TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Capelinhos Volcano** — Walk across black ash fields from the 1957–58 eruption that added new land to Faial, then descend into the...
- **Whale & Dolphin Watching** — The Azores is one of the world's premier whale-watching destinations.
- **Caldeira do Faial Crater Hike** — Drive to the island's volcanic core and walk the rim of a 2 km-wide lush green caldeira, 400 m deep.
- **Horta Marina Wall Art** — Sailor superstition demands every yacht crew leave a painted mural on the marina walls or risk bad luck at sea.
- **Peter Cafe Sport & Scrimshaw Museum** — The world's most famous sailor's bar has been serving Atlantic crossers since 1918.

BEST WALKS

- **Harbourfront to Marina & Porto Pim** 2.5 km · 40 min · Flat — Walk west from the pier along the Avenida Marginal to the marina to see the famous sailor murals, then continue south along Porto Pim...
- **Town Centre Stroll** 1.5 km · 30 min · Flat — Head into Horta's centre, stopping at the Igreja Matriz de São Salvador for its ornate azulejo tilework, then on to Peter Cafe Sport...

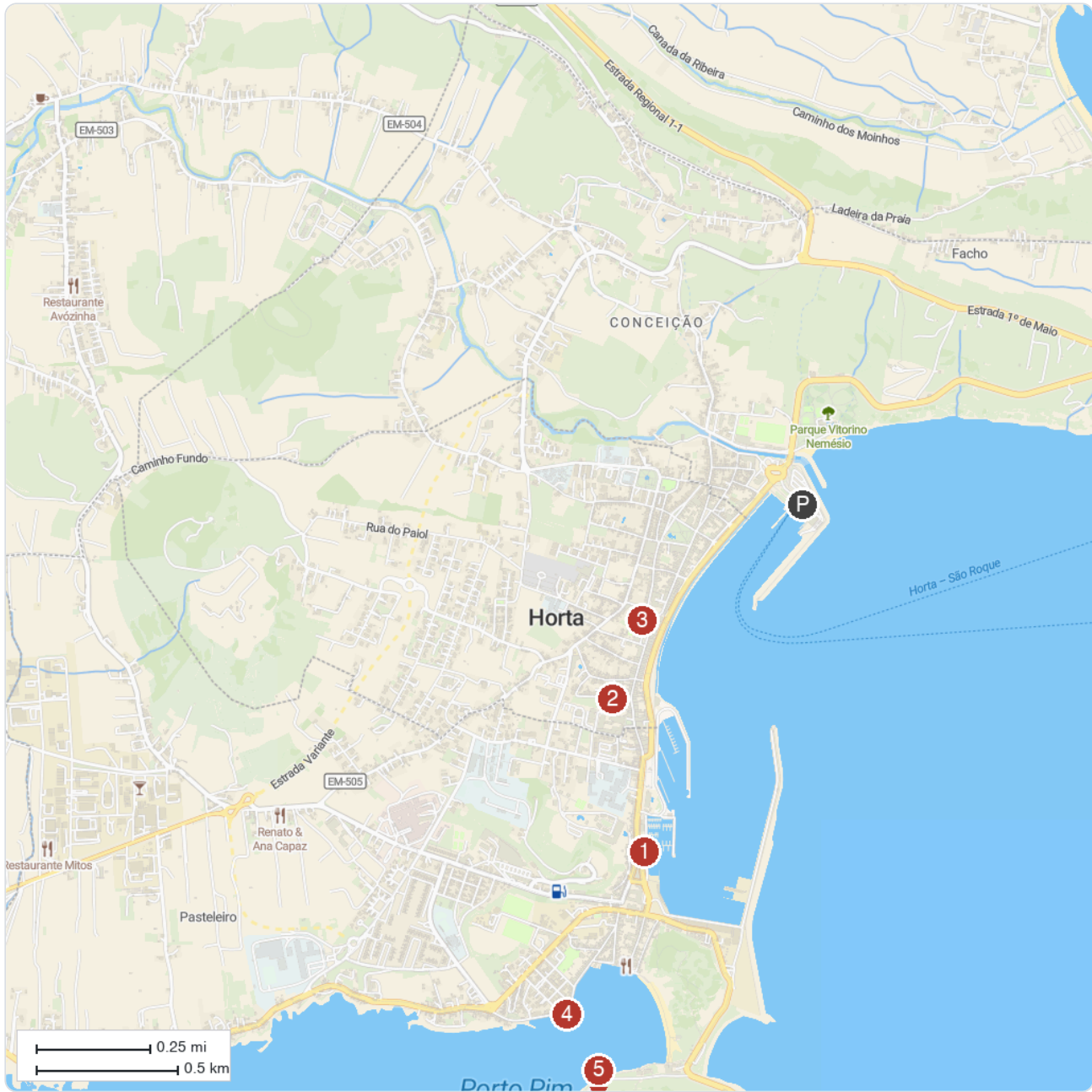
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Pack a rain layer: Azorean weather is famously changeable — sun, rain, and mist can all happen in one hour. A packable waterproof jacket is essential year-round.
- Azores time is GMT-1: One hour behind mainland Portugal and two behind Western Europe. Your ship will post its official port time — double-check before going ashore.
