- **Speicherstadt & Elbphilharmonie** — Walk the world's largest historic warehouse district — a UNESCO World Heritage site of redbrick canals — then ride the... historic Speicherstadt, and...
- **Miniatur Wunderland** — The world's largest model railway exhibition, in the heart of Speicherstadt.
- **Inner Harbour Cruise** — A one-hour guided boat tour from Landungsbrücken takes you past container terminals, the
- **Hamburg Rathaus & Altstadt** — The neo-Renaissance City Hall dominates Rathausmarkt with 647 rooms and a free inner courtyard.
- **Beatles History Tour** — Walk in Lennon, McCartney & Co.'s footsteps along the Grosse Freiheit.

BEST WALKS

- **Landungsbrücken to Speicherstadt & Elbphilharmonie** 3.5 km · ~50 min · flat — Start at the iconic St.
- **HafenCity Waterfront Loop** 2.5 km · ~35 min · flat — A modern architecture walk through HafenCity's award-winning buildings, public plazas, and waterside promenades.
- **Jungfernstieg & Alster Promenade** 2 km · ~30 min · flat — Hamburg's elegant shopping boulevard runs along the Binnenalster lake.

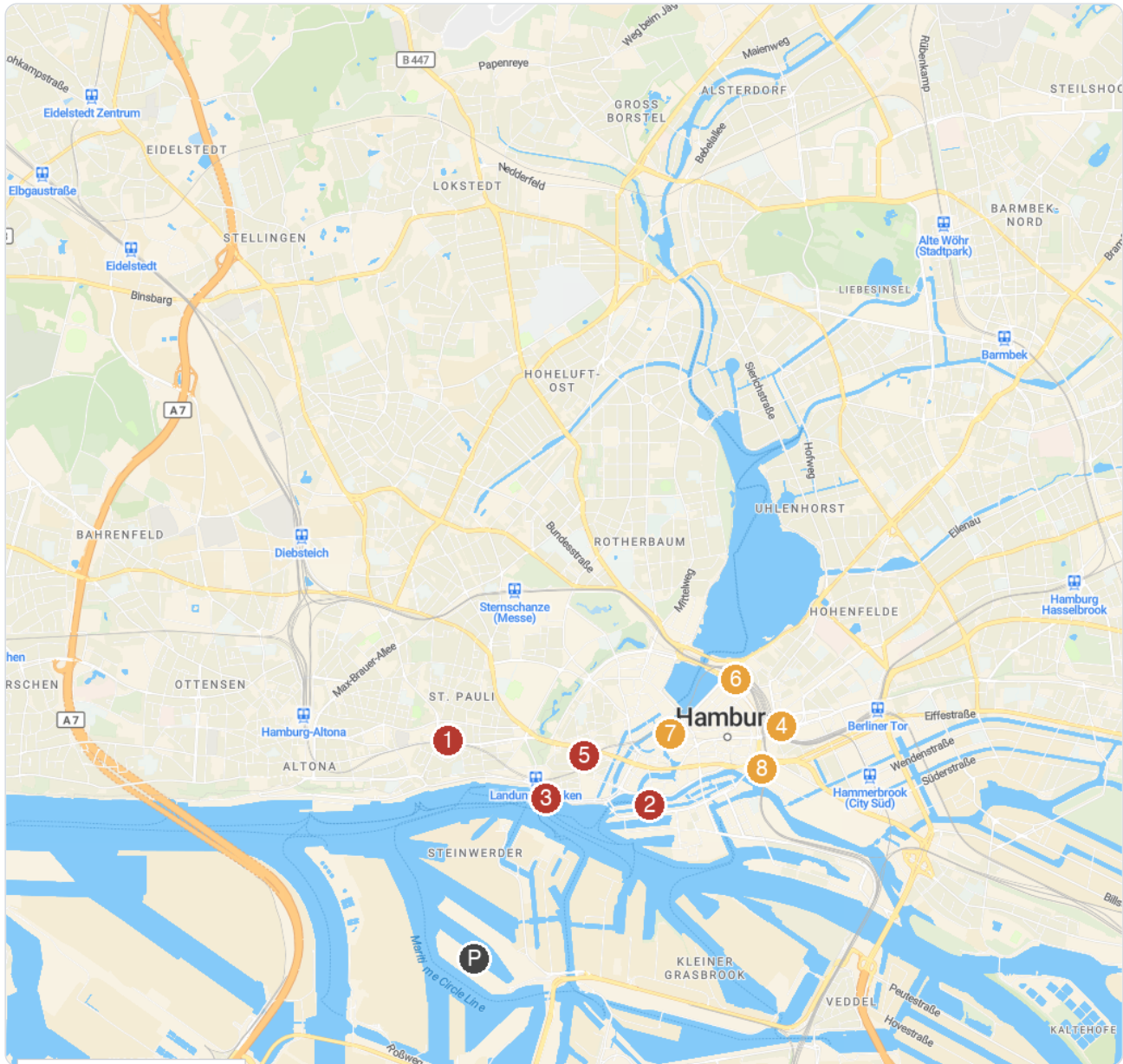
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
