GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Ujina Wharf (smaller ships) or Itsukaichi Wharf (large ships)

Best For: History, culture, Miyajima Island day trip, Japanese food

Walk to center: Not walkable — 6 km from Ujina; shuttle or tram required

Don't Miss: Peace Memorial Museum + Miyajima floating Torii gate

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Peace Memorial Park & Museum** — The emotional heart of Hiroshima.
- **Miyajima Island & Itsukushima Shrine** — The sacred island famous for its vermilion Torii gate that appears to float at high tide.
- **Hiroshima Okonomiyaki Village** — Hiroshima's signature layered savory pancake — distinct from Osaka's version — is made with cabbage, pork, yakisoba...
- **Hiroshima Castle** — The 'Carp Castle,' a 1590s feudal castle reconstructed after the war.
- **Mt. Misen Ropeway, Miyajima** — Take the two-stage ropeway up to near the summit of sacred Mt.

BEST WALKS

- **Peace Park Loop** 1.5 km · 30–45 min · Flat — From the Peace Memorial Museum, walk to the Cenotaph, Children's Peace Monument, Peace Flame, and the A-Bomb Dome.
- **Miyajima Waterfront & Shrine** 1.5 km · 30 min · Easy flat stroll — From the Miyajima ferry pier, stroll the waterfront past tame deer to the Itsukushima Shrine entrance.

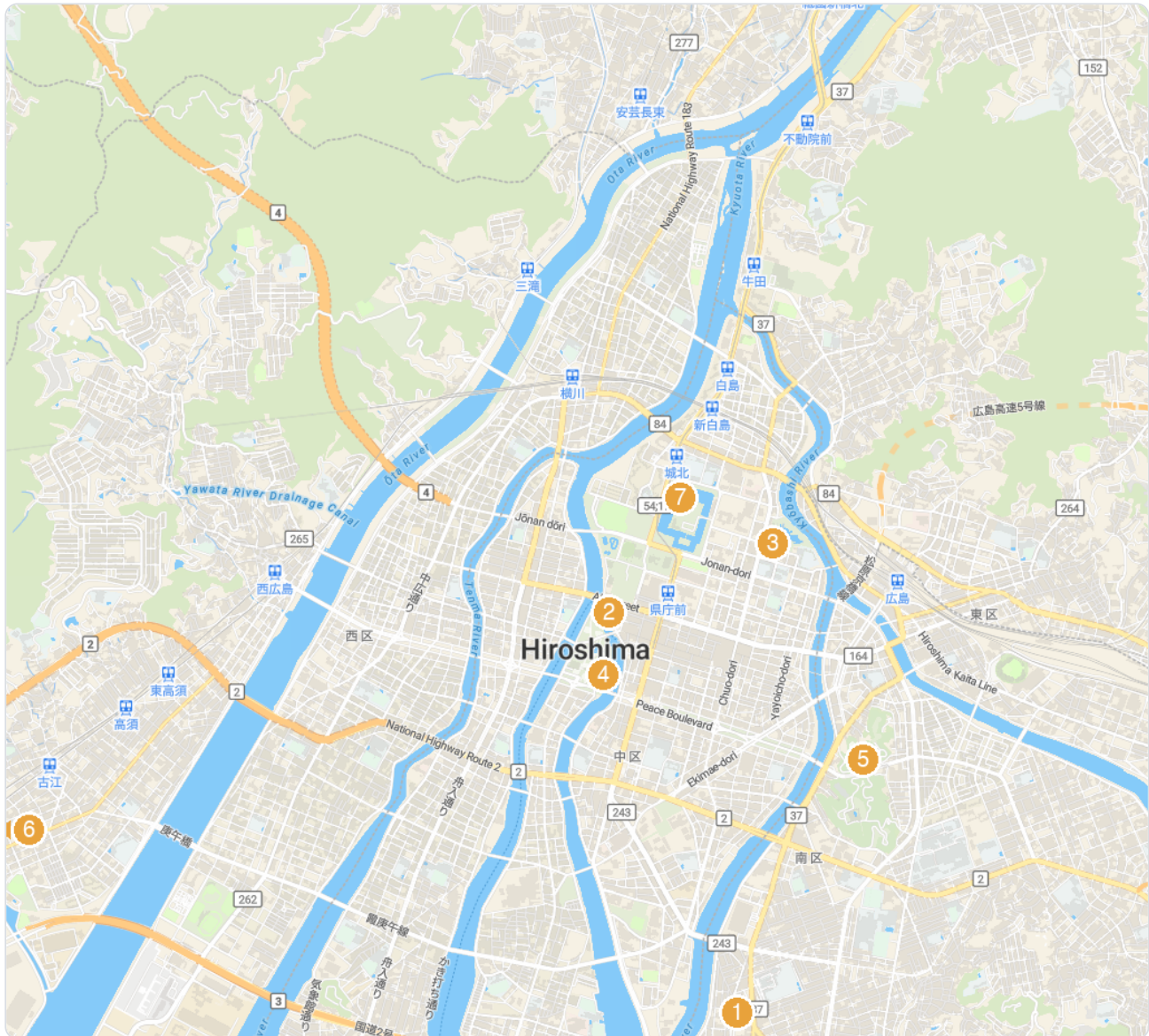
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Do both Peace Park and Miyajima if you have 9+ hours: take the Setonaikaikisen high-speed ferry from Ujina Port direct to Miyajima (~22 min), spend 3 hrs, then the Aqua Net World...
- Book Peace Memorial Museum tickets online before your cruise. Walk-up queues can be 30–60 minutes. Timed entry costs just 200 JPY / \$1.20 USD.
