No roads reach this place — just sea, mountains, and silence. Inverie is mainland Britain's last true wilderness, where expedition ships anchor in Loch Nevis and passengers step ashore into a community that runs entirely on its own terms.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor in Loch Nevis; tenders land at Inverie Pier

Best For: Wild hiking, wildlife watching, off-grid atmosphere, historic pub

Walk to village: 3–5 min from the pier to pub, tearoom, and community shop

Don't Miss: The Old Forge — Guinness-certified mainland Britain's most remote pub

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Knoydart Ranger Guided Walk** — Join a Knoydart Foundation ranger for a guided walk through the peninsula's ancient woodland and open hillside.
- Otter & Seal Spotting on Loch Nevis** — Otters are regularly seen playing around the pier and rocky foreshore.
- Hike to the Brocket Monument** — A strenuous hill walk leads up over the hills behind Inverie to the towering stone cross erected in the 1930s by Lord...
- Knoydart Brewery Tour & Tasting** — One of Britain's most remote craft breweries operates out of a converted chapel.
- Land Raiders Monument & Community Story** — A short walk from the pier stands the cairn commemorating the 1948 Land Raiders — seven local men who defied an...

BEST WALKS

- Village Foreshore Stroll** 1.5 km | 30 min | Easy | Flat paved track — Walk east from the pier along the single-track road through the village to Long Beach, passing The Old Forge, the community shop, and...
- Brocket Monument Hill Walk** ~10 km return | ~5 hrs | Strenuous | Rough boggy hill path — From the village, head up over the hills behind Inverie to the Brocket Monument, a tall stone cross built by Lord Brocket.
