Docking: Docked at Outer Harbour — shuttle bus required to reach town (~10 min)

Walk to center: Not walkable from port; free/paid shuttle to Market Gates or the seafront

Don't Miss: Hippodrome Circus (Britain's only surviving purpose-built circus still in use) and the 1932 wooden roller coaster

- **Medieval Walls & Minster Walk** — Great Yarmouth has the second-best preserved medieval town walls in England.
 - **Time and Tide Museum** — Housed in a Victorian herring curing works, this award-winning museum covers Great Yarmouth's fishing and maritime...
 - **Pleasure Beach — 1932 Wooden Roller Coaster** — One of only two remaining wooden scenic railways in the UK that still
- uses a live brakeman on the train.

 - **The Hippodrome Circus** — Built in 1903, this is Britain's only surviving purpose-built circus building still used for circus, and one of just a...
 - **Day Trip to Norwich** — Just 30 minutes by train, Norwich offers a Norman cathedral, a 900-year-old castle, medieval cobbled Elm Hill, and...

- **The Golden Mile Seafront Promenade** 2 km · easy · 45-60 min — Walk the full length of Great Yarmouth's famous seafront from the Venetian Waterways and Cotman Gardens at the north end to the...
- **Medieval Town Walls Circuit** 2 km loop · easy · 1 hr — Follow the surviving sections of Great Yarmouth's medieval flint walls — among the best-preserved in England.

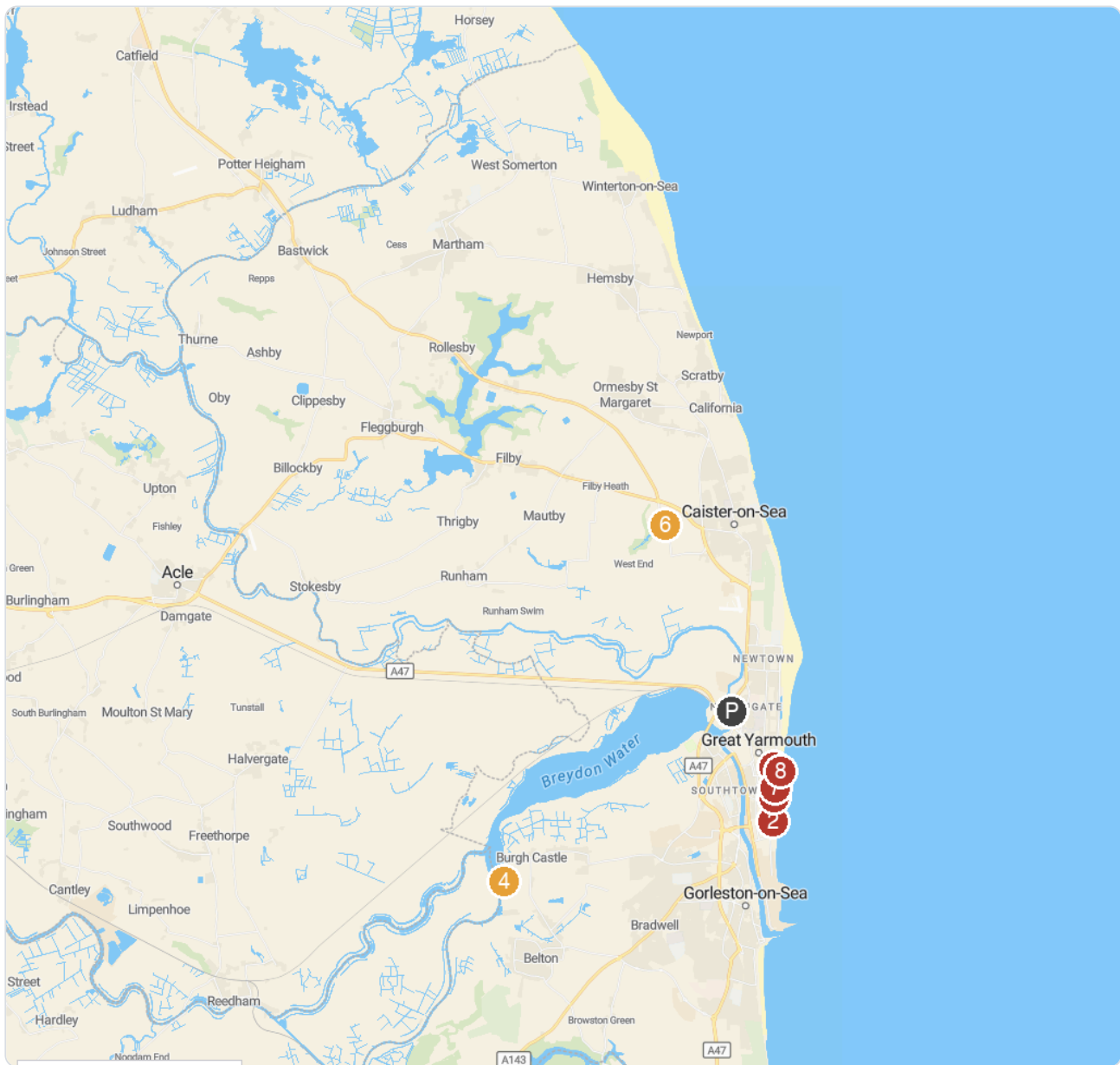
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
