TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Castle Cornet** — Eight centuries of island history packed into one sea-girt fortress.
- **Hauteville House — Victor Hugo's Exile** — Hugo spent 15 years here, writing *Les Misérables* and personally decorating every room into a three-storey work of art.
- **German Occupation Sites** — Guernsey was the only part of the British Isles occupied by Nazi forces during WWII (1940–45).
- **Fermain Bay Cliff Walk** — A stunning 45–60 minute cliff path south from St.
- **West Coast Beaches** — Cobo Bay and Vazon Bay on Guernsey's west coast offer broad stretches of pale sand and turquoise water — a world away...

BEST WALKS

- **Harbour & Castle Cornet Waterfront Walk** 1.5 km · 20-25 min · Easy/flat — A classic flat stroll along the harbourfront from Albert Pier to Castle Cornet.
- **High Street to Candie Gardens** 1 km · 20 min · Moderate (uphill) — Head up from the High Street through the historic quarter to Candie Gardens — Victorian public gardens with sweeping views over the...

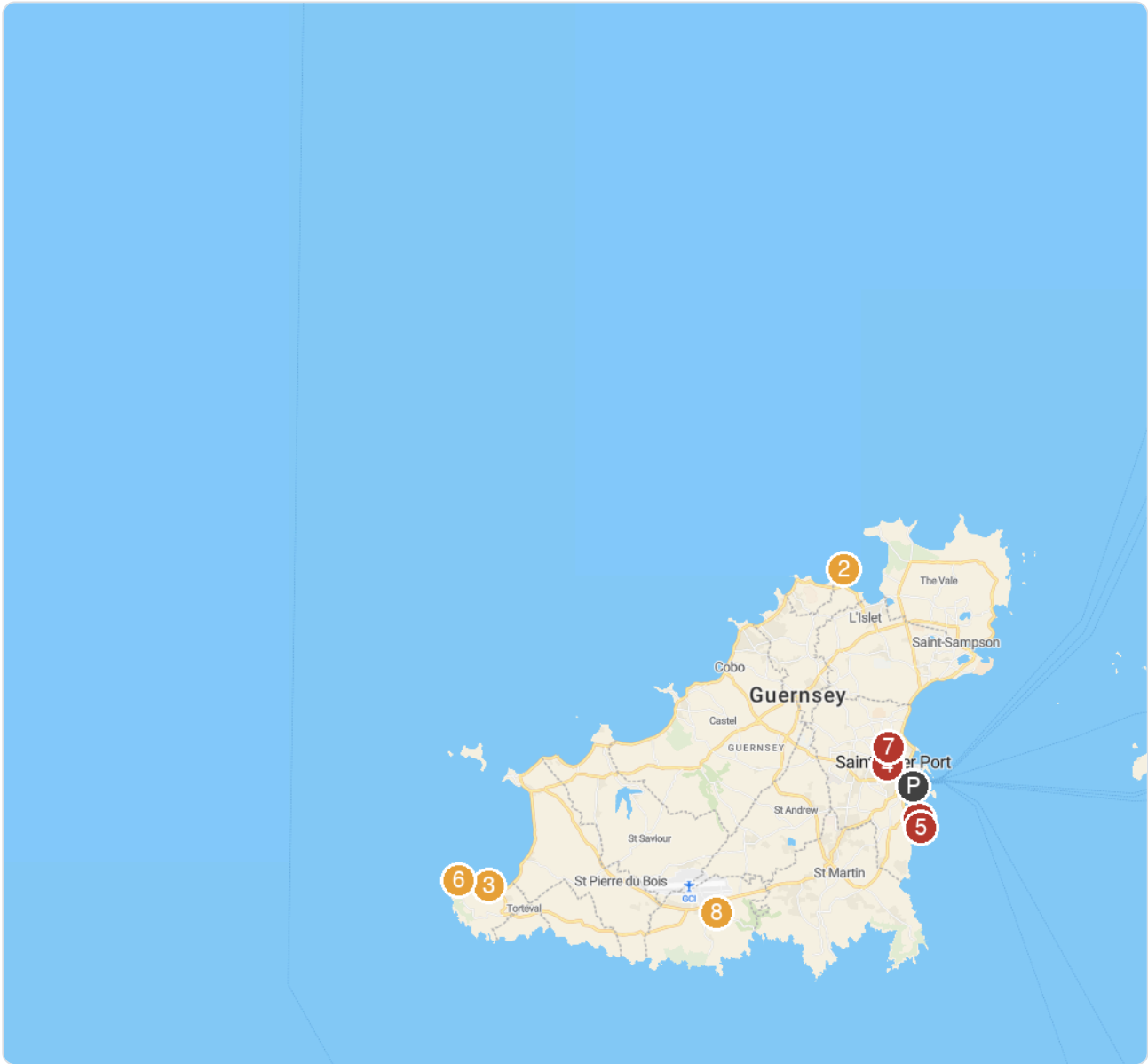
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Spend your Guernsey change before you leave. Guernsey Pounds and coins are near-impossible to exchange once you're back in the UK or on the continent. Cards are widely accepted...
- Turn off mobile data. Guernsey is outside UK and EU roaming bundles. Most carriers charge premium rates here. Download offline maps before you arrive.
- Hauteville House requires advance booking. Tickets sell out weeks (sometimes months) ahead — book via the Paris Musées website (maisonsvictorhugo.paris.fr) before your cruise...
