GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Direct pier at Hundested Havn — two cruise quays up to 350 m

Walk to centre: ~5 min (300–400 m) to harbor shops and restaurants

Best For: Artisan culture, seafood, polar history, easy day trips

Don't Miss: Knud Rasmussen's House and the glassblowing studios on the quay

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  80–150 DKK (~\$12–23 USD) for short local trips

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Knud Rasmussen's House** — The preserved cottage of Denmark's greatest polar explorer sits on the cliffs above the lighthouse, filled with Arctic...
- **Artisan Harbor Walkabout** — Wander the Kulturhavn and duck into open glassblowing studios, ceramic workshops, and galleries.
- **Spodsbjerg Lighthouse & Coastal Path** — Follow the Fyrstien coastal path from the harbor up 30-metre moraine cliffs to the lighthouse (current tower built...
- **Day Trip: Frederiksborg Castle** — Hop the local train to Hillerød for Denmark's finest Renaissance castle — the 'Danish Versailles' set on a lake, now...
- **Trekanten Beach** — A Blue Flag sandy beach protected by breakwaters, just 3 minutes' walk from the ship.

BEST WALKS

- **Harbor & Artisan Quarter Loop** 1.5 km · 25 min · flat — From the cruise quay, stroll the length of Kulturhavn past workshops and galleries, swing through town past the train station, and...
- **Fyrstien — Lighthouse Cliff Walk** 3.5 km one-way · ~50 min · moderate — Head north from the harbor along the coastal path past Trekanten Beach, up the heathland cliffs to Spodsbjerg Lighthouse and Knud...

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

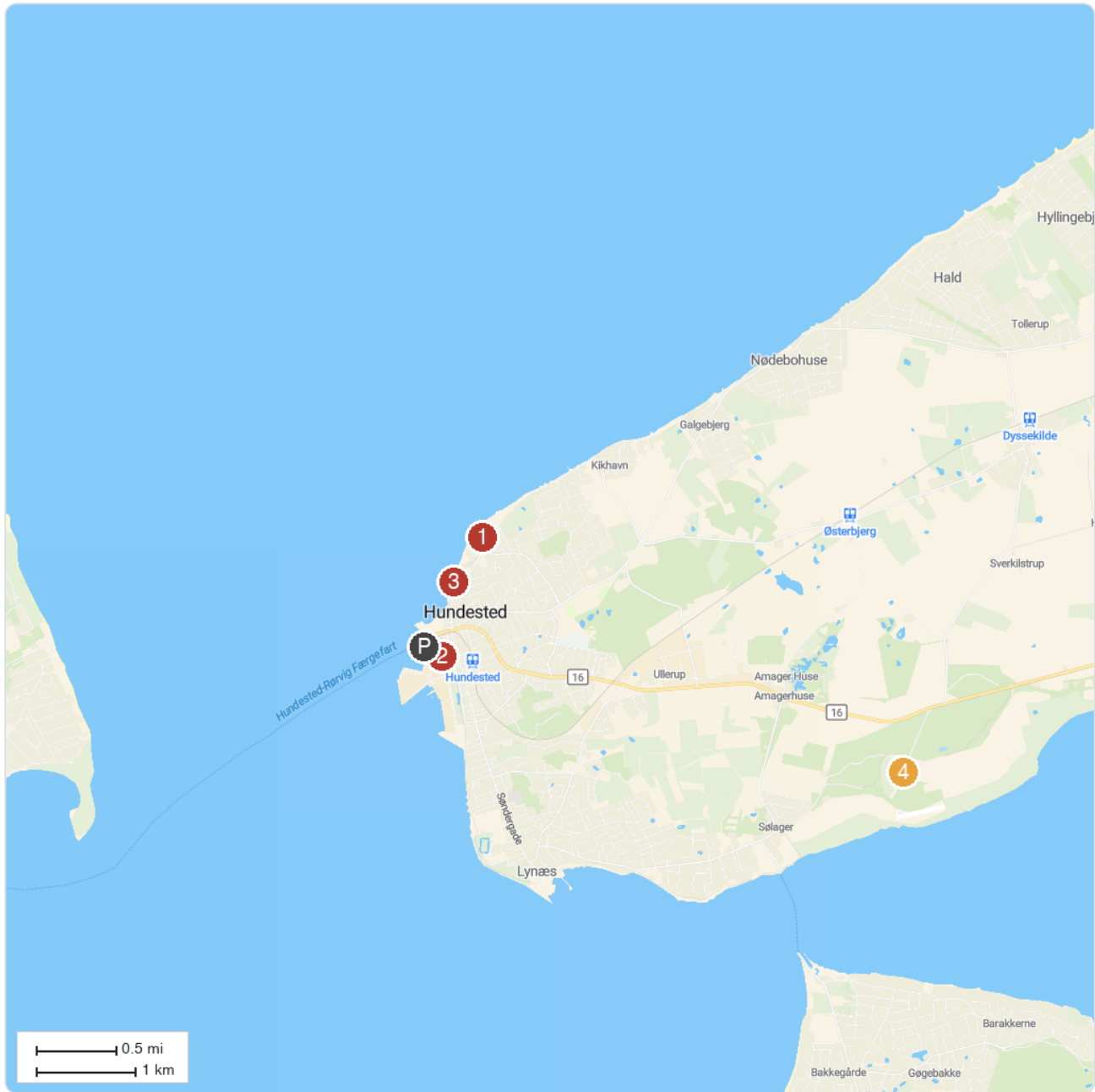
- Go cashless. Denmark is virtually card-only — Visa and Mastercard are accepted everywhere in Hundested, including street food stalls and museum entry.

Book a windproof layer. Hundested is on a peninsula and can be breezy, even in summer. — the lighthouse walk especially feels
