- Tsunami Memorial Sites** — Visit Kadonowaki Elementary School — preserved largely as found after the 2011 tsunami — and the Minamihama Tsunami...
- San Juan Bautista Museum** — The Sant Juan Kan museum tells the story of the 17th-century galleon built near Ishinomaki under Date Masamune, which...
- Hiyori-yama Park** — Climb the hill where Ishinomaki Castle once stood for panoramic views over the Kitakami River estuary and the rebuilt...
- Tashirojima (Cat Island)** — A short ferry ride from Ishinomaki brings you to this small island famous for its thriving feral cat population and the...

BEST WALKS

- Manga Road to the Museum** ~1 km one-way · 20-30 min · Flat — Walk from Ishinomaki Station along the character-statue-lined Manga Road to the Ishinomori Manga Museum on its river island.
- Hiyori-yama Park Viewpoint** 20 min from station · Moderate hill · Great views — From the city center, head south up the hill to Hiyori-yama Park for sweeping views over the Kitakami River estuary and the rebuilt...

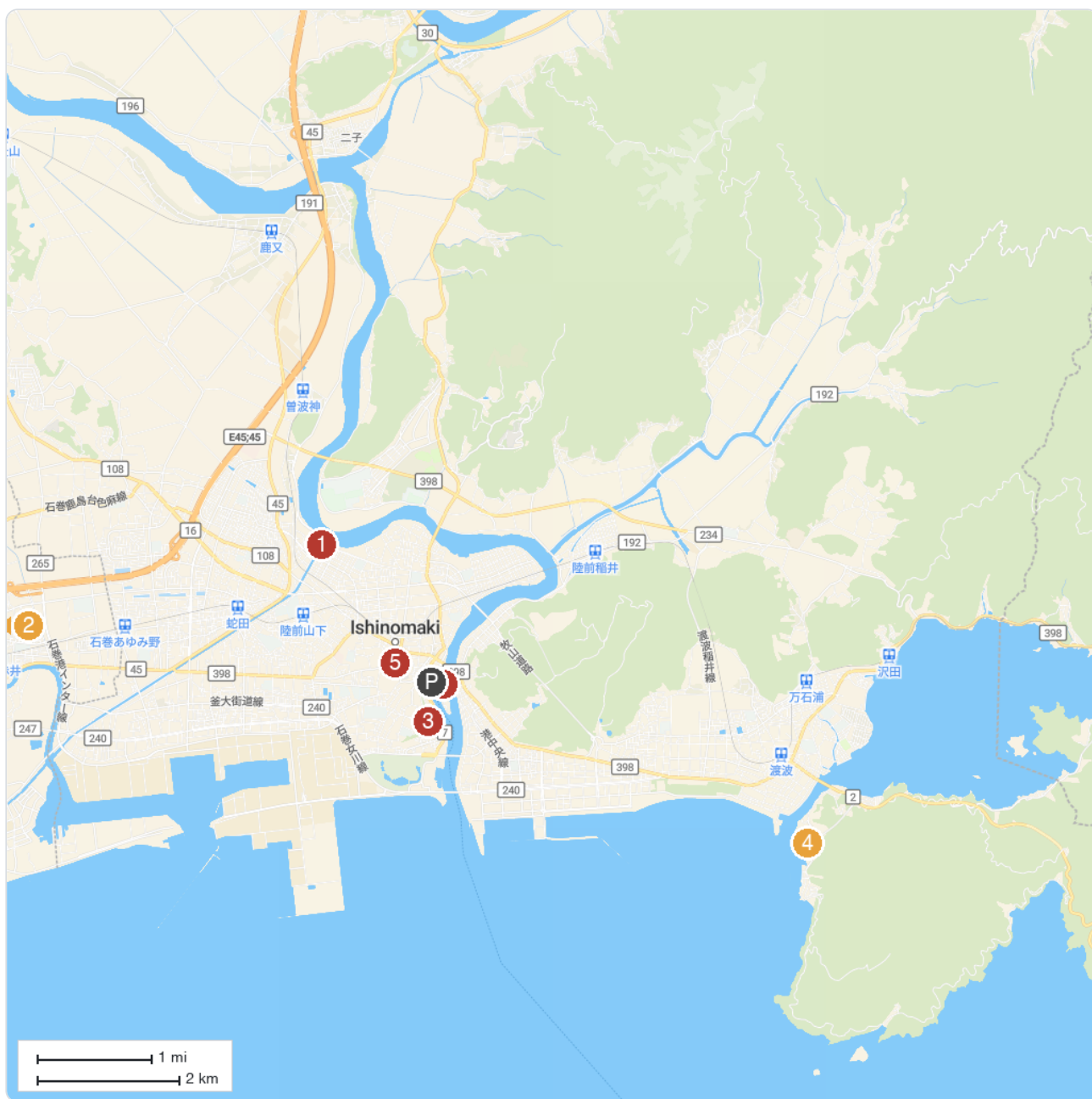
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
