GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — ships tie up directly to the Neckar riverbank, no tender

Best For: Wine lovers, science fans, history buffs, easy pedestrian city walking

Walk to center: 2–5 min from central Experimenta dock; 15–20 min from Wertwiesenpark dock

Don't Miss: Astronomical clock on the 1580 Town Hall and a glass of local Trollinger red wine

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Historic Marketplace & Astronomical Clock** — The 1580 Renaissance Town Hall holds one of Germany's finest astronomical clocks — watch it strike the hour as...
- **St. Kilian's Church (Kilianskirche)** — A towering Gothic and Renaissance landmark on the marketplace.
- **experimenta Science Center** — Germany's largest science center occupies a futuristic riverside building right at the main dock.
- **Neckar Wine & Swabian Food Tour** — Heilbronn is Germany's red wine capital, famous for Trollinger (light, served chilled) and Lemberger (rich, full-bodied).
- **Wartberg Hill Vineyard Walk** — A 45-minute uphill walk (or short taxi ride) through working vineyards leads to the Wartberg tower and sweeping...

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town Loop** 1.5 km · ~30 min · flat — From the central dock, cross the Adolf-Cluss-Brücke and walk to the Marketplace, passing St.
- **Wertwiesenpark Riverside Stroll** 2 km · ~35 min · flat — If docked at Wertwiesenpark, enjoy a scenic walk north through the rose gardens and reed-lined lakes of this 15-hectare park, then...

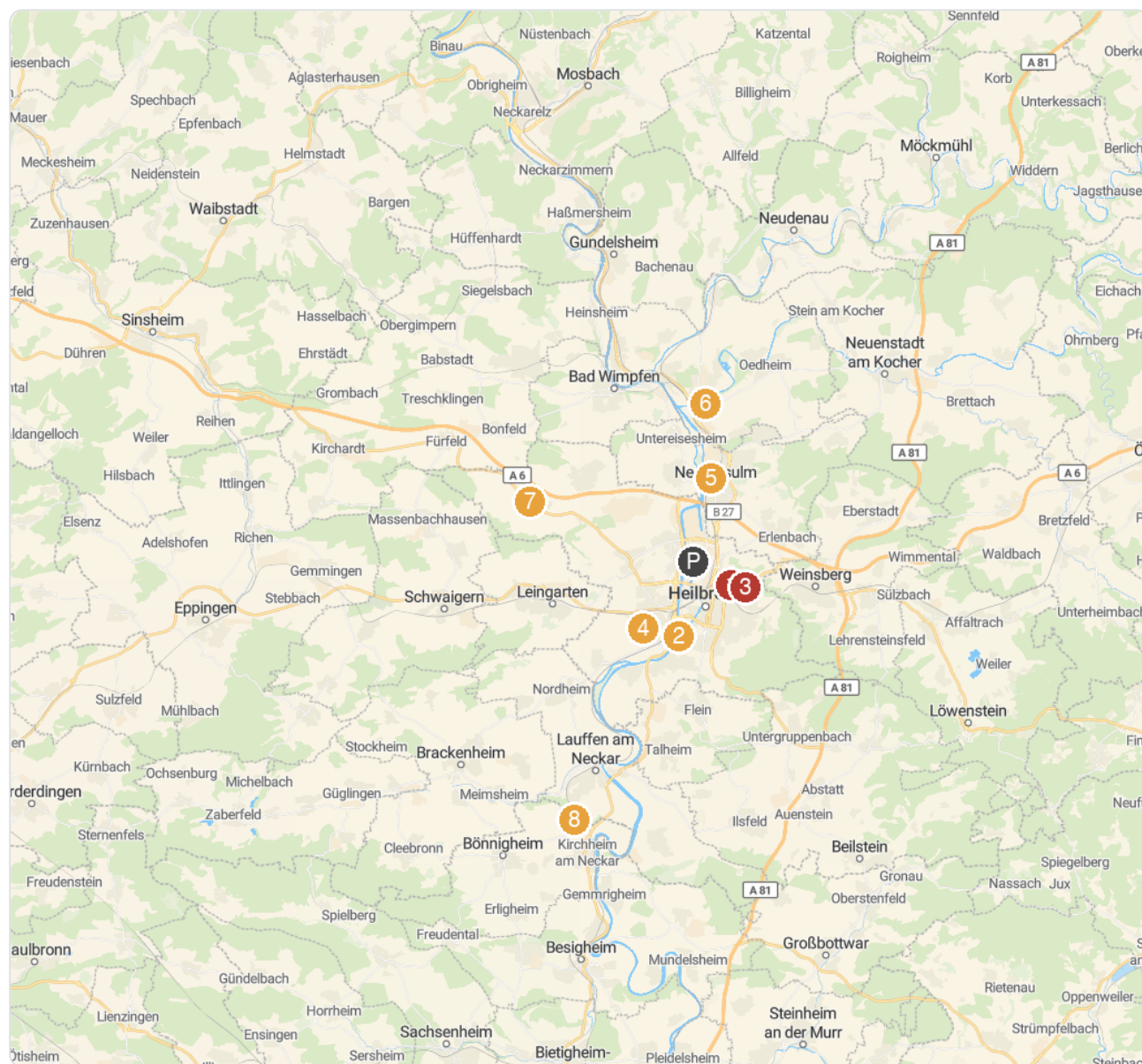
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
