Docking: Pier — Amerikaterminalen (central) or Arendal/Skandia (outer, shuttle provided)

Best For: City culture, seafood, canals, architecture, Liseberg

Walk to center: 5–20 min from Amerikaterminalen; shuttle from outer terminals

Don't Miss: Giant cinnamon bun at Café Husaren, Paddan canal boat, Skansen Kronan views

Getting around: **Taxi** SEK 100–450 (~\$9–43 USD) · **Rideshare** Uber, Bolt · **Hop-on hop-off** Stromma / City Sightseeing

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Paddan Canal Boat Tour** — Flat-bottomed Paddan boats glide through the 17th-century moat canals and out into the harbor.
- Haga District Walk** — Göteborg's oldest suburb is a living museum of 19th-century timber houses along cobblestone Haga Nygata.
- Liseberg Amusement Park** — Scandinavia's largest amusement park blends world-class wooden roller coasters, beautifully landscaped gardens, and...
- World of Volvo** — Opened 2024 in a spectacular circular wooden building near Liseberg, this interactive museum traces Volvo's history...
- Southern Archipelago Islands** — Take Tram 11 to Saltholmen, then a public ferry (covered by your transit pass) to car-free islands like Vrångö (sandy...

BEST WALKS

- Haga to City Center Loop** 2–3 km · ~45 min · Easy — From Haga Nygata, walk north past Skansen Kronan fortress for panoramic views, then descend into Slottsskogen park (free zoo with...
- Waterfront & Canal Walk** 2 km · ~30 min · Easy — Follow the Göta River waterfront from the Opera House to Feskekôrka (the Gothic-looking fish market), then along the inner canal past...

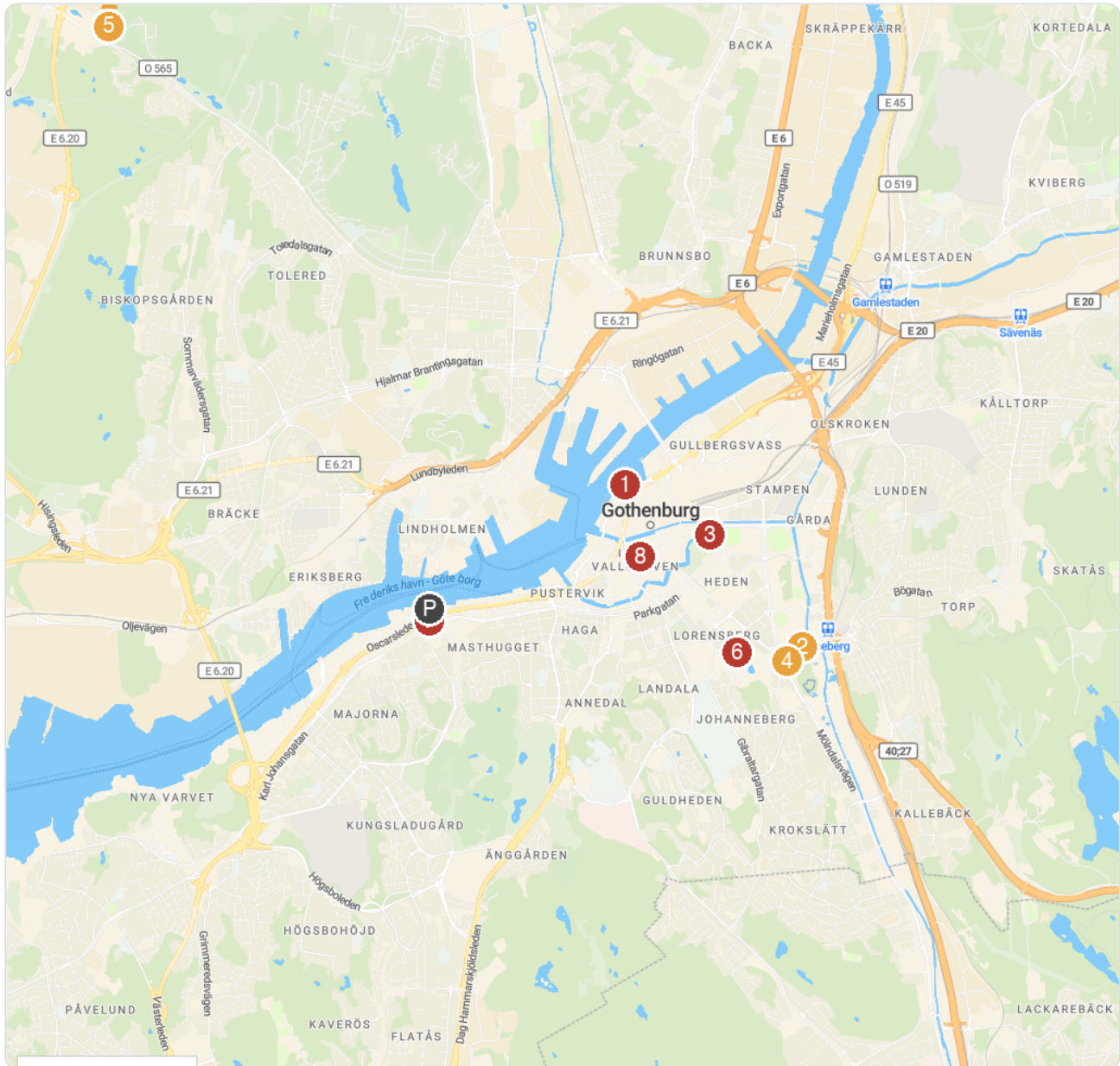
