

Hiva Oa, Marquesas Islands, French Polynesia

The wildest island in French Polynesia — volcanic peaks, ancient stone tikis, and the final resting place of Gauguin and Jacques Brel. No lagoons, no resort hotels, just raw Marquesas.

GETTING ASHORE

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Gauguin Cultural Center & Maison du Jouis** — Explore Gauguin's final years through high-quality reproductions of his Polynesian paintings and a replica of his infamous 'House of Pleasure' studio.
- Calvary Cemetery — Gauguin & Brel Graves** — A steep 15-minute walk from town leads to the hillside cemetery where both Gauguin and Brel are buried side by side with sweeping views of Atuona Bay.
- Espace Jacques Brel — Jojo's Hangar** — Jacques Brel spent his last years flying medical evacuations on this remote island.
- Tikis of Puamau — Me'ae Lipona** — The largest stone tiki statues in all of French Polynesia, including the 2.6-m Tiki Takaii, stand at this remote ceremonial site in the Puamau Valley.
- Taaoa Valley — Upeke Archaeological Site** — One of the largest ancient ceremonial complexes in the Marquesas, hidden in the jungle just 20 minutes from Atuona by 4x4.

BEST WALKS

- Atuona Village & Calvary Cemetery Loop** 3 km · 1.5–2 hrs · Moderate (hilly) — From the Gauguin Cultural Center, walk uphill through Atuona village past the red-stone Notre Dame church, then continue the steep climb to Calvary Cemetery for...
- Harbor to Atuona Black Sand Beach** 2 km one-way · 25 min · Easy (flat) — From Tahauku Harbor, follow the coastal road toward the mouth of the bay to reach the dramatic black volcanic sand beach.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Nonos are brutal. These tiny biting midges cause intensely itchy welts. Standard DEET often doesn't work — buy Monoi oil with citronella at the pier shop or bring high-concentration Picaridin before you leave the ship.
- Cash only, and the ATM runs dry. Bring XPF or euros — the single Banque Socredo ATM in Atuona often empties on cruise days. Credit cards accepted at the museums, rarely elsewhere.
- Puamau takes the whole day. The giant tikis at Me'ae Lipona are 2.5 hours each way by 4x4. Only attempt it if your ship is in port for 9+ hours and you pre-book a driver.
- Sunday closures. If you're in port on a Sunday, most shops and restaurants close. The artisans' market usually opens for cruise arrivals regardless.
- Eat local. Try poisson cru (raw fish in coconut milk) and Marquesan goat curry at Snack Temetiu. If you see a local selling giant pamplemousse (Marquesan grapefruit), buy one — they're extraordinary.
- Wild horses roam freely along the roads and ridges — a quirky Marquesan signature. They're generally gentle but give them space on narrow roads.

Paul Gauguin Cultural Center

Small museum in Atuona with reproductions of Gauguin's Marquesan-period paintings, since the originals are held abroad.

Calvary Cemetery

Hillside cemetery above Atuona where painter Paul Gauguin and singer Jacques Brel are both buried, with sweeping bay views.

Me'ae Iipona

Marquesas' largest restored ceremonial site, with some of Polynesia's tallest surviving stone tiki figures.

Taaoa Petroglyphs

Ancient rock carvings and a restored marae complex in a valley a short drive from Atuona.
