GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Minatocho Wharf (large ships, 5 km from center) or Wakamatsu Wharf (small ships, walkable)

Best For: History, seafood, panoramic views, Meiji-era architecture

Walk to center: Not walkable from Minatocho; free/paid shuttle to Hakodate Station

Don't Miss: Goryokaku star fort, Morning Market squid bowl, Mount Hakodate ropeway

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Mount Hakodate Ropeway** — Hakodate's summit view is ranked among Japan's top three.
- **Goryokaku Fort & Tower** — Japan's first Western-style (Vauban-style) star fortress, built 1857-1864 to defend Hokkaido.
- **Hakodate Morning Market (Asaichi)** — 250+ stalls of fresh Hokkaido seafood right beside the station.
- **Motomachi Historic District** — Wander Hakodate's Victorian-era hillside quarter: Russian Orthodox Church, Roman Catholic Church, Former British...
- **Onuma Quasi-National Park** — A scenic lake district 20 km north of Hakodate, with gentle walking trails, lake cruises, and views of the Komagatake...

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront Loop: Station to Red Brick Warehouses** 2 km · 25 min · Flat — From Hakodate Station, browse the Morning Market stalls, then follow the harbor promenade south past the fishing boats to the Kanemori...
- **Motomachi Slopes & Churches** 2.5 km · 40 min · Hilly — Tram to Jujigai stop, then climb through the old foreign settlement past churches and the Former British Consulate to the top of...

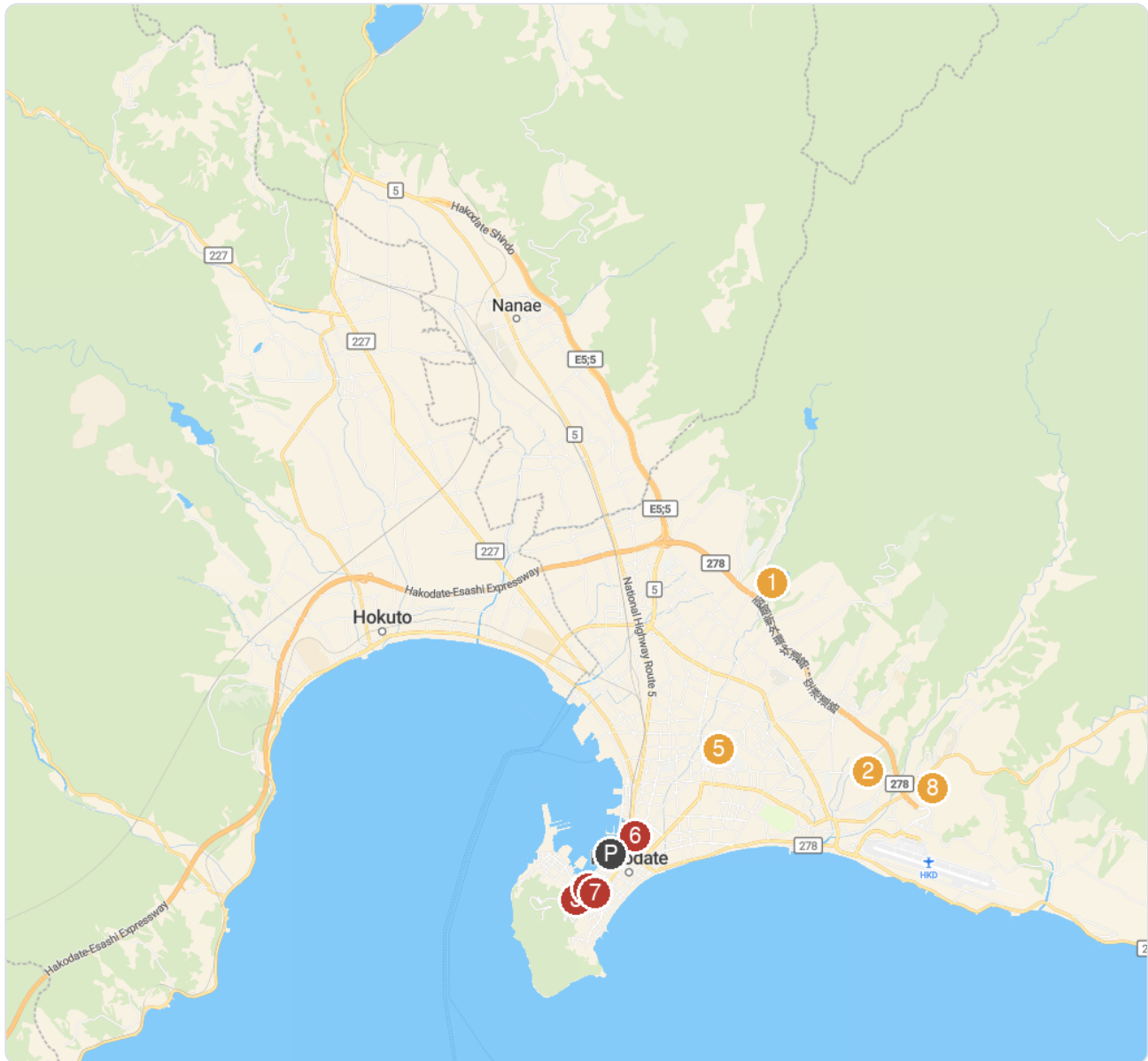
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
