GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Ocean Terminal (central Tsim Sha Tsui) or Kai Tak Cruise Terminal (Kowloon Bay — not walkable to city centre)

Walk to centre: Ocean Terminal: steps from Harbour City mall and Star Ferry. Kai Tak: taxi or shuttle required (~15-25 min to TST)

Best For: Harbour skylines, dim sum and Cantonese food, street markets, temples, cable cars, and the Big Buddha

Don't Miss: Victoria Peak at golden hour and the Star Ferry crossing at dusk — ideally timed for the 8 PM Symphony of Lights

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Victoria Peak & Peak Tram** — Ride the historic funicular railway up a stomach-tilting 45° incline to Hong Kong's most famous viewpoint.
- **Lantau Island — Big Buddha, Po Lin & Tai O** — Take the MTR to Tung Chung then the Ngong Ping 360 cable car for sweeping South China Sea views before reaching the...
- **Star Ferry & Symphony of Lights** — The 10-minute Star Ferry crossing between Tsim Sha Tsui and Central costs HKD 3-4 and delivers a front-row seat to one...
- **Dim Sum & Cantonese Food Tour** — Dim sum in Hong Kong is a ritual — steamer baskets of har gow, siu mai, char siu bao, and egg tarts in a packed...
- **Kowloon Temples — Wong Tai Sin & Chi Lin Nunnery** — Wong Tai Sin Temple is one of Hong Kong's most vivid Taoist shrines — colourful, active, and alive with fortune-tellers...

BEST WALKS

- **Tsim Sha Tsui Waterfront to Mong Kok Markets** 4 km · Easy · ~2 hrs — Start at Ocean Terminal and walk the TST Promenade past the Avenue of Stars and the Clock Tower for harbour views.
- **Central Mid-Levels Escalator & Hollywood Road** 2 km · Easy · ~1 hr — Ride the world's longest outdoor covered escalator system from Central Market up through SoHo — packed with independent cafes...

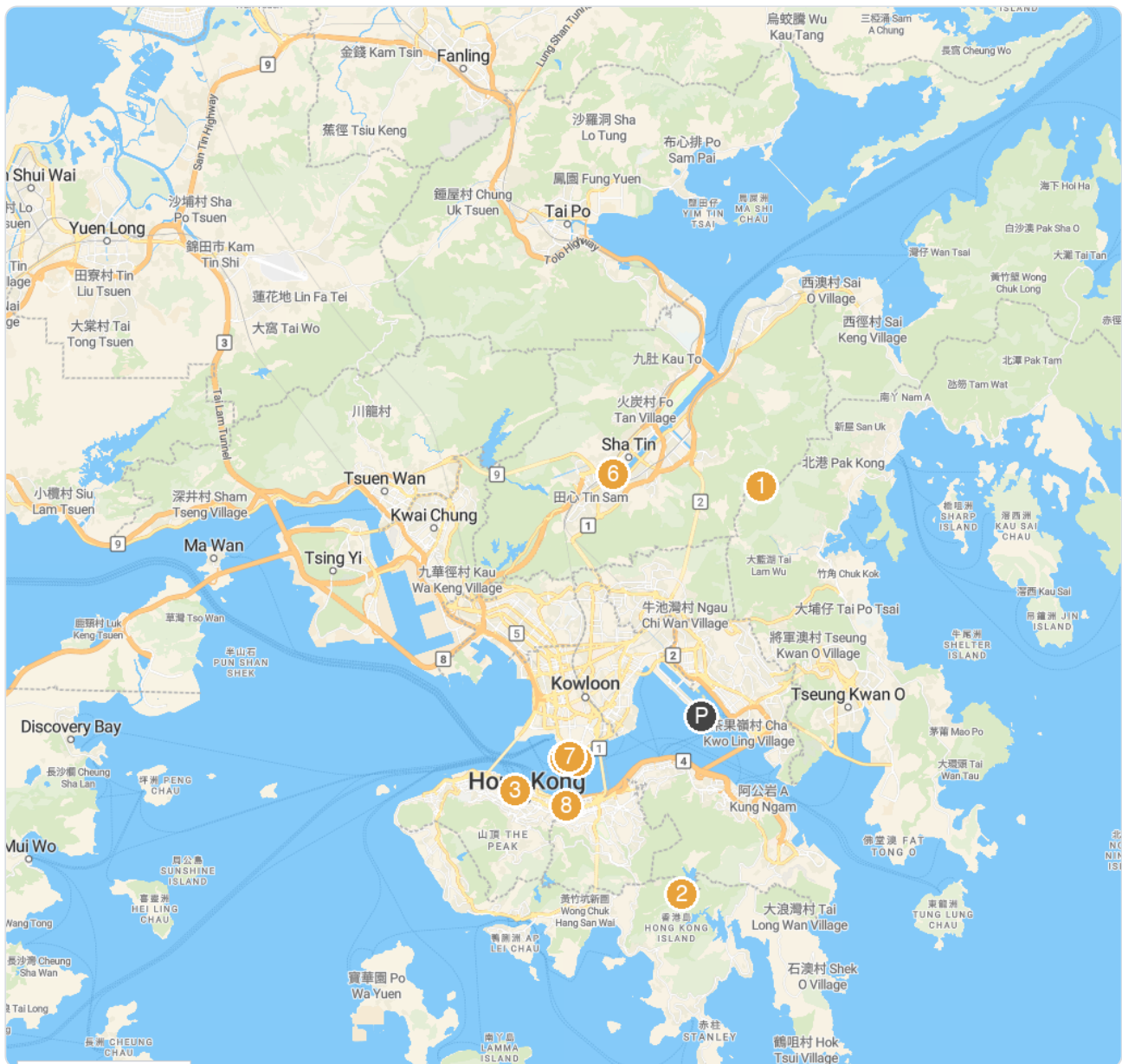
