GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Terminal Sierra Maestra, directly adjacent to Old Havana (Habana Vieja)

Walk to center: Walkable — Old Havana's main plazas are 5-10 min on foot from the pier

Best For: Colonial architecture, vintage car rides, Cuban music, and living history

Don't Miss: Plaza de la Catedral and a daiquiri at El Floridita, Hemingway's old haunt

- **Old Havana Walking Tour** — UNESCO-listed Habana Vieja is the core of any Havana visit.
- **Classic Car City Tour** — Havana's fleet of perfectly maintained 1950s American cars is genuinely remarkable — and renting one for a private city...
- **Live Music & Rum Experience** — Cuba is the birthplace of son cubano, salsa, and mambo.
- **Fortaleza de San Carlos de la Cabaña** — One of the largest fortresses in the Americas, built by the Spanish in the 18th century to defend Havana Harbor after...
- **Cuban Food & Market Tour** — Beyond mojitos and ropa vieja, Havana has a developing private-restaurant (paladar) scene worth exploring.

BEST WALKS

- **The Four Plazas of Habana Vieja** 2 km · 60-90 min · Easy — From the waterfront, walk to Plaza de San Francisco de Asís (the old trading square), then north along Calle Oficios to Plaza de Armas...
- **The Malecón Stroll** 2 km one-way · 30-40 min · Easy — Walk west from the edge of Old Havana along the Malecón, Havana's famous 8-km seawall boulevard.

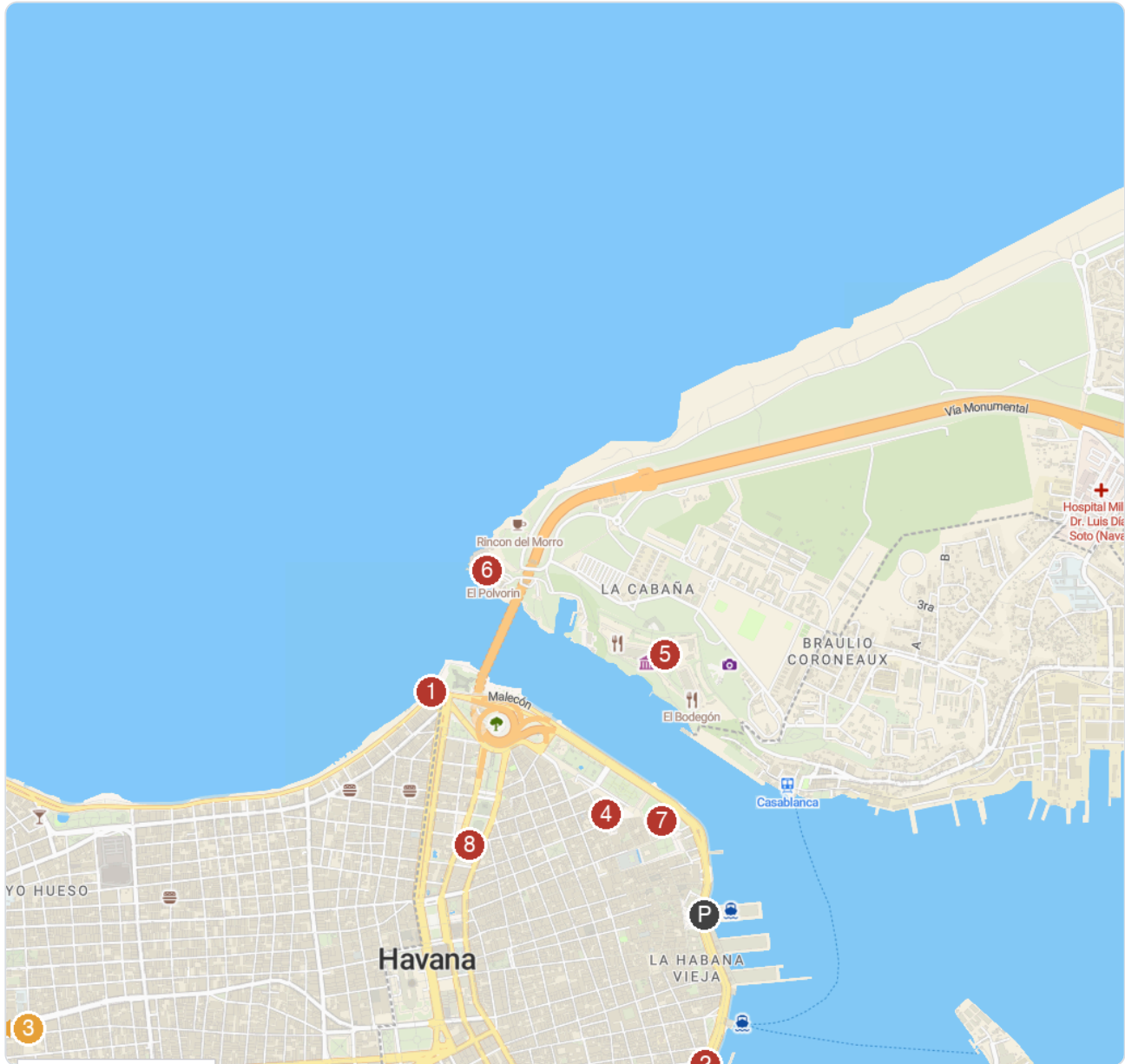
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
