- **Ha Long Bay Junk Boat Cruise** — Sail among 1,600+ limestone karsts on a traditional junk.
- **Hanoi Old Quarter & Hoa Lo Prison** — The capital's maze of 36 historic trading streets, Hoan Kiem Lake with Ngoc Son Temple, and the sobering Hoa Lo Prison...
- **Temple of Literature & Water Puppet Show** — Van Mieu — Vietnam's 1,000-year-old first university — followed by a Thang Long Water Puppet Theatre performance.
- **Kayaking the Ha Long Karsts** — Paddle through sea caves, floating fishing villages, and towering limestone formations from Tuan Chau Marina near the...
- **Hanoi Street Food Walk** — Pho bo at a sidewalk stall, bun cha grilled pork (the Obama–Bourdain dish at Bun Cha Huong Lien), banh mi, and egg...

BEST WALKS

- **Hoan Kiem Lake Loop (Hanoi)** 1.8 km loop • Easy • 30–40 min — The peaceful heart of Hanoi.
- **Ha Long City Promenade** 2 km • Easy • 45 min — A flat walk along Ha Long's waterfront with bay views, souvenir shops, and cafes.

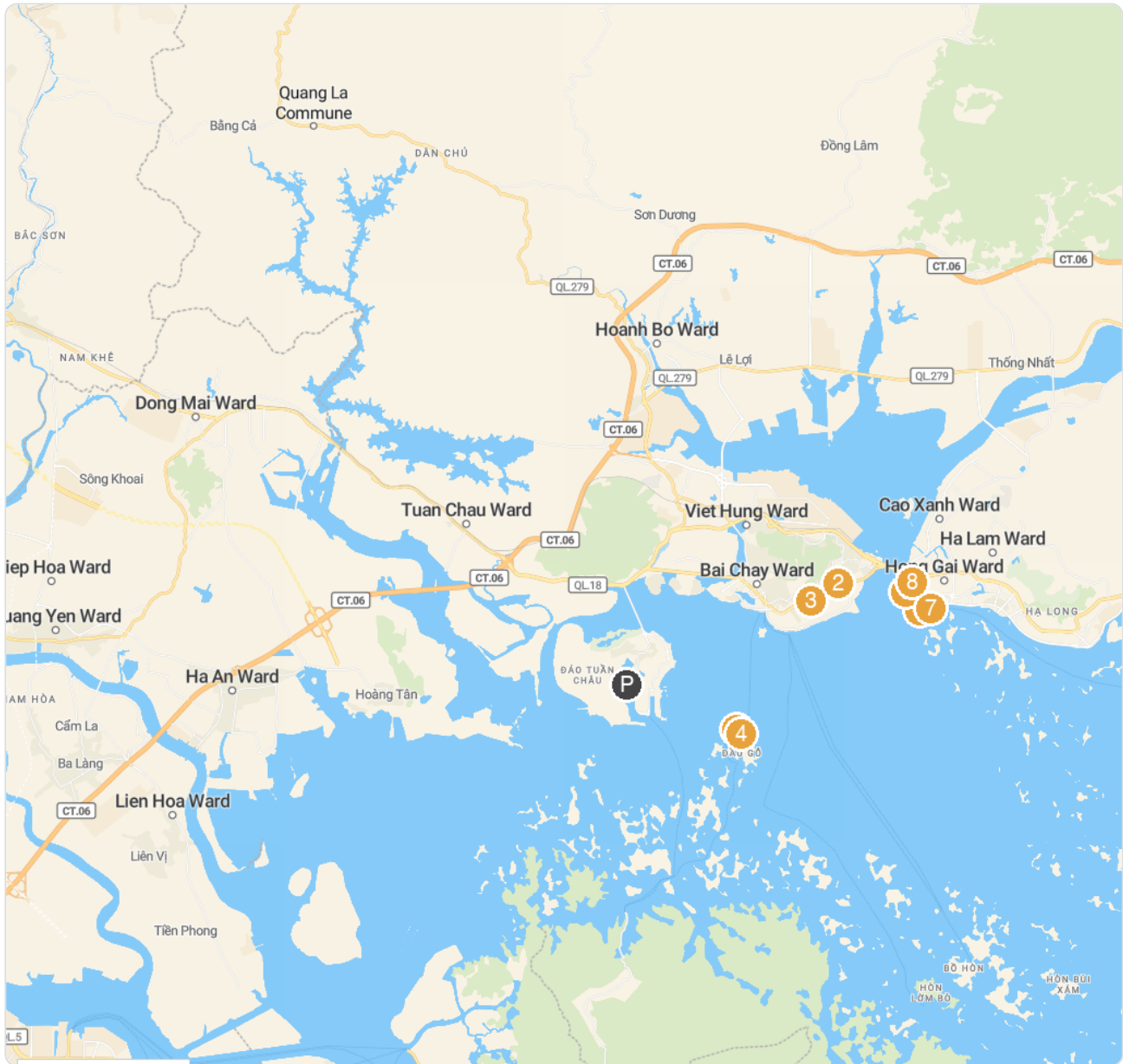
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Short call = stay local. Ha Long Bay requires only 10–30 min transit. Hanoi requires 3+ hrs each way — only realistic with 12+ hrs in port or an overnight stav.
