TOP THINGS TO DO

- **MONA — Museum of Old and New Art** — Australia's most talked-about gallery is a 25-minute ferry ride up the Derwent River.
 - **kunanyi / Mount Wellington Summit** — The 1,271 m peak towers over the city and offers panoramic views to the Derwent Valley and Southern Ocean.
 - **Port Arthur Historic Site** — A UNESCO World Heritage-listed convict settlement on the Tasman Peninsula, about 90
- minutes by road.

 - **Bonorong Wildlife Sanctuary** — Hand-feed kangaroos and get close to Tasmanian devils at this conservation sanctuary 25 minutes north of Hobart.
 - **Richmond Village & Oldest Bridge** — A well-preserved Georgian village 25 km from Hobart, home to the oldest bridge in Australia (1823) and the oldest...

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront to Salamanca Loop** 1.5 km | Easy | 30-45 min — Walk from Macquarie Wharf along the waterfront past Constitution Dock and Fishing boat harbour to Salamanca Place, then loop back via...
- **Battery Point Heritage Walk** 2 km | Easy | 45-60 min — From Salamanca Place, climb the short rise into Battery Point — Hobart's oldest residential suburb with 19th-century cottages, St...
