- Glasgow City Day Trip — DIY by Train** — Take the ScotRail train to Glasgow Central and explore on foot.

- Inveraray Castle & Argyll** — The ancestral seat of the Duke of Argyll, Inveraray Castle is a fairytale turreted castle featured in Downton Abbey.

- Scotch Whisky Tasting — Clydeside Distillery** — Glasgow's only working waterfront distillery sits next to the Riverside Museum.

BEST WALKS

- Greenock Esplanade Waterfront Walk** 1.5 miles one-way · Flat · 30-45 min · Free — Starting from the cruise terminal, follow the Esplanade east along the Firth of Clyde.
- Glasgow Merchant City & Cathedral Walk** 1.5 miles loop · Easy · 45-60 min after train · Free — From Glasgow Central, walk north through the Merchant City to George Square, then up High Street to Glasgow Cathedral and the...

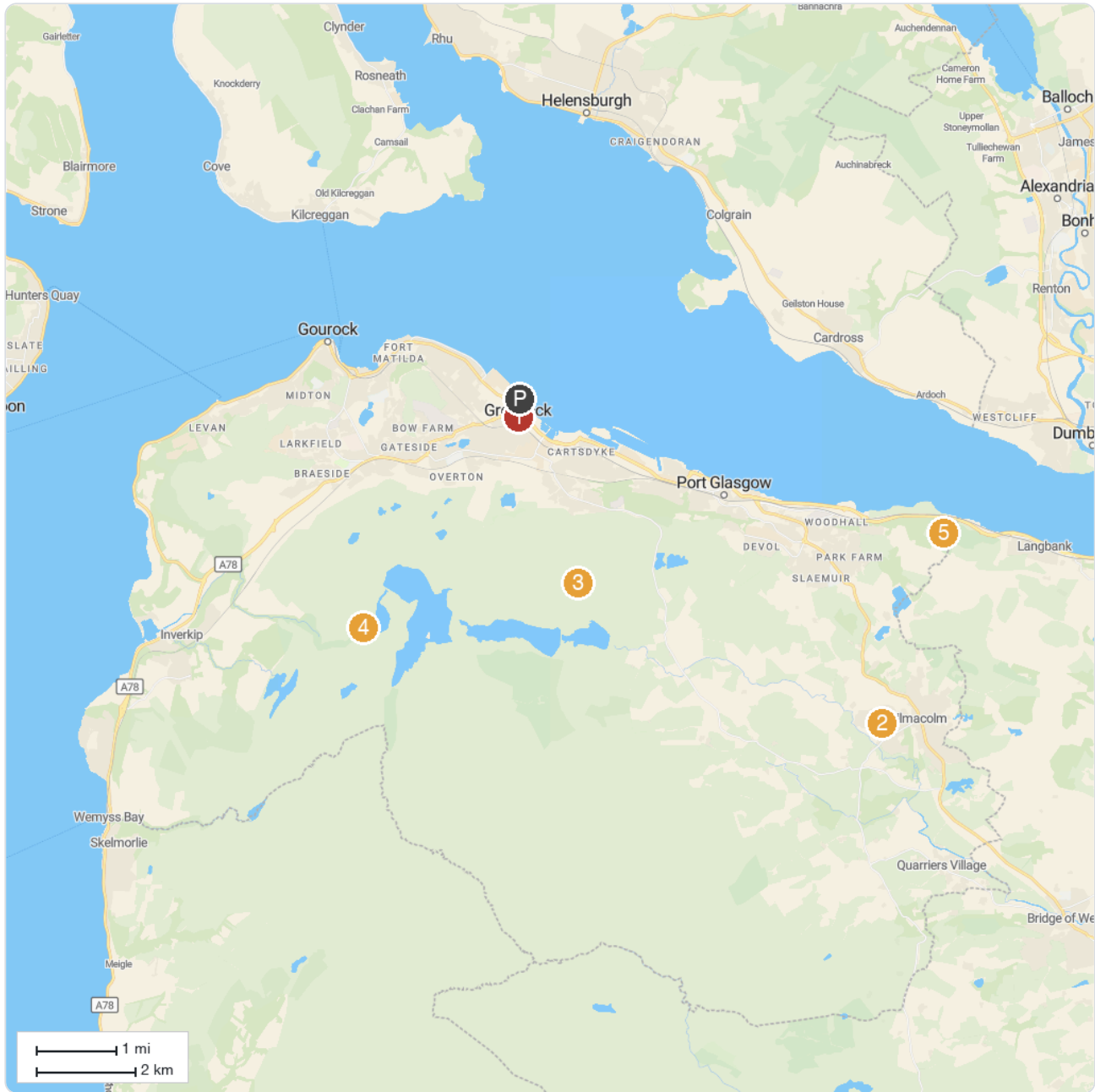
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
