GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Riverside pier — ship ties up directly; town center is a short walk

Best For: History lovers, cyclists, and those seeking a quiet, authentic German river town

Walk to center: 5–10 min flat walk to the island old town; 15–20 min uphill to the Dom

Don't Miss: Dom St. Marien (1170 AD) and the Prignitz Museum in the old monastery

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Dom St. Marien & Prignitz Museum** — The cathedral was consecrated in 1170 and blends Romanesque and Gothic styles.
- **Havelberg Old Town Island Walk** — Wander the cobblestone Stadtinsel and discover St.
- **Elbe Cycle Route Ride** — Havelberg sits on the famous Elberadweg (Elbe Cycle Route).
- **Haus der Flüsse (House of Rivers)** — An interactive nature and visitor centre dedicated to the Havel and Elbe river ecosystems — local flora, fauna, and the...
- **Riverside Dining at Restaurant Hoffnung** — The restaurant ship 'Hoffnung' is moored on the waterfront and serves regional dishes while boats pass by — a relaxing...

BEST WALKS

- **Island Old Town Loop** 1.5 km · 20 min · Easy, flat — A circuit of the Stadtinsel taking in the marketplace, St.
- **Cathedral Hill Climb** 1 km each way · 30 min round trip · Moderate (steep hill) — From the island, follow Domstraße uphill to Dom St.

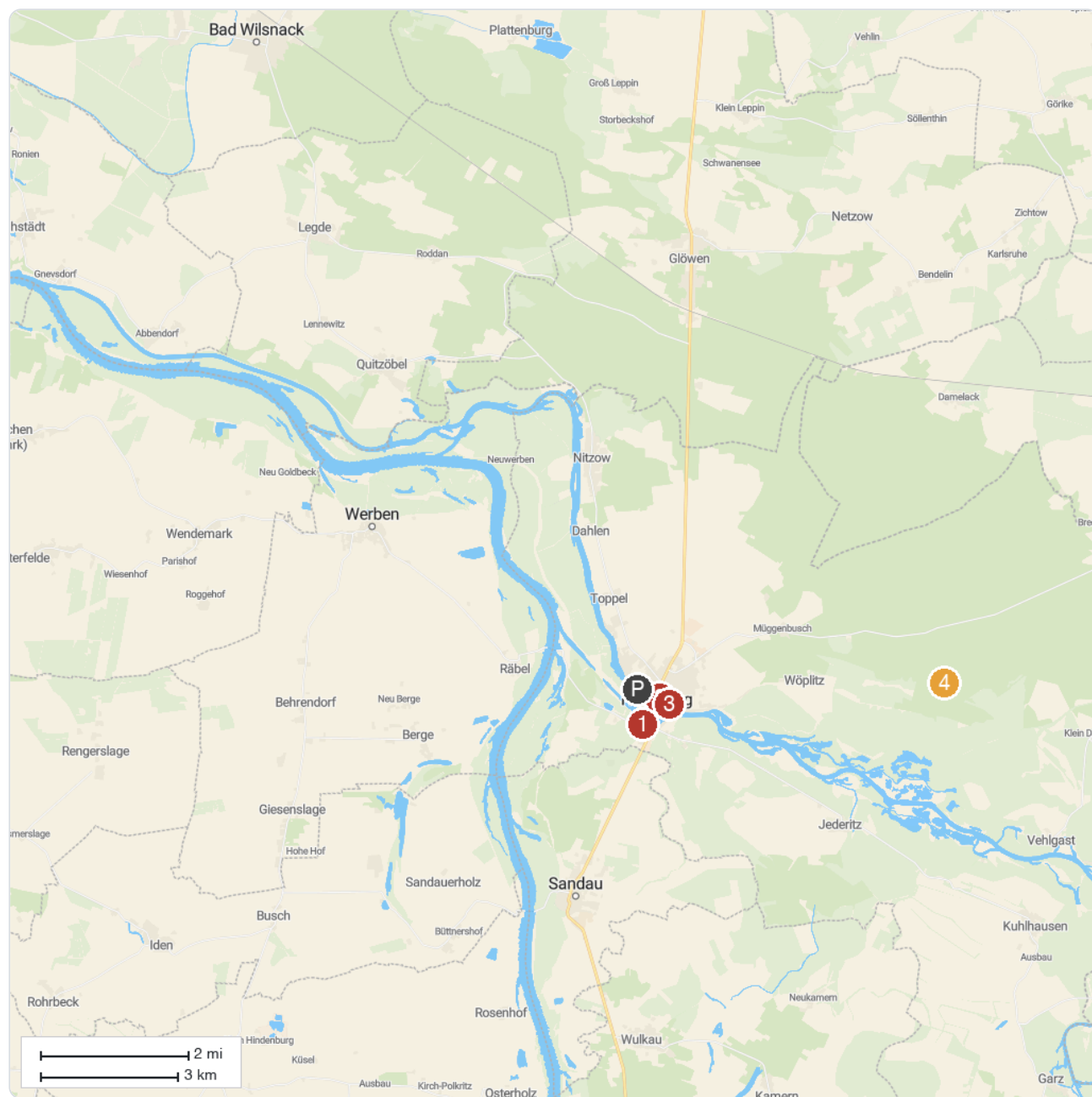
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Carry cash. Small-town Germany often prefers cash — bring Euros for museums, bakeries, and cafés.
- Bring or rent a bike. Havelberg is on the Elberadweg; flat riverbank paths make cycling the best way to explore beyond the island.
- The Dom climb is steep. It's a genuine uphill walk from the river — allow extra time and wear comfortable shoes. Taxis are available at the quay.
