GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender for large ships; vessels up to ~200 m may berth at quay

Best For: History, scenic strolls, Byzantine ruins, day trips

Walk to center: Tender drops at harbor — town is immediately at hand

Don't Miss: Marathonisi islet & Mystras UNESCO ghost city

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Mystras Byzantine Ghost City** — A UNESCO World Heritage hilltop city that was once the second capital of the late Byzantine Empire.
- **Diros Caves (Vlychada)** — One of Europe's most spectacular water caves.
- **Sparta & Archaeological Museum** — Modern Sparta sits atop the ancient city.
- **Mavrovouni Beach** — A 5 km arc of golden sand and fine pebbles just south of town, with crystal-clear Laconian Gulf water.
- **Marathonisi Islet & Mani Museum** — Walk the 150-meter causeway to the pine-covered islet of Cranae — where myth says Paris and Helen of Troy spent their...

BEST WALKS

- **Harbor Promenade to Marathonisi** 2.5 km round-trip · Flat · 40–60 min — Stroll the neoclassical waterfront past tavernas drying octopus in the sun, then cross the stone causeway to Marathonisi islet.
- **Town & Roman Theater Walk** 2 km loop · Mostly flat, some gentle hills · 30–45 min — Head north along the waterfront and climb gently to the small but well-preserved 2nd-century Roman theater.

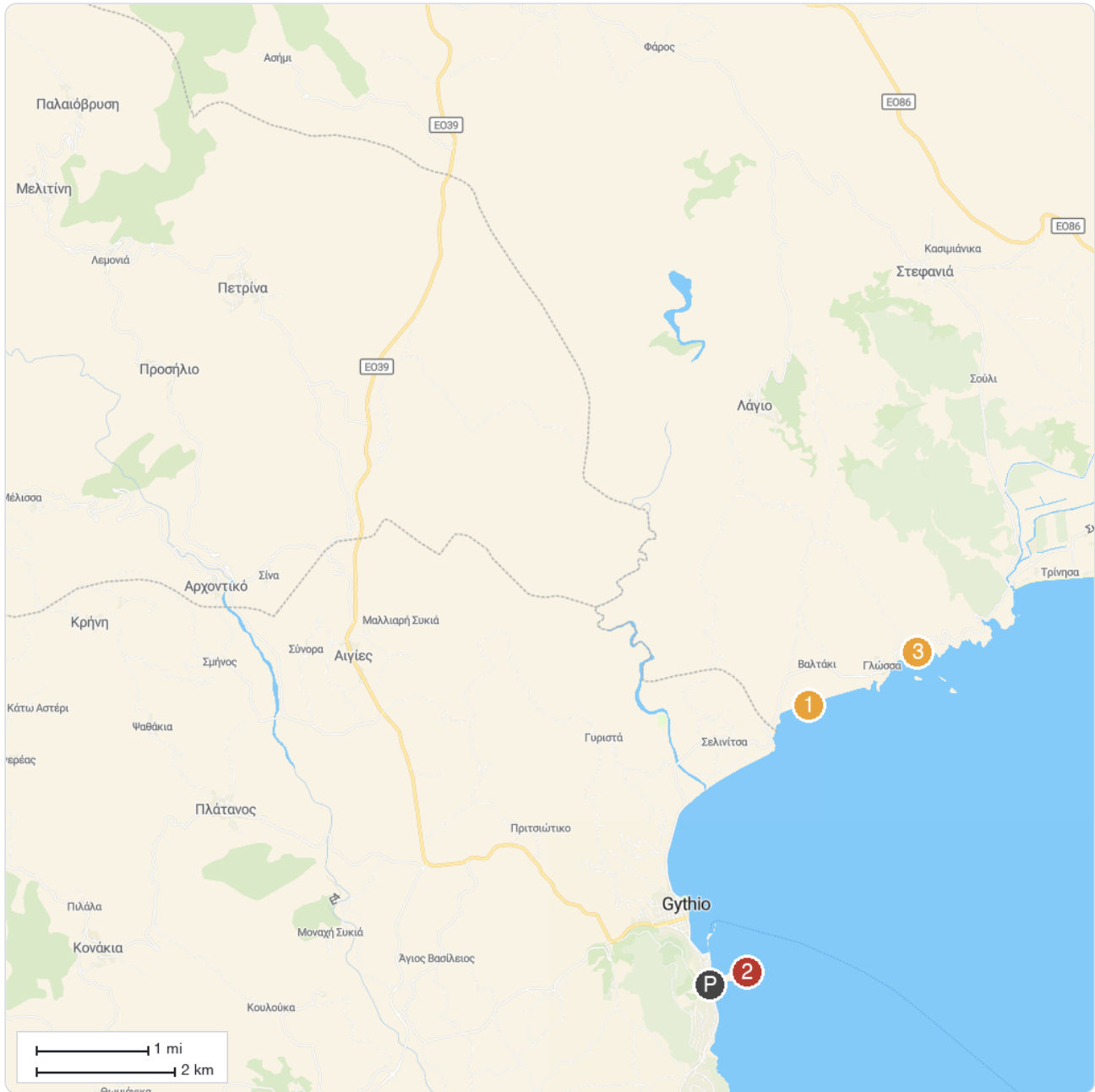
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- **Tender timing:** Pick up tender tickets early on board — call-day crowds can mean 30-min waits for the boat back. Aim to be back at the tender dock 90 min before all-aboard.
- **Taxis fill up fast:** The taxi stand is steps from the tender pier. Agree on a round-trip price before you go — for Mystras or Diros, expect €60–90 for the car (not per person)....
- **Car rental books out:** Local agencies (e.g., near the harbor) have small fleets. Reserve weeks ahead if you want to self-drive to the Mani or Diros Caves.
