GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Zodiac from ship — no landings permitted

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Drift Snorkel — Crescent Islets** — The signature experience: drift along the semi-sheltered crescent of volcanic islets while sea lions, white-tip reef...

- **Scuba Diving — Wall & Pelagic Site** — Walls drop 20 meters to a sandy bottom draped in black coral and
- **Zodiac Panga Ride — Islet Circumnavigation** — Some ships offer a slow Zodiac tour around the islets to spot blue-footed boobies nesting on the rock faces, Nazca...

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Currents can be strong. This is often a drift snorkel — the Zodiac drops you at the start and picks you up at the end. Confident swimming is recommended; weak swimmers should stay...
- Bring an underwater camera. Sea lions will approach within arm's reach. A GoPro on a wrist strap is ideal — action is fast and you'll want both hands free.
- Wear the wetsuit. Even in the tropics, the Humboldt Current chills the water (18–22°C). A 3mm shorty is usually provided; use it for warmth and buoyancy.
