) all the way to Quinta Spiaggia.
- **Capo Figari Trail to the Lighthouse** 5 km return · Moderate · 2-2.5 hrs — Follow signs from Cala Moresca up through Mediterranean scrub to the Capo Figari lighthouse.

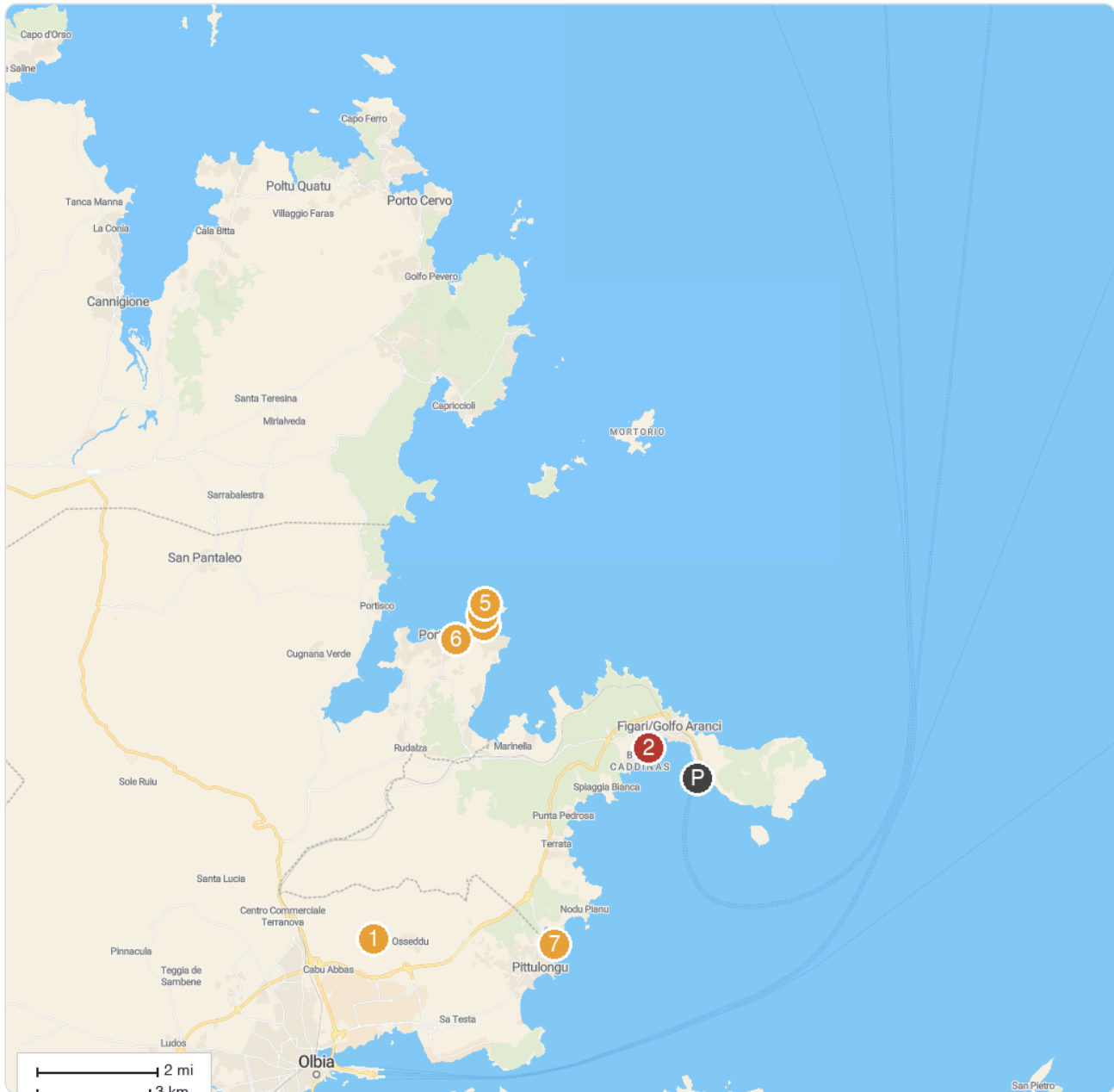
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Free beaches steps away: Prima through Quinta Spiaggia are all free public beaches within 10 minutes' walk of the pier — no excursion needed for a beach day.
- Train to Olbia is cheap and easy: €2 gets you to Olbia in about 25 minutes. Good option for shopping, a cathedral visit, or the archaeological museum.
