GETTING ASHORE

- Docking:** Pier — City Pier (centre) or South Harbour (5–10 min ride); tender rare
- Walk to centre:** 0 min from City Pier; ~25–30 min or shuttle from South Harbour
- Best For:** History, day-trip to Denmark, Swedish fika, coastal walks
- Don't Miss:** Climbing Kärnan tower for views across the Öresund to Denmark

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  150–300 SEK ·  **Rideshare**  Uber, Bolt

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Climb Kärnan & the Castle Terraces** — The 35-metre medieval keep is all that survives of a mighty Danish fortress.
- Ferry to Helsingør & Kronborg Castle** — Board the Øresundslinjen ferry (20 min crossing) to Denmark and visit Kronborg — Shakespeare's Elsinore Castle and a...
- Sofiero Palace & Rhododendron Gardens** — Former royal summer residence 5 km north of town, world-famous for its spectacular rhododendron blooms (peak May–June)...
- Fredriksdal Open-Air Museum** — One of Sweden's largest open-air museums with 18th-century Skåne farmhouses, working period shops, a rose garden, and...
- Beach Fika & Kallbadhuset Sauna** — Helsingborg's 'Tropical Beach' near the harbour has sun loungers and a summer beach bar.

BEST WALKS

- Historic City Loop** 3 km · 1 hr · Easy — From the waterfront, walk Kullagatan (Sweden's oldest pedestrian shopping street) north to Stortorget (the main square) and the...
- Waterfront Promenade Stroll** 2 km · 40 min · Easy — Head north from the City Pier along Gröningen, the seaside promenade.

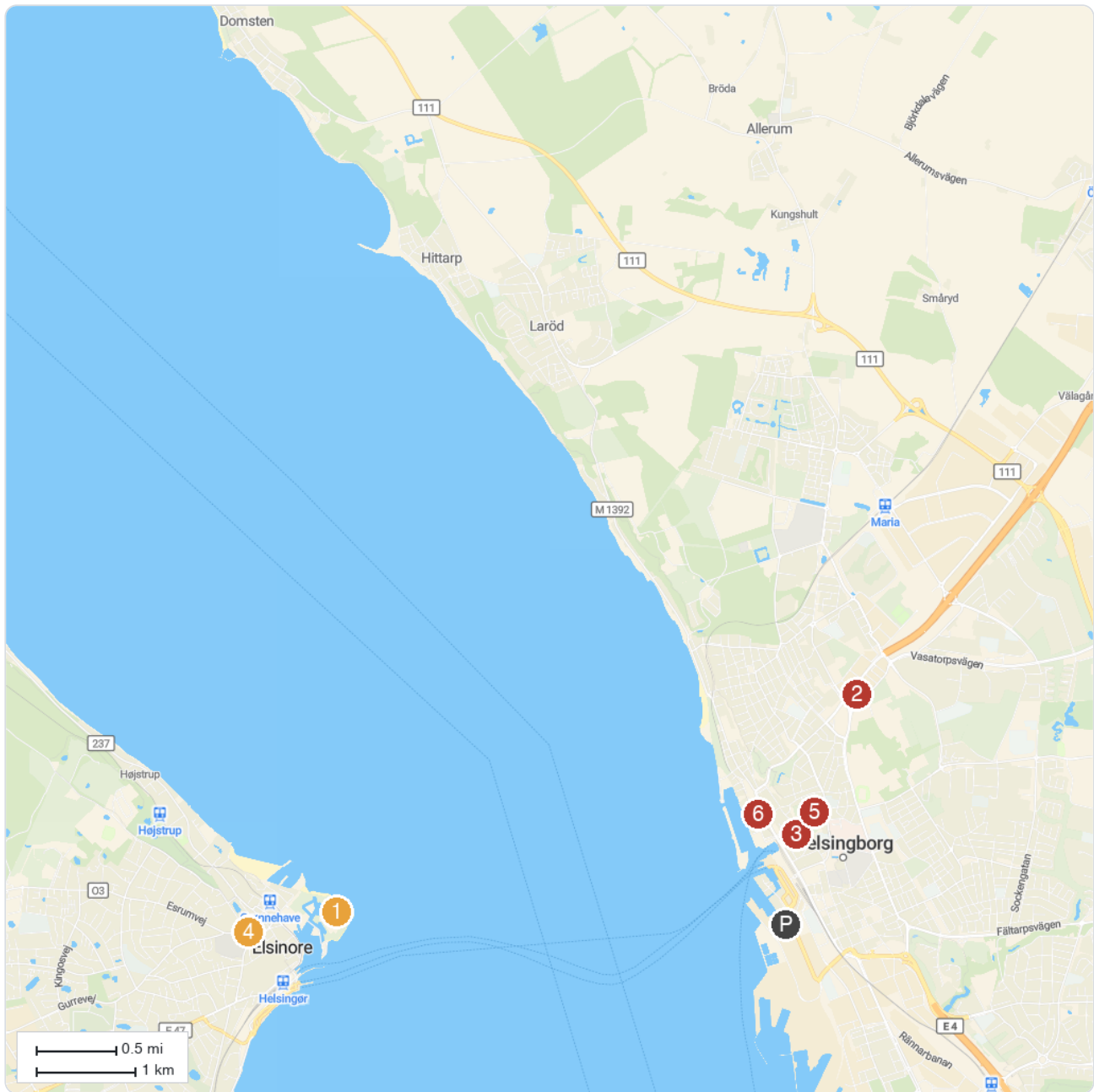
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Sweden is virtually cashless. Cards are accepted everywhere — including street food, public toilets, and city buses. No need to obtain Swedish Krona.
- The Denmark ferry is the highlight. The Øresundslinjen runs every 15–20 min from Krukkpunkten station — buy a cheap round-trip
