GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier at Agios Kyrkos (capital); some calls use Evdilos (north coast)

Best For: Hot springs, off-the-beaten-path beaches, Blue Zone culture

Walk to center: 2–5 min from pier to Agios Kyrkos harbor square

Don't Miss: Free thermal springs at Lefkada rocks (2 km from port)

Getting around: **Taxi** €5–€10 · **Rideshare** not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Thermal Springs at Therma** — Soak in the municipal radioactive hot springs at the village of Therma, just 2 km east of the port.
 - **Seychelles Beach Hike** — Ikaria's most dramatic beach — white limestone cliffs, electric-blue water, and smooth white pebbles created by a...

- **Drakano Tower (Ancient Watchtower)** — The remains of a 4th-century BC military watchtower on Ikaria's eastern tip, overlooking Samos and the open Aegean.
 - **Afianes Winery & Pramnios Wine** — Taste Pramnios wine — the same wine praised by Homer — at a mountain winery that ferments in clay amphorae buried...
 - **Theoktistis Monastery** — A tiny chapel built entirely under a massive hollow boulder — one of Ikaria's most striking sights.

BEST WALKS

- **Harbor to Lefkada Thermal Rocks** 2 km each way | Easy flat road | ~25 min each way — Walk west along the coast road from the harbor to the Lefkada thermal springs, where hot mineral water naturally bubbles into the sea...
- **Agios Kyrkos Town Wander** 1-2 km loop | Very easy | ~30-40 min — Explore the amphitheater-like streets of the capital: the harbor monument to Icarus, the neoclassical buildings, the small...

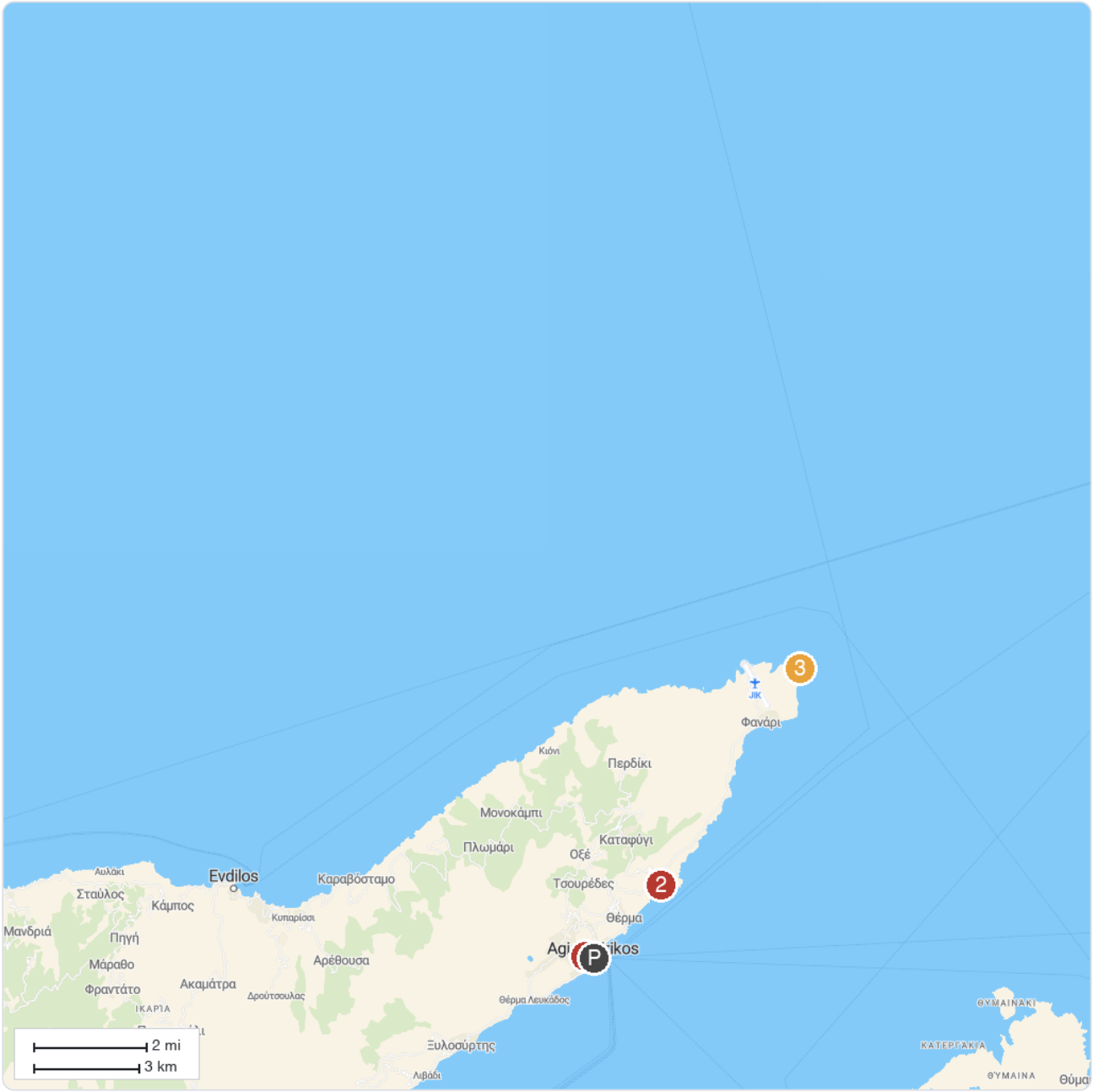
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Book taxis early. There are only ~30-40 taxis on the whole island. If you want to reach Seychelles Beach or any mountain village, arrange transport at the pier the moment you...
- Carry cash. Many small cafes, taxis, and beach access points are cash only. ATMs are in Agios Kyrkos center — use them early.
