GETTING ASHORE

- Docking:** Commercial pier; shuttle to downtown (~10 min, often complimentary)
- Best For:** Seafood lovers, divers, nature seekers, those wanting non-touristy Mexico
- Walk to center:** Not walkable from pier — industrial port zone; take shuttle or taxi
- Don't Miss:** Perlas del Mar de Cortez pearl farm tour and fresh camarones on the Malecón

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  \$10–\$15 USD one-way ·  **Rideshare**  Uber, DiDi

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Perlas del Mar de Cortez Pearl Farm** — The only active saltwater pearl farm in the Americas.
- San Carlos Mirador & Playa Los Algodones** — Head 20 minutes to San Carlos for the Mirador Escénico — ranked by National Geographic as one of the Top 10 Ocean Views...
- Sea of Cortez Dive & Snorkel** — Jacques Cousteau called this 'the aquarium of the world.' Dive sites include underwater caves, basalt walls, and wrecks...
- Nacapule Canyon Hike** — Just outside Guaymas, Cañón del Nacapule is a lush tropical oasis tucked inside a dry canyon — a rare microclimate with...
- Downtown Guaymas Food & Malecón Walk** — Take the shuttle downtown, stroll the renovated Malecón waterfront, and eat at the Mercado Municipal or a waterfront...

BEST WALKS

- Historic Downtown & Malecón Loop** 1.5 miles · Easy · 60–90 min — Start at Plaza de los Tres Presidentes with its large bronze statues of three Mexican presidents born here.
- Playa Miramar Beach Walk** 15 min by taxi · Easy · 1–2 hrs beach time — Playa Miramar is the closest swimming beach to the port — calm, clear turquoise water in a protected bay.

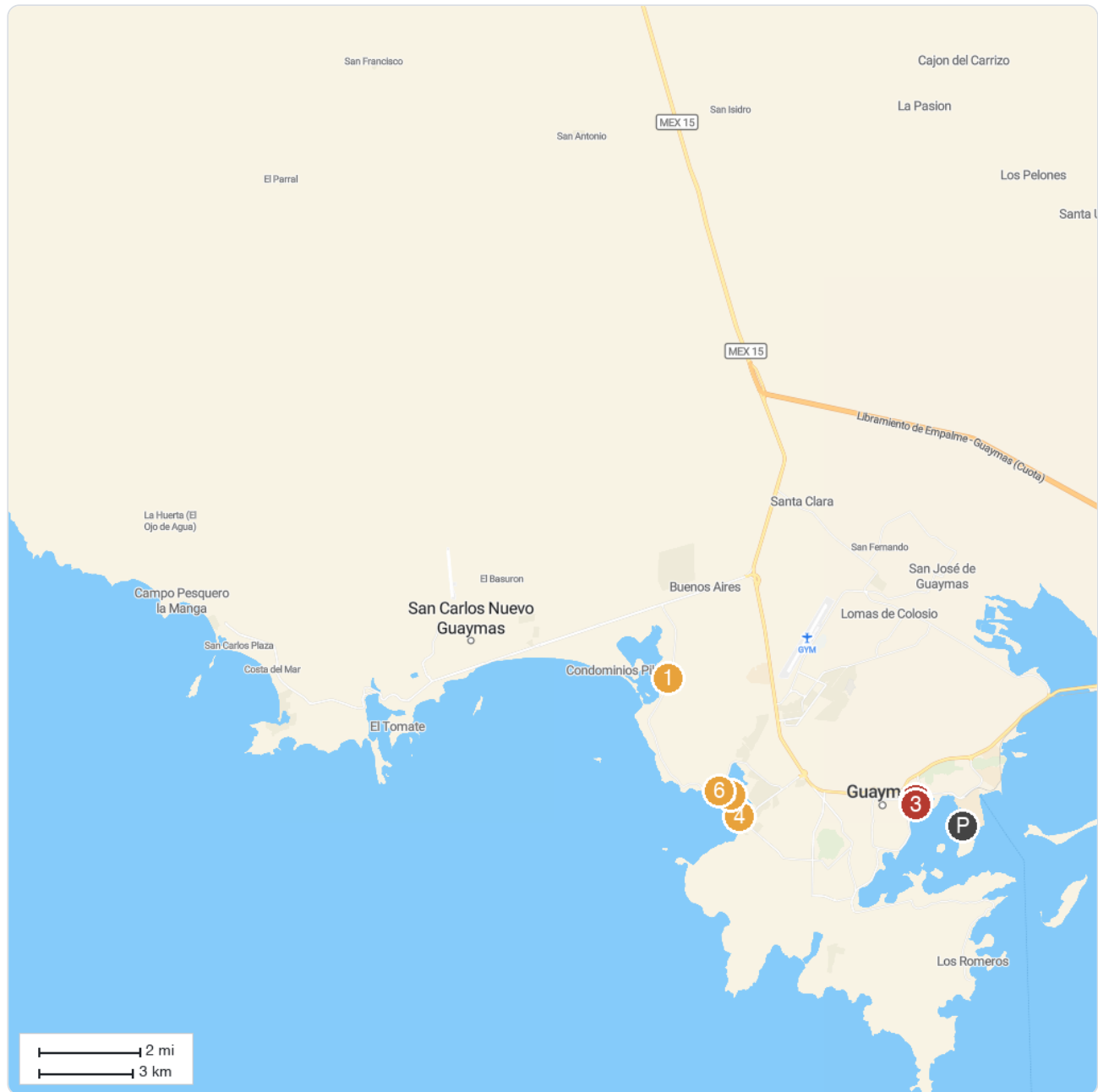
