Docking: Pier — F1 Pier, Port Authority of Guam, Apra Harbor

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **War in the Pacific National Historical Park** — Seven distinct units tell the story of the 1944 liberation of Guam.
- **Two Lovers Point (Puntan Dos Amantes)** — Guam's most photographed landmark — a roughly 370-foot limestone cliff over Tumon Bay, named for the Chamorro legend of...
- **Tumon Bay Beach Day** — Tumon's long white-sand beach fronts the main hotel strip and is free, public, and calm year-round behind a fringing...
- **Valley of the Latte Adventure Park** — A cultural eco-park in the south showcasing ancient Chamorro village life, latte stone replicas, boat rides, and water...
- **Snorkeling & Diving Apra Harbor / Fish Eye Marine Park** — Guam's reef-protected waters are legendary in the Pacific.

BEST WALKS

- **Hagåtña History Loop** 1.5 miles • Easy • 60–90 min — From the Plaza de España ruins, walk past the restored Dulce Nombre de Maria Cathedral-Basilica, cross to Latte Stone Park to see the...
- **Tumon Bay Boardwalk** 1 mile • Easy • 30–45 min — Stroll the beachfront from the Westin south end to Ypao Beach Park, dipping into the water whenever you like.

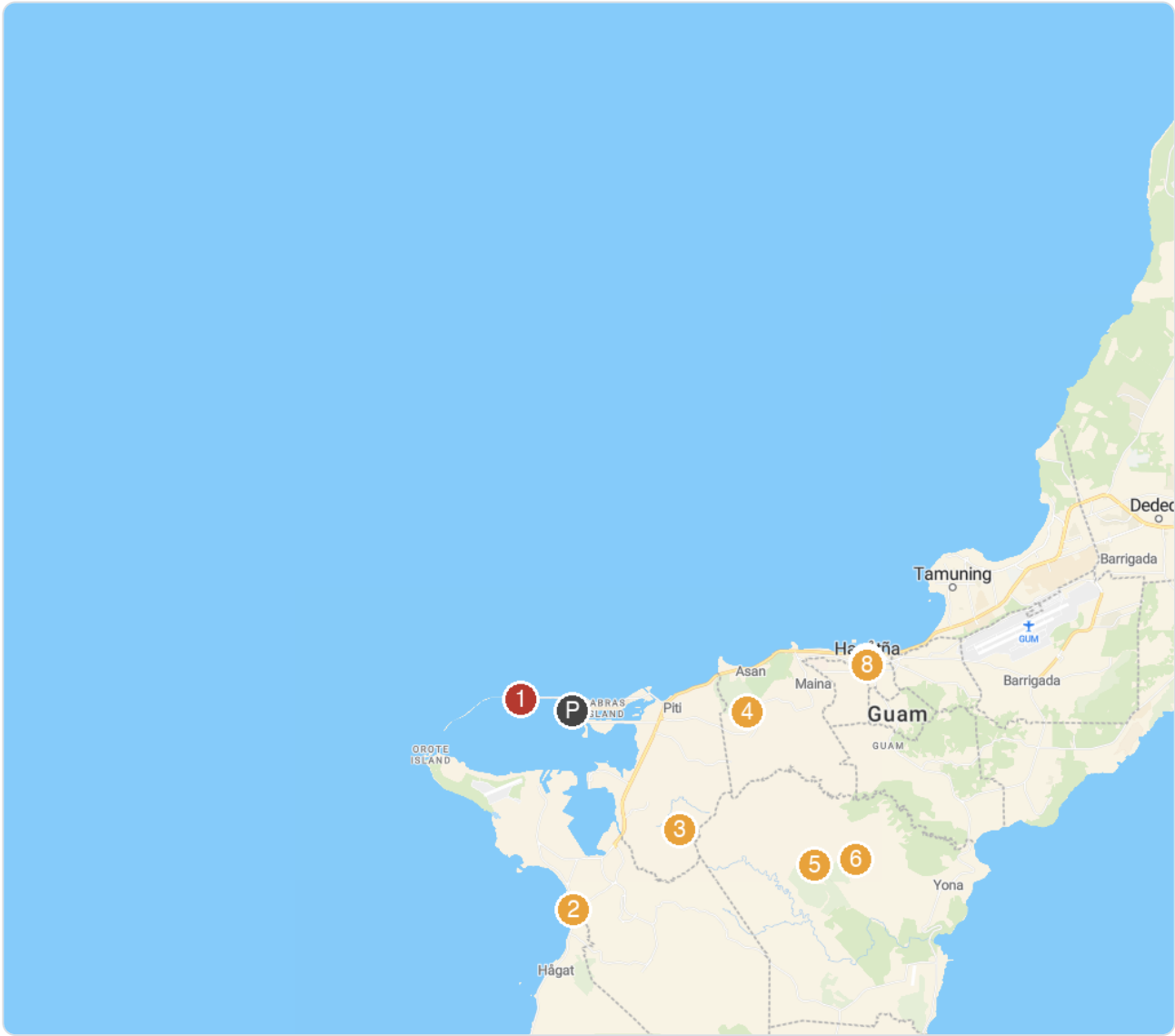
