GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender only — ships anchor in the bay; Zodiacs ferry passengers to Muelle El Embarcadero pier

Best For: Wildlife encounters, snorkeling, giant tortoises, volcanic hiking, and desert-island beaches

Walk to center: 10–15 min walk (0.8 mi / 1.2 km) from the pier along boardwalk and sandy road; pickup trucks available (\$2–3)

Don't Miss: Concha de Perla snorkeling lagoon (free, 2 min from pier) and Arnaldo Tupiza Tortoise Breeding Center

Getting around: **Taxi** \$1–\$2 per person · **Rideshare** not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Concha de Perla Snorkeling** — A crystal-clear natural mangrove lagoon just two minutes from the pier — free to enter and arguably the best...
 - Arnaldo Tupiza Giant Tortoise Breeding Center** — Walk the flamingo estuary boardwalk to this conservation facility where you can see giant tortoises at every life stage...
- Los Túneles Snorkeling (The Tunnels)** — Ancient lava flows have formed underwater arches and bridges teeming with white-tip reef sharks, giant manta rays...
 - Las Tintoreras Islet** — A short 10-minute boat ride from the pier leads to this rocky islet where white-tip reef sharks rest in a narrow lava...
 - Sierra Negra Volcano Hike** — A challenging 10-mile round-trip hike to one of the world's largest volcanic calderas.

BEST WALKS

- Pier to Town & Flamingo Estuary** 2.5 miles round-trip · 1-1.5 hrs · Easy · Free — Walk from the pier past Concha de Perla snorkeling lagoon (worth the 2-minute detour), through town along Avenida Antonio Gil, then...
- Bike to the Wall of Tears** 7 miles round-trip · 2-3 hrs · Easy cycling · Bike rental ~\$15 — Rent a bicycle in town and follow the sandy road west past Playa Grande beach, through dry forest and mangroves, watching for giant...
