GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Ships dock in Mannheim (~30 min) or Speyer (~45 min); motorcoach transfer to Heidelberg

Best For: Castle & history fans, romantic Old Town strolls, German food and wine

Walk to center: Coach drops at Marktplatz or Neckarmünzplatz — Old Town is entirely flat and walkable

Don't Miss: Heidelberg Castle terrace view, the Bronze Bridge Monkey on the Old Bridge, Student Prison

Getting around: Taxi €7–€15 · Rideshare Uber, Bolt

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Heidelberg Castle & Funicular** — Ride the historic Bergbahn funicular up to the sandstone ruins for panoramic views over the Neckar valley, then explore...
- Old Town Walking Tour** — Wander the Hauptstraße pedestrian zone, Marktplatz, and Kornmarkt — a Baroque city center that survived WWII intact.
- Student Prison (Studentenkarzer)** — From 1778 to 1914, the university jailed students for pranks and brawls here.
- Philosophers' Walk** — Cross the Old Bridge to the north bank, climb the steep Schlangenweg (Snake Path), and reach the hilltop promenade...
- Wine & Regional Food Tasting** — Sample Palatinate wines and regional specialties — Saumagen (stuffed pig's stomach), Maultaschen ravioli, and the...

BEST WALKS

- Old Town Core Loop** 1.5 km · 30–45 min · Flat — Start at the Old Bridge, walk west along the Neckar bank to Neckarmünzplatz, up to Marktplatz and the Church of the Holy Spirit...
- Castle Climb & Terrace View** 1 km · 20 min up · Steep cobblestones — From Kornmarkt, follow the Burgweg cobblestone path steeply up through the wooded hillside to the castle.
- Old Bridge to Philosophers' Walk** 2 km · 45–60 min · Steep then flat — Cross the Karl-Theodor Bridge (touch the Bridge Monkey for luck), then climb the Schlangenweg path up the north hill to the...

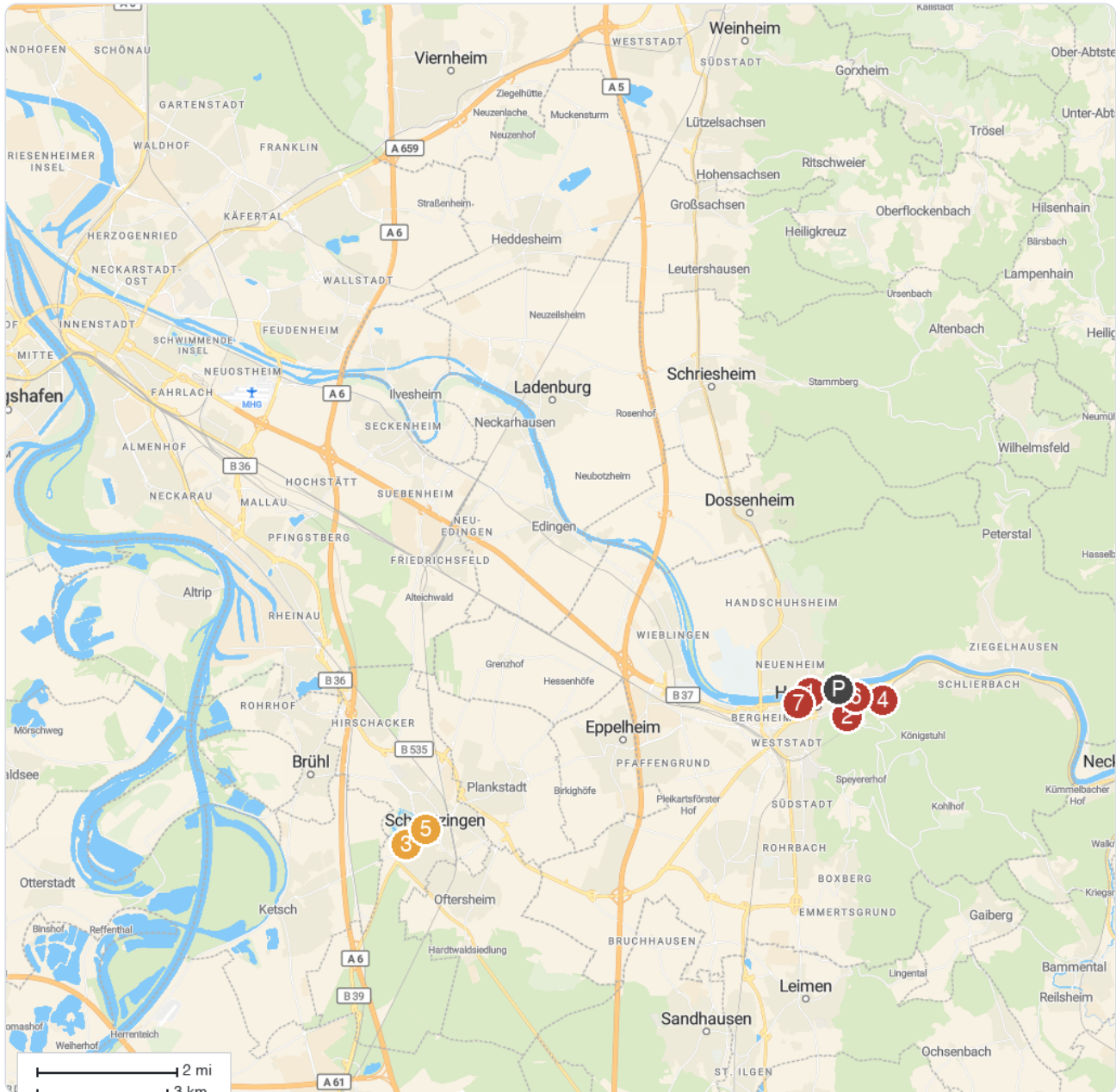
