BEST WALKS

- **Vila Historic Center & Pier Promenade** 1-2 hrs | Flat | Free — From the tender pier, stroll the cobblestone streets of Vila.
- **Pier to Praia do Saco da Capela** 15 min | Flat paved path | Free — A pleasant coastal walk north from the tender pier along a paved promenade lined with palm trees, moored sailboats, and casual kiosks.

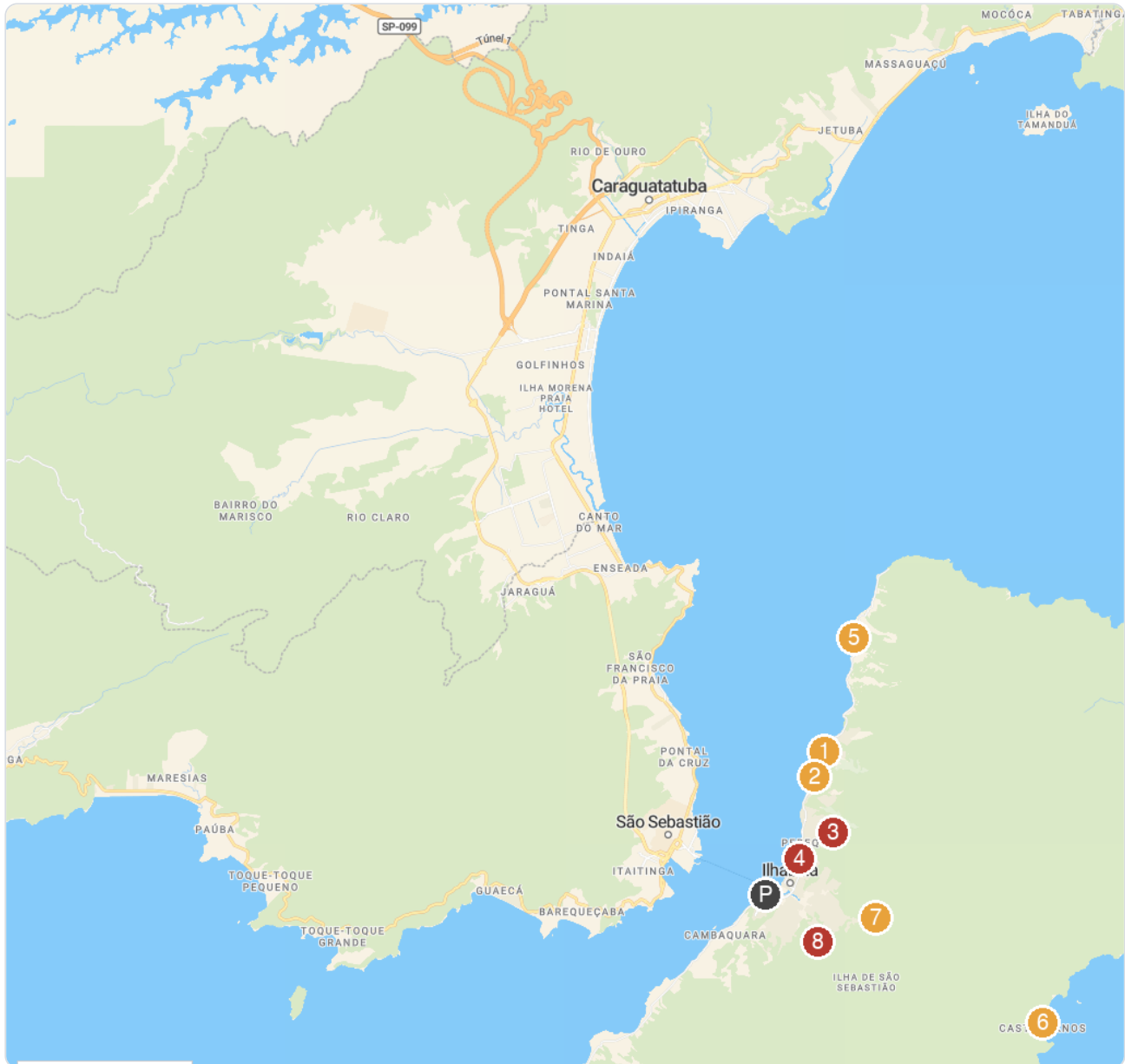
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Buy local insect repellent immediately. Ilhabela's tiny black gnats (borrachudos) bite hard and normal DEET doesn't stop them. Look for products with Icaridina or local citronella...
- Cards work almost everywhere. Visa and Mastercard are accepted at restaurants, shops, and beach clubs. Keep a small amount of BRL cash for bus fares, kiosk snacks, and tips.
