GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — main quay in town center; Fuglenes pier ~1 mile away

Walk to Center: Steps off the gangway — town is immediately walkable

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Royal & Ancient Polar Bear Society** — Visit the Isbjørnklubben museum near the harbor for Arctic hunting and exploration history.
- Salen Viewpoint Hike** — Follow the Zig-Zag Path up Salen hill (about 15-20 min on foot) for sweeping panoramic views over Hammerfest and the...
- Meridian Column (UNESCO)** — A 10-minute walk or quick taxi ride to the Fuglenes peninsula reveals the Meridian Column, the northernmost point of...
- Reconstruction Museum** — This moving museum tells the story of the Nazi scorched-earth policy that destroyed virtually all of Finnmark in 1944...
- Seiland National Park Boat Trip** — Venture by RIB or small boat to Seiland Island National Park, home to two of northern Europe's southernmost glaciers...

BEST WALKS

- Town Center & Polar Bear Society Loop** 1.5 km · 30-40 min · flat — From the main quay, walk along Strandgata into the town center.
- Salen Viewpoint via Zig-Zag Path** 2.5 km round trip · 45 min · moderate uphill — Head uphill from the town center on the well-marked Zig-Zag Path to the Salen lookout.
- Fuglenes Peninsula & Meridian Column** 3 km round trip · 45-60 min · easy — Follow the waterfront path west from the main quay to the Fuglenes peninsula.
