TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Herrenhausen Baroque Gardens** — One of Europe's finest Baroque garden complexes, laid out in the 17th century and inspired by Versailles.
- **The Red Thread Walking Route** — A 4.2 km red line painted on the city pavements links 36 historic sights — Old Town, the Nanas sculptures, Market...
- **New Town Hall & Dome Elevator** — The 1913 Neues Rathaus houses four scale models showing Hannover from medieval times to WWII rubble to modern city.
- **Eilenriede Urban Forest** — Germany's largest urban forest and one of the largest in Europe — nearly twice the size of New York's Central Park...
- **Hannover Markthalle (Market Hall)** — The city's historic indoor market — 'the Belly of Hannover' — is packed with stalls selling local sausages, fresh...

BEST WALKS

- **The Red Thread City Loop** 4.2 km • ~2–3 hrs • Easy — Follow the red line painted on the pavement from Hannover Hauptbahnhof through the Altstadt, past the Nanas sculptures on the Leine...
- **Maschsee Lakeside Stroll** 3 km loop • ~1 hr • Easy — The Maschsee is a large man-made lake south of the city centre, ringed by a paved promenade.

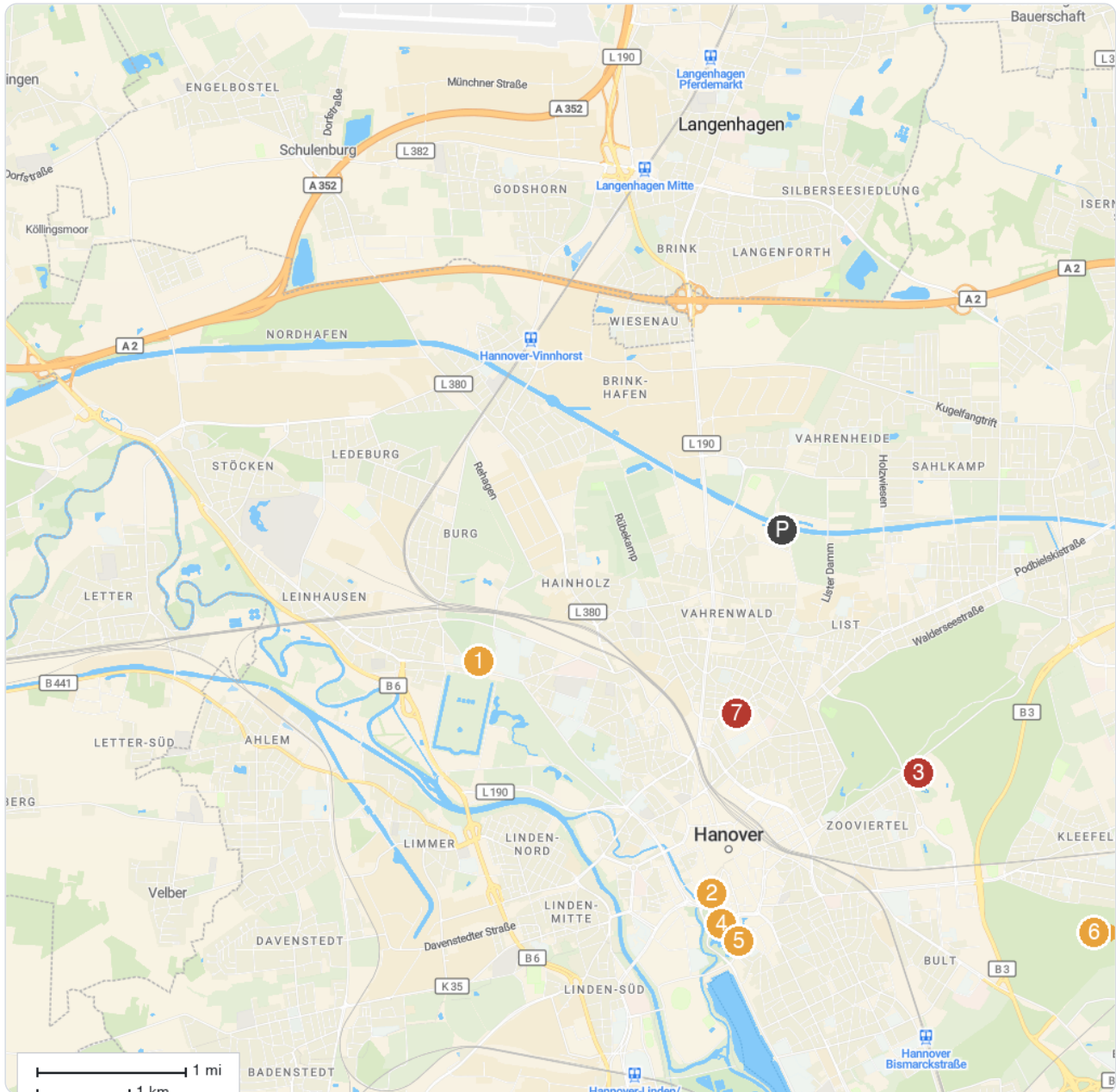
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Buy a GVH day pass first thing. The canal dock is not walkable to the centre — grab an unlimited TagesTicket (~€5) at any U-Bahn platform machine before leaving the dock area.
- Get the Red Thread booklet. The €3 guide from the Tourist Info office opposite the Hauptbahnhof turns a 4.2 km painted line into a full narrated city tour. Don't skip it.
