Docking: Docked at north riverfront dock (Center Street Landing area) — no tender required

Best For: Literary history, American heritage, river scenery, easy walkable town

Walk to center: 2-5 min walk from dock to Historic Main Street and Boyhood Home

Don't Miss: Mark Twain Boyhood Home & Museum, Tom & Huck Statue, Cardiff Hill Lighthouse

Getting around: **Taxi** Meter / call ahead · **Rideshare** Uber

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Mark Twain Boyhood Home & Museum** — Nine-property complex including Twain's actual boyhood home, the Becky Thatcher House, Huck Finn House, and a gallery...
 - **Mark Twain Cave Tour** — The National Natural Landmark that inspired the cave scenes in Tom Sawyer.
 - **Mark Twain Riverboat Cruise** — 1-hour narrated sightseeing cruise on the Mississippi River departing from Center Street Landing.
- **Jim's Journey: The Huck Finn Freedom Center** — A moving museum dedicated to the real man who inspired the character of Jim in Huckleberry Finn, and to the broader...
 - **Rockcliffe Mansion** — A Gilded Age mansion built in 1900 with original furnishings and sweeping views of the Mississippi.

BEST WALKS

- **Riverfront to Cardiff Hill Loop** 1.5 miles | Easy | 45-60 min — The classic Hannibal walk.
- **Historic Main Street Stroll** 0.5 miles | Flat | 30 min — Walk the length of Main Street from the river end to Bird Street and back.

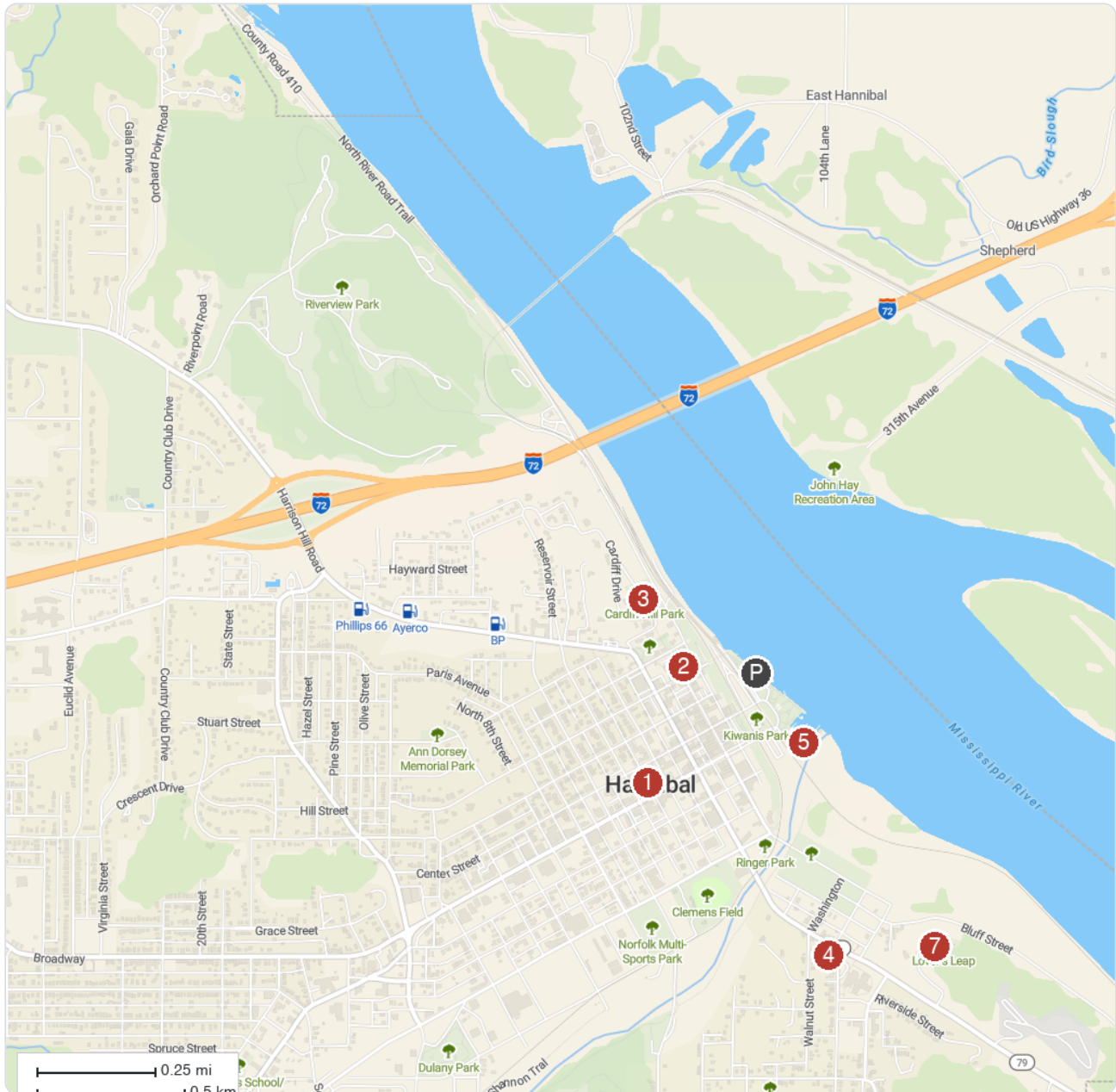
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Check your cruise inclusions first. American Cruise Lines and Viking often bundle the Mark Twain Museum ticket or trolley tour into their shore programs — buy independently only...
- Everything is walkable. The dock, Boyhood Home, Tom & Huck Statue, and Main Street are all within a 5-minute walk. You don't need a taxi or shuttle for the main sights.
- Summer means heat and humidity. July–August in Hannibal can be brutal — bring water, sunscreen, and a hat. Early-morning
