GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Leicht Memorial Park on the Fox River; ships dock alongside, no tendering

Best For: Sports history, Great Lakes freshwater cruising, Midwest food culture

Walk to center: ~5 min to CityDeck & Broadway District; Lambeau Field ~3 miles (rideshare recommended)

Don't Miss: Lambeau Field tour & Packers Hall of Fame, Bay Beach Amusement Park (25¢ rides!), squeaky cheese curds

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Lambeau Field Tour & Packers Hall of Fame** — Walk the same tunnel as NFL players, stand on the legendary frozen tundra, and explore 15,000 sq ft of Packers history.
- **Heritage Hill State Historical Park** — 56 acres of living history with 26 authentic buildings spanning Wisconsin's fur trade, frontier military, pioneer, and...
- **National Railroad Museum** — One of the oldest and largest railroad museums in the US.
- **Bay Beach Wildlife Sanctuary** — 600-acre urban wildlife refuge with free admission.
- **Door County Day Trip** — About an hour from the dock, Door County is the 'Cape Cod of the Midwest' — limestone bluffs, cherry orchards, historic...

BEST WALKS

- **CityDeck & Broadway District Stroll** 1–2 hrs | Flat | Free — From Leicht Memorial Park, walk south along the Fox River to the CityDeck boardwalk, cross Ray Nitschke Memorial Bridge, then explore...
- **National Railroad Museum & Bay Beach Loop** 3–4 hrs | Easy | Rideshare to start — Rideshare to the National Railroad Museum, walk through the exhibits, then continue to Bay Beach Amusement Park and the Wildlife...

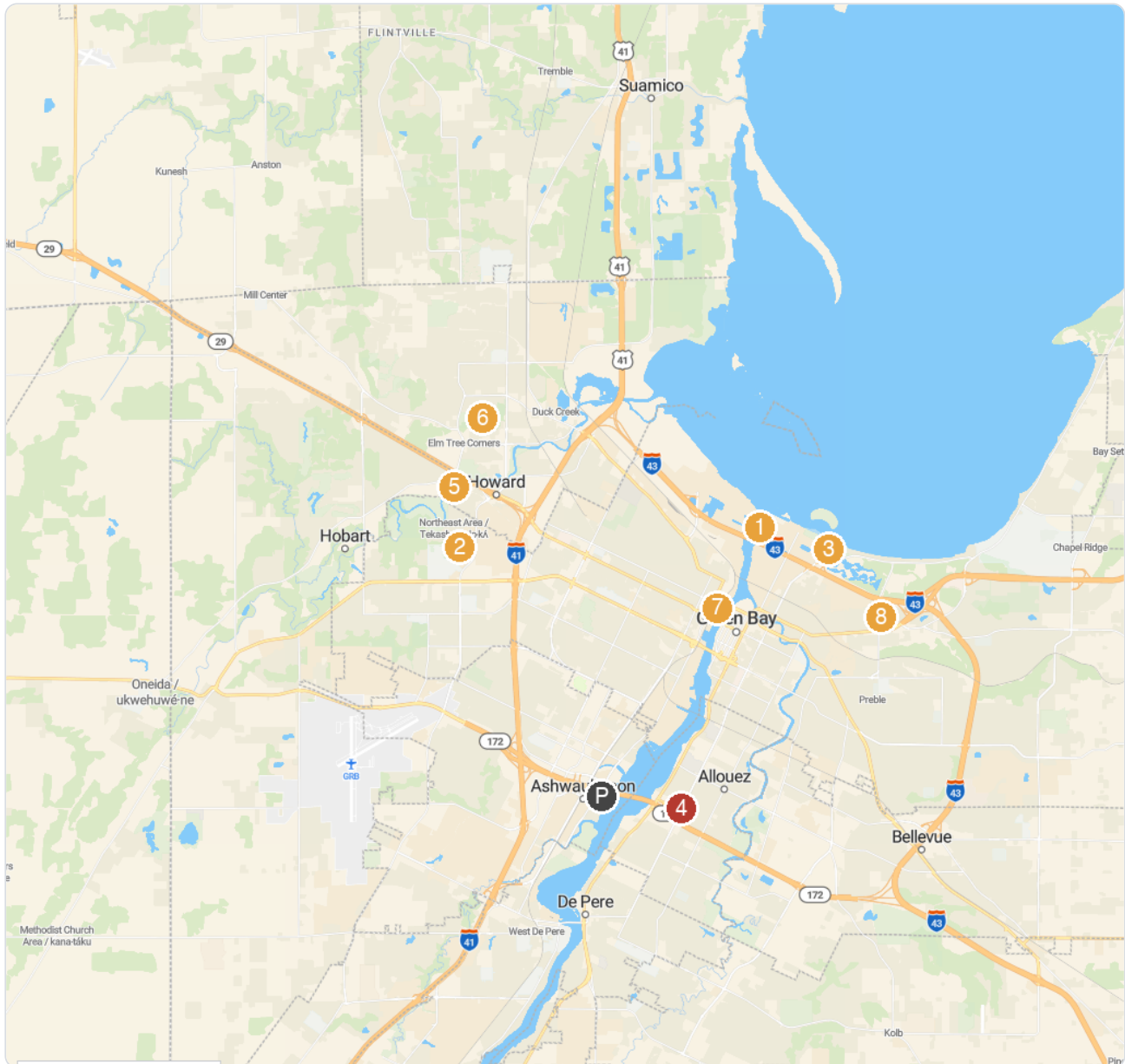
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
