- Huntington Museum of Art** — West Virginia's largest art museum holds American and European paintings, stunning art glass collections (Blenko and...
- Heritage Farm Museum & Village** — A Smithsonian-affiliate outdoor museum with seven galleries on pioneer and Appalachian life, a petting zoo, wagon...
- Huntington Hot Dog Tour** — Huntington is famous for its distinct style of hot dog — a steamed bun topped with chili, coleslaw, and mustard.
- We Are Marshall Heritage Walk** — The 1970 plane crash that killed nearly the entire Marshall University football team profoundly shaped Huntington.
- Camden Park Amusement Park** — One of America's oldest continuously operating amusement parks, with classic rides, water slides, mini-golf, and paddle...

BEST WALKS

- Riverfront to Downtown Heritage Walk** 1.5 miles · Easy · 30-45 min — Walk from the park through the floodwall, up to Heritage Station, through the 4th Avenue corridor to Pullman Square, and back along...
- Ritter Park Stroll** 2 miles round-trip in park · Easy · 45 min — A short Uber ride gets you to Huntington's crown-jewel park — a 67-acre green space with a famous rose garden, Four Pole Creek trail...

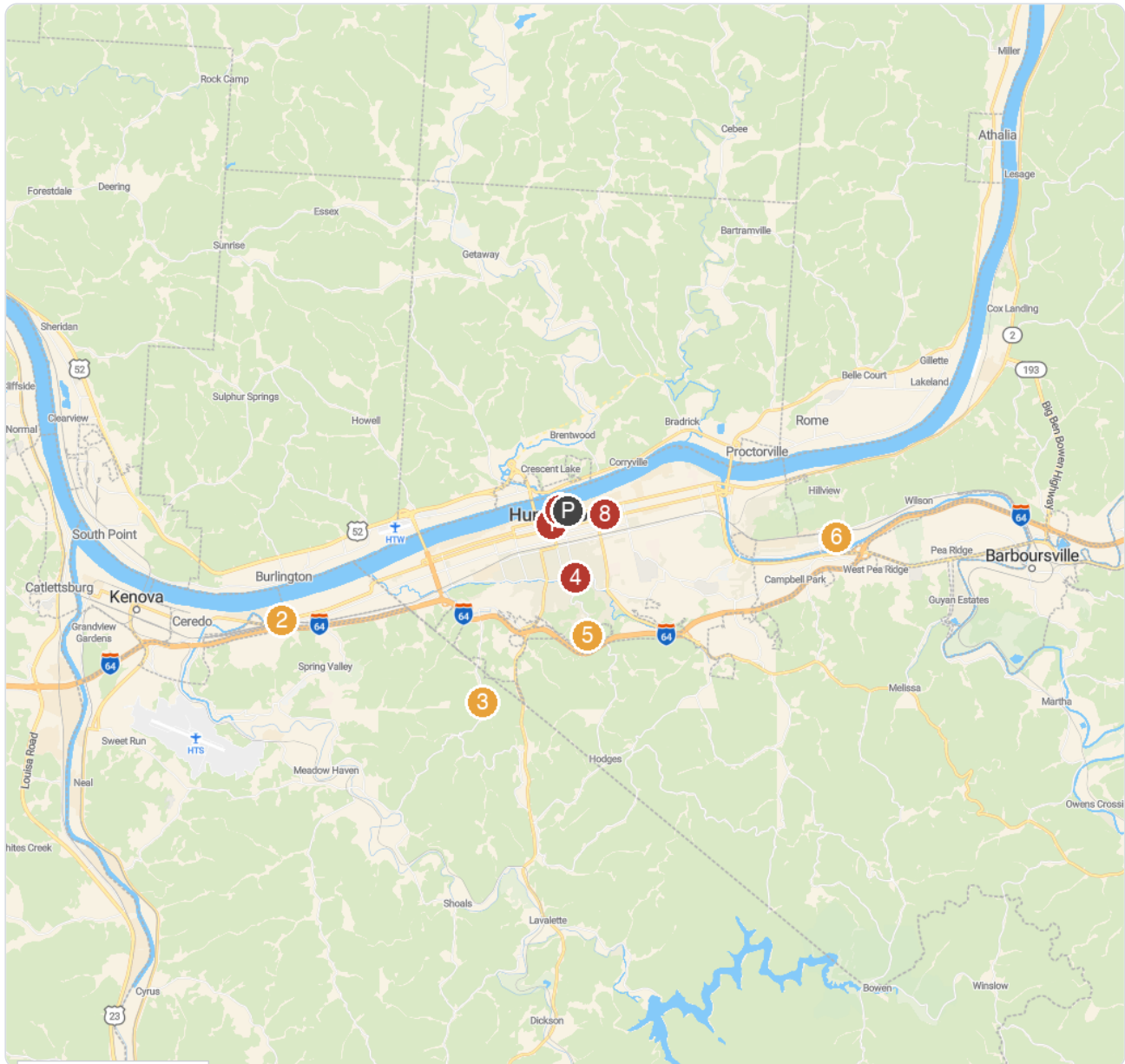
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Try the local hot dog. The Huntington-style hot dog — chili, coleslaw, mustard on a steamed bun — is a regional icon. Order it 'all the way' at any local diner.
- The floodwall gate is the only steep part. Once through, downtown is completely flat and easy to walk. No hills, no steep climbs.
