GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Ships berth directly on Front Street in Hamilton city centre

Best For: Pink-sand beaches, history, snorkelling, and easy island exploring

Walk to centre: You are already in the centre — shops and restaurants steps away

Don't Miss: Fort Hamilton's underground passages and Horseshoe Bay's pink sand

Getting around:  **Taxi**  \$9.20 first mile, \$3.25/mile after (1–4 pax) ·  **Rideshare**  not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Horseshoe Bay Beach** — Bermuda's most famous stretch of pink sand and turquoise water.
 - Fort Hamilton Walk** — A 19th-century British fortification 15 minutes uphill from the pier.
 - Crystal & Fantasy Caves** — Two adjoining caverns in Hamilton Parish with crystal-clear underground pools,
- stalactites, and natural rock bridges.

 - Historic St. George's** — A UNESCO World Heritage town with cobblestone lanes, 17th-century churches, and Bermuda's original capital.
 - Snorkelling & Water Sports** — Bermuda's reefs host wreck dives, kayaking, and snorkelling.

BEST WALKS

- Front Street to Fort Hamilton** ~2 km · 30–40 min · moderate (uphill to fort) — Start at the cruise pier on Front Street, walk east past pastel shops and the Bermuda Historical Society Museum, then follow King...
- Hamilton Waterfront & City Hall Loop** ~1.5 km · 20–30 min · easy — From the pier, stroll along Front Street to the ferry terminal, cut up to City Hall and the Bermuda National Gallery, pass through...

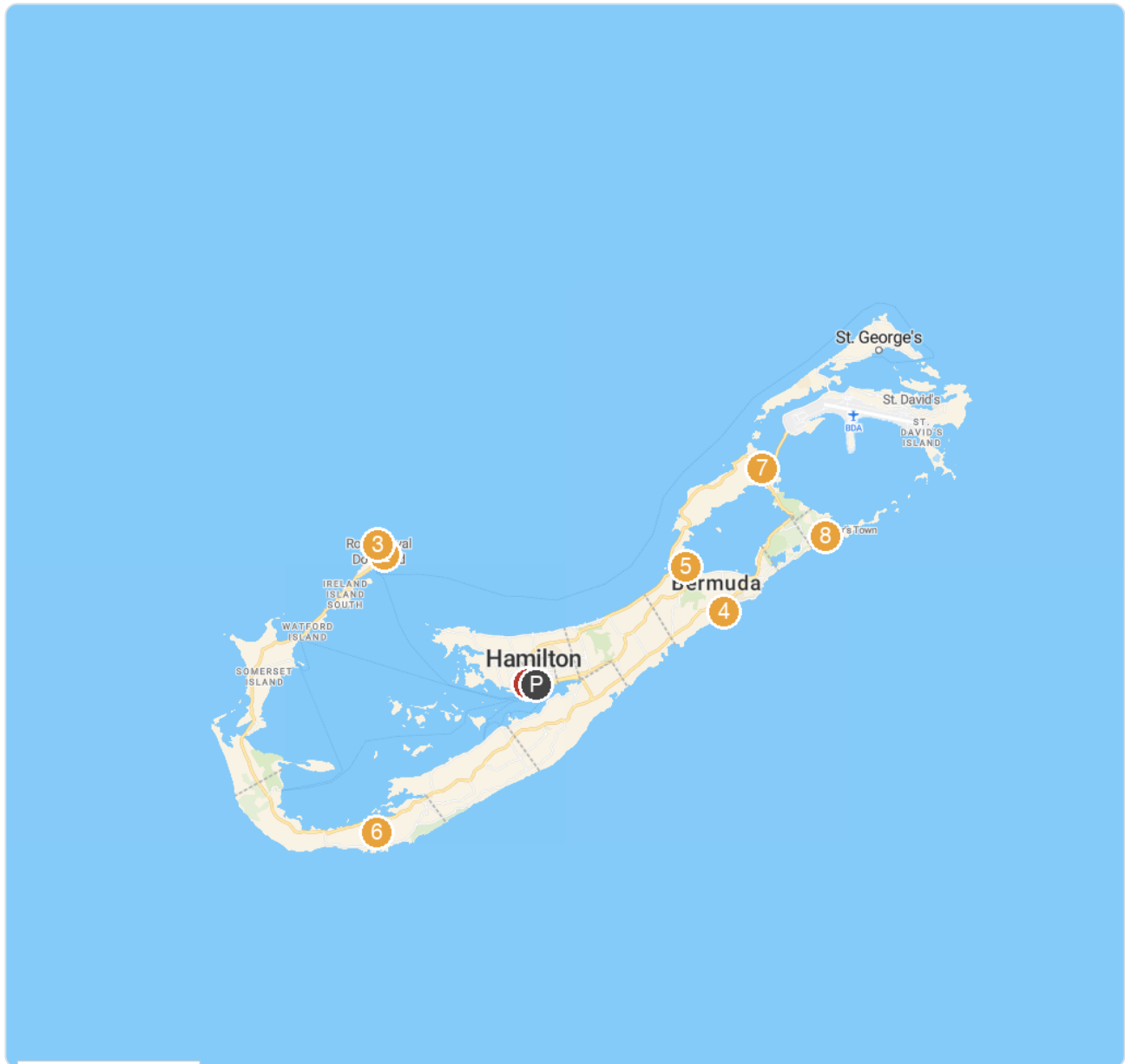
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- USD = BMD. Bermuda dollars and US dollars are accepted everywhere at 1:1 — no need to exchange currency.
- Buy a multi-trip bus pass. The Public Transportation Board sells 1-day and 3-day passes at the bus terminal on Washington Street — much easier than exact change.
- Horseshoe Bay is worth the trip. It's 25 minutes by bus or taxi. Go early — it fills up fast when multiple ships are in port.
