GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier at Muelle Sur outer port (~15 km from city center); shuttle provided. Luxury/small ships may use inner Muelle de Levante.

Best For: Columbus history, Ibérico ham & white prawns, Doñana Nature Reserve, off-the-beaten-track Andalusia

Walk to center: Not walkable from Muelle Sur — take cruise shuttle or taxi (20 min). Inner port: 15-20 min walk.

Don't Miss: Boarding the replica Columbus caravels at Palos de la Frontera (€3.60)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Columbus Caravels & La Rábida Monastery** — Board full-scale replicas of the Niña, Pinta, and Santa María at Palos de la Frontera, then walk to the 15th-century...
- **Doñana National Park 4x4 Safari** — One of Europe's most important wetlands — flamingos, Iberian lynx, and wild horses.
- **Barrio Reina Victoria (British Mining Quarter)** — Walk through a surreal neighborhood of Victorian English cottages built for Rio Tinto Company workers from 1916 through...
- **Huelva Gastronomy Tour** — Huelva was Spain's Capital of Gastronomy 2017.
- **Day Trip to Seville** — Seville's Alcázar palace, Cathedral, and Giralda tower are 75 minutes away.

BEST WALKS

- **City Center Highlights Walk** 2.5 km · 45–60 min · Easy · Free — From the shuttle drop near Casa Colón, walk to Plaza de las Monjas and the Columbus statue, then follow Calle Concepción to the Tinto...
- **Columbus Monument & Cinta Hermitage** 4 km · 75 min · Easy · Free — Walk or take a short taxi to the giant Columbus monument at Punta del Sebo, then continue uphill to the 15th-century Hermitage of...

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Confirm your pier before planning. Large ships dock 15 km out at Muelle Sur — shuttle is free but check departure times back to ship carefully.
- Eat the white prawns. Gambas blancas de Huelva are a world-class delicacy, usually just boiled with sea salt. Don't leave without

- 1** Parroquia Mayor de San Pedro de Huelva Huelva's main parish church, a historic religious landmark.
- 3** Parque Moret Huelva's largest urban park, great for nature walks.
- 5** Zafra Park Central urban park with playgrounds and green spaces.
- 7** Muelle de las Carabelas Museum with replicas of Columbus's three discovery caravels.
- P** Cruise port / terminal

- 2** La Rabida Monastery Historic monastery where Columbus planned his first voyage.
- 4** Monumento a la Virgen del Rocío Monument honoring the Virgin of El Rocío, a pilgrimage site.
- 6** La Fontanilla Popular beach in Matalascañas, known for its lighthouse.
- 8** Plus Ultra monument Monument commemorating the first transatlantic flight from Spain.
