TOP THINGS TO DO

- Guided Snorkel Safari** — A marine biologist leads a small group along the outer reef wall, pointing out clownfish, giant clams, Maori wrasse...
 - Introductory Scuba Dive** — No certification required.
 - Scenic Helicopter Flight** — A 10-minute flight over the outer reef reveals the full scale of the coral system from above,
- including Heart Reef — a...

 - Semi-Submersible Coral Viewing** — A small glass-sided vessel dips below the waterline to give a fish-eye view of the reef without getting wet — ideal for...
 - Certified Scuba Dive** — Qualified divers can do a guided dive to 18 metres on the outer reef slope.

BEST WALKS

- Pontoon Exploration** Self-guided · Flat · 10 min — Walk the pontoon levels: upper sun deck, shaded dining area, underwater observatory stairs, and gear station.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Use reef-safe sunscreen only. The Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority prohibits oxybenzone and octinoxate sunscreens. Bring mineral SPF 50+ or buy on the pontoon.
- Always wear a stinger suit from November to May — box jellyfish and Irukandji are present in these waters. Suits are provided free on pontoons but supply is limited; board early.
- Take seasickness meds before tendering. The open Coral Sea can run 1–2 metre swells. Once on the pontoon you'll be fine, but the tender and semi-sub can be rough.
