- **Nine Bays Boat Tour** — Charter a panga or catamaran from the marina to cruise the bays accessible only by sea — snorkel in hidden coves, spot...
- **Beach Day at Playa Maguey** — Ten minutes by taxi, this golden-sand bay is lined with palapa restaurants.
- **Snorkeling at Playa La Entrega** — A protected cove with a coral reef teeming with tropical fish.
- **Copalita Archaeological Zone** — The only major Mesoamerican site on Mexico's Pacific coast — 2,500-year-old ruins with a ball court and museum set in...
- **La Crucecita Market & Oaxacan Lunch** — Walk the zócalo, see the famous 65-foot Virgin of Guadalupe ceiling mural, then sit down for mole negro and mezcal at a...

- **Pier to Playa Santa Cruz & Marina** 10–15 min · Easy · Free — A flat waterfront stroll from the ship to the beach and marina.
- **La Crucecita Town Walk** 30 min walk or 5-min taxi · Easy · Free — The real town of Huatulco.

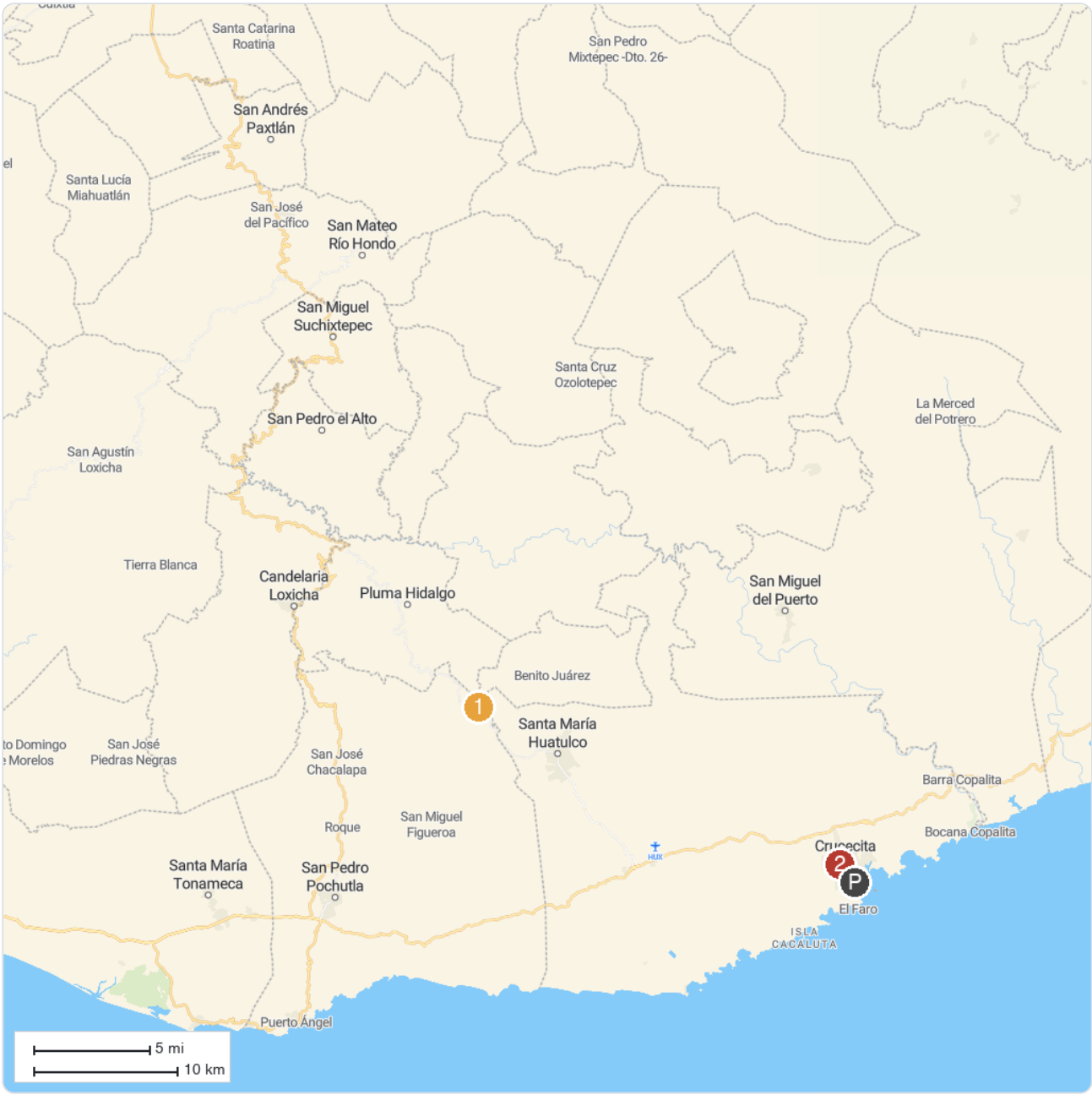
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Pay in pesos. USD is accepted but you'll get a poor rate. ATMs are at the Santa Cruz plaza, 3 minutes from the gangway.
- Taxis have fixed rates. Check the green fare board at the pier exit before you leave — it lists official prices to every beach and to La Crucecita.
- Playa Chahué looks stunning but has strong undertow. Stick to Santa Cruz or Maguey for swimming; Chahué is for photos and walking.
