

# Havre-Saint-Pierre, Quebec, Canada

One of North America's most remote cruise calls, Havre-Saint-Pierre opens the door to surreal limestone monoliths, Atlantic puffin colonies, and proud Acadian traditions on the subarctic North Shore of the Gulf of St. Lawrence.

## GETTING ASHORE

**Docking:** Tender — ships anchor; small boats ferry passengers to the town pier

**Best For:** Mingan Archipelago boat tours, puffin-watching, Acadian culture

**Walk to center:** 5 min from tender dock to main street (Rue de la Digue)

**Don't Miss:** Chicoutai (cloudberry) pie at Chez Julie; puffins on Île aux Perroquets

Getting around: **Taxi** ~CAD 10–15 per trip · **Rideshare** not available

## TOP THINGS TO DO

- Mingan Archipelago Monolith Boat Tour** — Cruise among the largest concentration of erosion monoliths in Canada — surreal limestone formations carved into...
- Puffin Colony at Île aux Perroquets** — This island hosts a breeding colony of Atlantic Puffins (June–late August) alongside a historic lighthouse.
- Acadian & Innu Cultural Visit** — Explore the Maison de la Culture Roland-Jomphe in the old Hudson's Bay Company building for multimedia exhibits on the...
- Boardwalk & Town Self-Guided Walk** — The Sentier de la Digue boardwalk runs along the St.
- North Shore Seafood & Cloudberry Tasting** — Chez Julie on Rue de la Digue is a port institution serving legendary seafood pizza piled with shrimp, scallops, and...

## BEST WALKS

- Boardwalk & Town Centre Loop** 1.5 km · 20-25 min · Easy — From the tender dock, walk along the Sentier de la Digue boardwalk past whale-watching benches and interpretive panels, then cut into...
- Church & La Grande Plage Stroll** 2 km · 30 min · Easy — Head inland briefly to see the historic wooden Saint-Pierre Church, then continue to La Grande Plage — a sweeping subarctic beach...

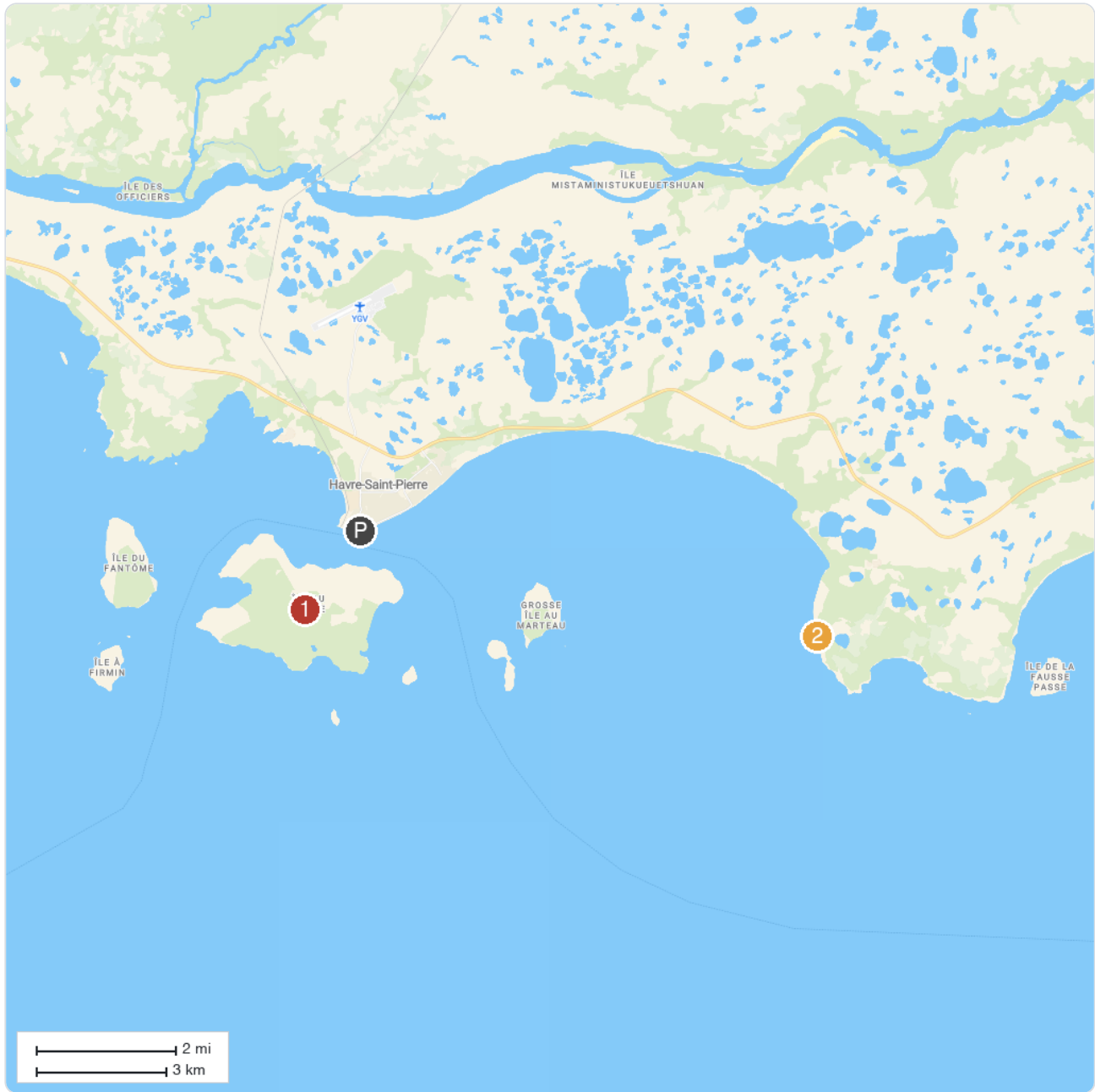
## KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
