TOP THINGS TO DO

- Seoul Highlights: Palaces & Myeongdong** — The big draw for most passengers — take the subway or a ship tour to Gyeongbokgung Palace (Korea's grandest), wander...
- Incheon Chinatown & Songwol-dong Fairy Tale Village** — Korea's only official Chinatown — established in 1883 — is a colorful hillside neighborhood famous for Jajangmyeon...
- Sinpo International Market & Street Food** — Incheon's oldest traditional market is famous for Dakgangjeong — sweet, spicy, incredibly crunchy glazed chicken.
- Songdo Central Park & Smart City Walk** — Built from scratch on reclaimed sea, Songdo's Central Park features a seawater canal inspired by New York's Central...
- Gaehangjang Open Port & Colonial Architecture** — Adjacent to Chinatown, this preserved late-19th century district showcases Japanese and Western colonial-era buildings...

BEST WALKS

- Chinatown to Fairy Tale Village Loop** 1.5 km · 45 min · Easy — From Incheon Chinatown Gate, walk up the hill through colorful Chinese restaurants and murals, then cross into Songwol-dong Fairy Tale...
- Songdo Central Park Waterfront** 2 km · 40 min · Easy — Stroll the Songdo Central Park canal from the Tri-Bowl pavilion along the seawater waterway, watching water taxis glide past sleek...

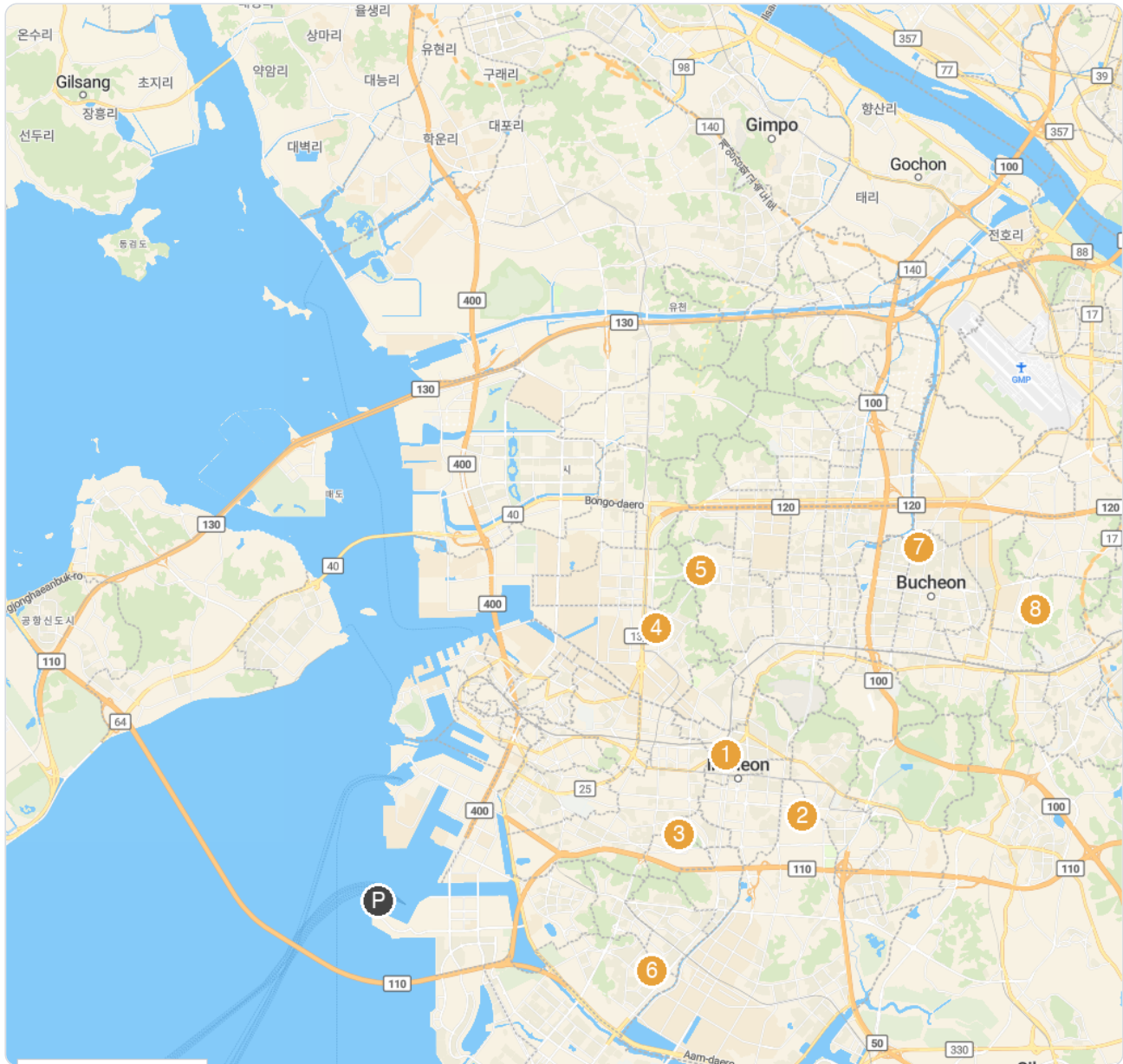
