TOP THINGS TO DO

- JFK Hyannis Museum** — The John F.
 - Nantucket Ferry Day Trip** — Hy-Line Cruises runs a fast ferry (1 hr) from Hyannis Harbor to Nantucket.
 - Kennedy Compound Harbor Cruise** — The Kennedy Compound in Hyannis Port is not accessible by land, but
- local harbor cruises pass by water offering views...

 - Kalmus Beach** — A broad sandy beach on Nantucket Sound, a short ride from the harbor.
 - Main Street Stroll & Shopping** — Hyannis's Main Street runs parallel to the harbor and is lined with Cape Cod-style boutiques, art galleries, fudge...

BEST WALKS

- Harbor to Main Street Loop** 1.5 miles • Easy • 30-45 min — From the Ocean Street Dock, walk up Ocean Street past the Artist Shanties at Bismore Park, continue to the JFK Museum on Main Street...
- Waterfront & Veterans Memorial Park** 0.5 miles • Easy • 20 min — A short, pleasant walk from the dock along the harbor waterfront to Veterans Memorial Park, which has a small sandy beach, picnic...

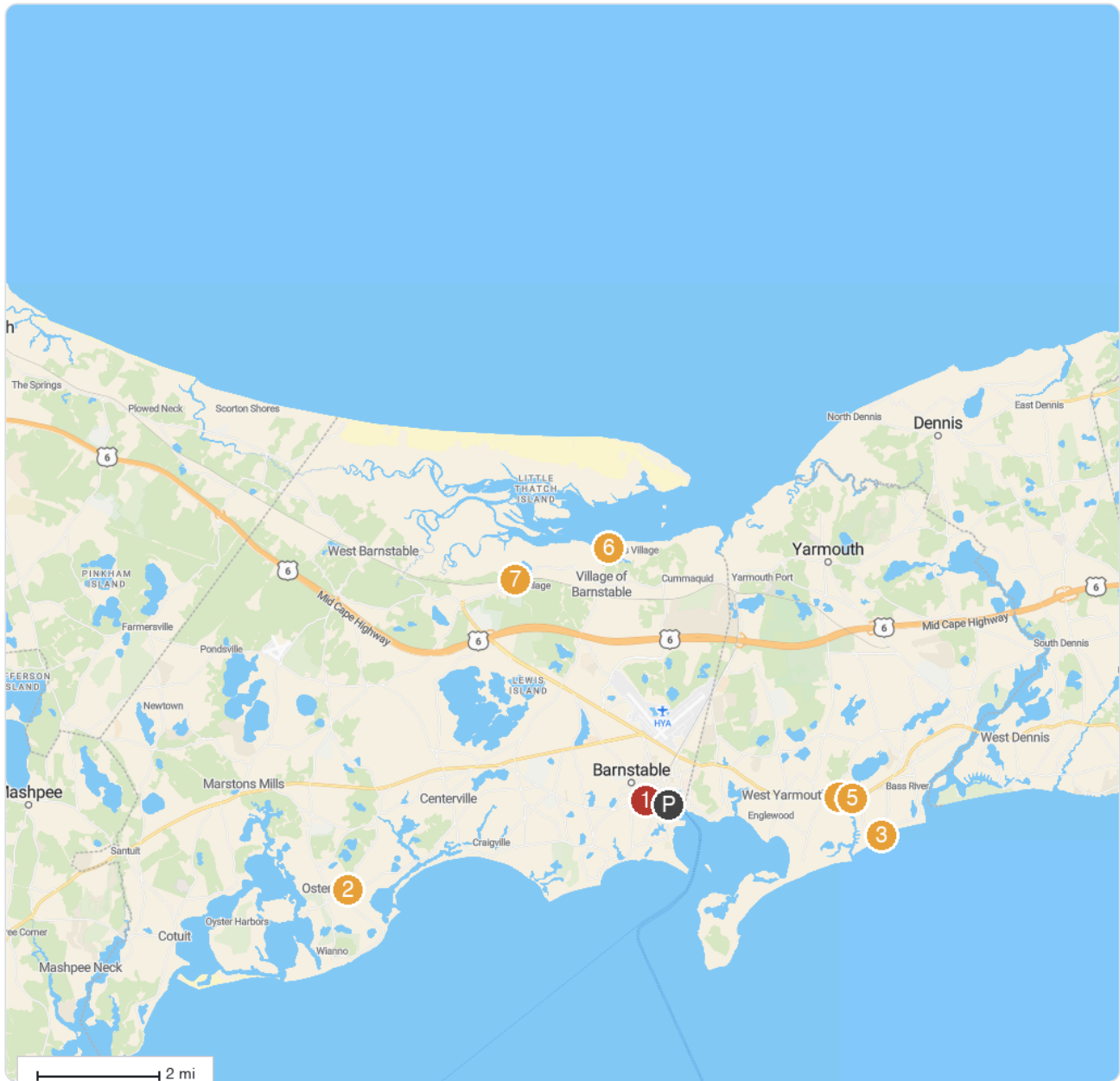
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- You can't walk to the Kennedy Compound. It's in private Hyannis Port, blocked to the public. The only view is from the water — book a harbor cruise or watch from your ship.
- Ferry to Nantucket is tempting but risky. Only attempt it if your ship gives you 6+ hours ashore and you confirm tender/last-return times. Missing the last tender is a real risk.
