TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Nationaal Jenevermuseum** — Belgium's national jenever museum occupies a preserved 19th-century distillery.
- **Japanese Tuin (Japanese Garden)** — The largest traditional Japanese garden in Europe, gifted by Hasselt's sister city Itami (Japan).
- **Herkenrode Abbey** — Once the richest women's abbey in the Low Countries, Herkenrode sits just outside the city with restored buildings, an...
- **Street Art Trail** — Over 80 large-scale murals are spread through Hasselt's streets, making it one of Belgium's top street art cities.
- **Bokrijk Open-Air Museum** — A 15-minute taxi or bus ride from the port, this vast open-air museum recreates Flemish rural life with transplanted...

BEST WALKS

- **Canal to Grote Markt Loop** 2.5 km · 45 min · Easy · Flat — From the quay walk through Quartier Bleu's modern waterfront, past the Fashion Museum, through the Beguinage garden, and into the...
- **Street Art & Hidden Courtyards** 3 km · 1 hr · Easy · Self-guided — Pick up the free street art map at the Tourism Office and follow the mural trail through Hasselt's lanes.

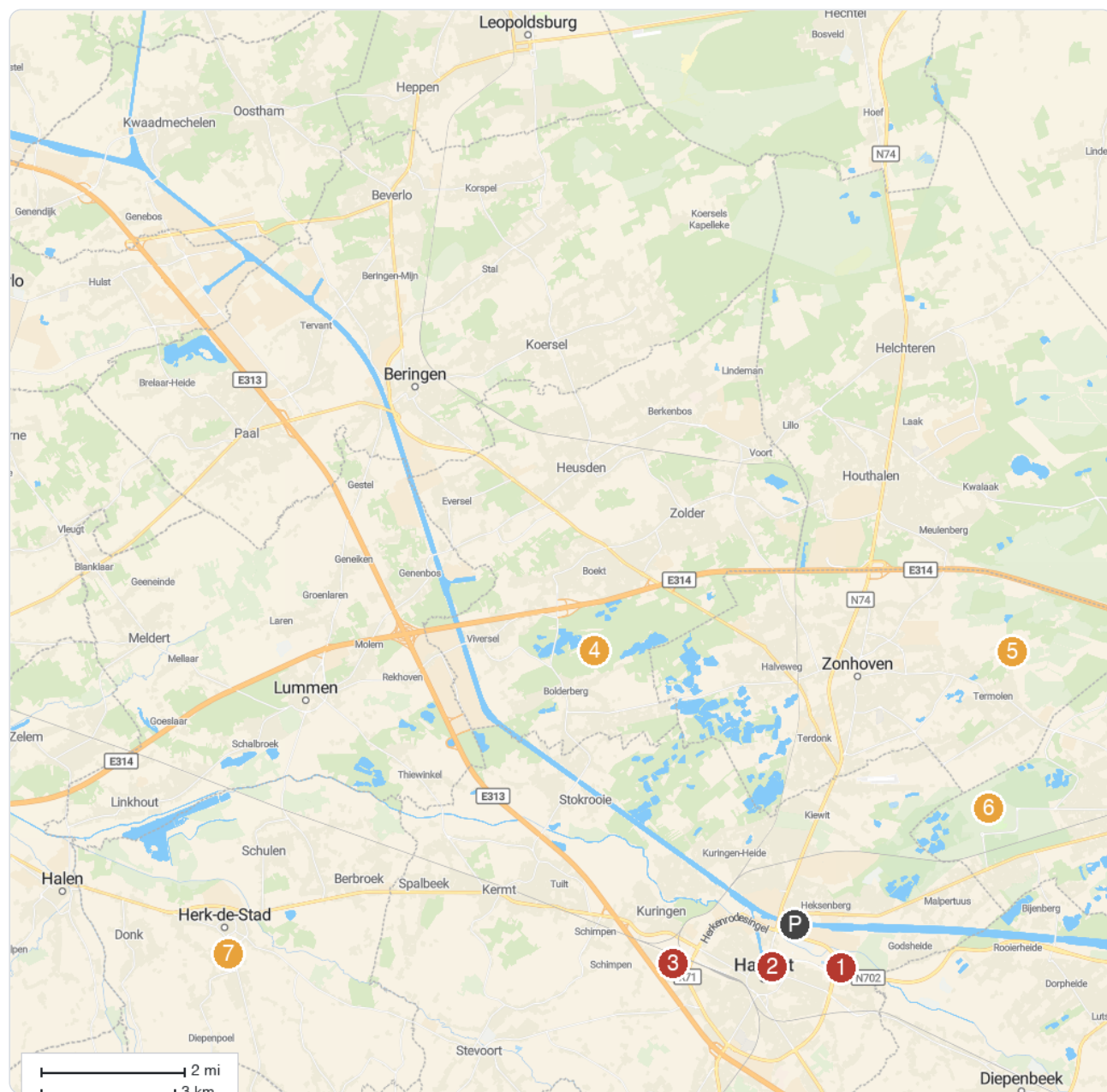
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
