GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — up to 3 ships simultaneously at Grand Turk Cruise Center

Best For: Wall diving, snorkeling, beaches, colonial history

Walk to town: Cockburn Town is ~3 miles north; taxi or golf cart recommended

Don't Miss: Governor's Beach and the Turks & Caicos National Museum

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Wall Dive or Snorkel at The Edge** — Grand Turk's signature attraction: a sand shelf at 30–40 ft that plummets 7,000 ft into the Columbus Passage.
- **Gibbs Cay Stingray Encounter** — A short boat ride to an uninhabited cay where wild southern stingrays glide up to meet you in waist-deep water.
- **Cockburn Town & National Museum** — Walk or taxi to the sleepy colonial capital — 18th-century Bermudian buildings, red British phone booths, and roaming...
- **Governor's Beach** — A 20-minute walk or 5-minute taxi north of the cruise center, Governor's Beach offers wide powdery sand and calm...
- **Golf Cart Island Loop** — Rent a golf cart and drive the full length of the island: cruise center, Governor's Beach, Cockburn Town, the...

BEST WALKS

- **Cruise Center to Governor's Beach** ~1 mile north | 20 min | Flat & easy — Head north along the beach from the cruise center past Jack's Shack beach bar to Governor's Beach — the island's best stretch of sand...
- **Cockburn Town Front Street Walk** Short loop | 1–2 hrs | Best with taxi to town — Taxi to Cockburn Town and walk Front Street and Duke Street past the painted Bermudian salt-era buildings, the red phone booths, and...

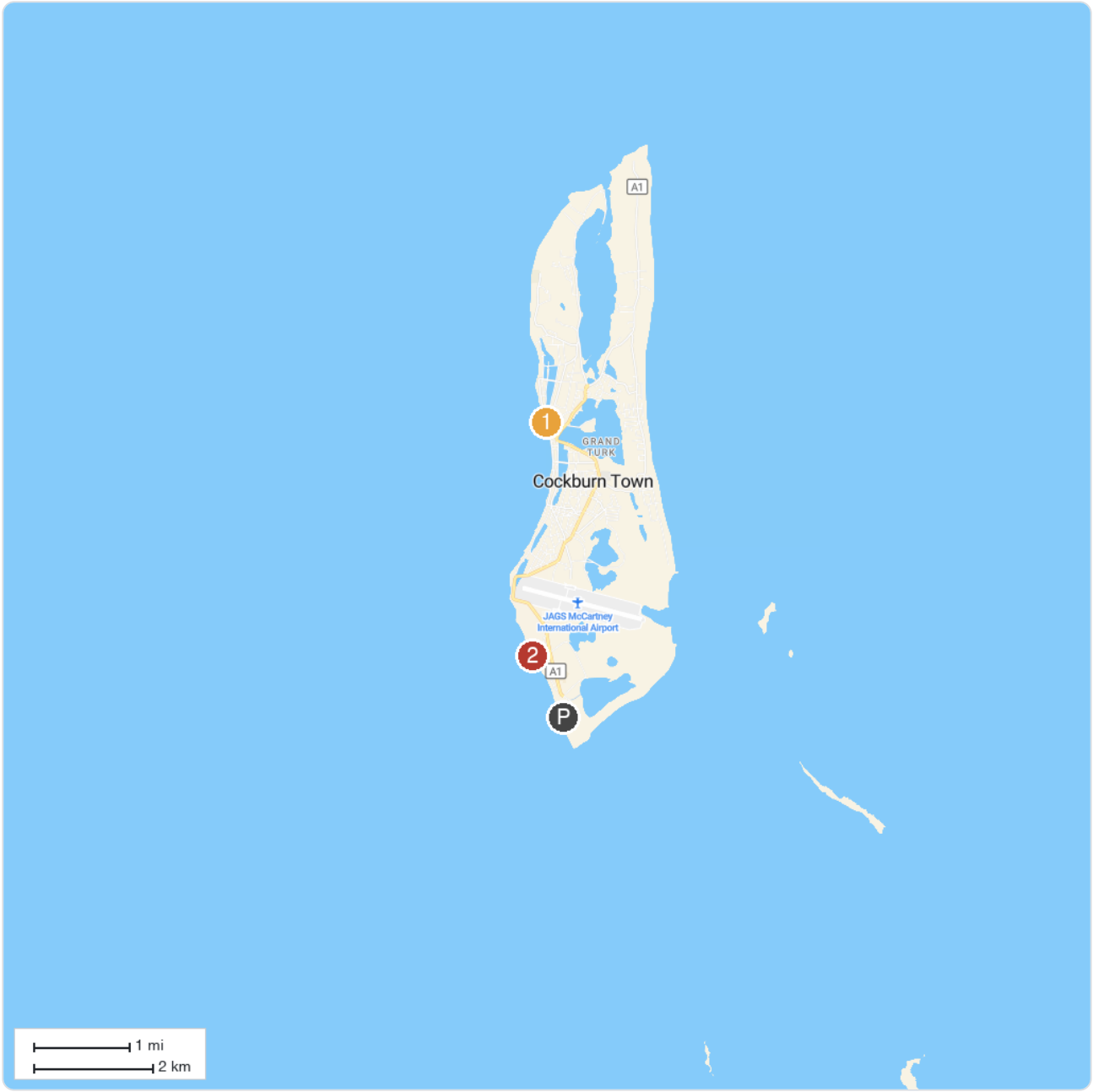
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
