TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Loch Ness & Urquhart Castle** — The dark, deep loch that holds Scotland's greatest mystery.
 - **Culloden Battlefield & Clava Cairns** — The moorland where the Jacobite rising ended in 1746.
 - **Dunrobin Castle & Falconry** — One of Britain's oldest continually inhabited houses, styled like a French château
- with spectacular gardens overlooking...

 - **Glenmorangie Distillery Tour & Tasting** — One of Scotland's most celebrated single malts is distilled in Tain, just 15 minutes north of the port.
 - **Cawdor Castle & Gardens** — A beautifully preserved 14th/15th-century castle still lived in by the Cawdor family, with Shakespeare's Macbeth...

BEST WALKS

- **Invergordon Mural Trail** 1-2 hrs · Easy · Free — Numerous large professionally painted murals cover the sides of buildings throughout town, depicting everything from the Viking era to...
- **Saltburn Woodland & Shore Walk** 1.5-2 hrs · Easy · Free — Head east along the Cromarty Firth shoreline to the village of Saltburn.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Layer up, always. Highland weather is famously unpredictable — four seasons in one day is not a myth. Bring a waterproof jacket even if it looks sunny when you step ashore.
- Book taxis and private tours early. Invergordon is a small town. Independent local taxis and minibus tours sell out months in advance during peak season (May–September).
