Docking: Tender — ships anchor in Brodick Bay; tender to Brodick Ferry Terminal pontoon

Best For: Scenic walks, whisky distillery tours, Brodick Castle, prehistoric standing stones

Walk to Centre: 5-10 min flat walk from tender pontoon to Brodick village shops & cafes

Don't Miss: Arran Cheese Shop and a dram of Arran Single Malt before re-boarding

- Brodick Castle & Country Park** — A dramatic red-sandstone baronial castle (National Trust for Scotland) packed with antiques and art, surrounded by...
 - Arran Single Malt Distillery Tour (Lochranza)** — The Isle of Arran Distillery in the scenic north produces award-winning unpeated single malt whisky.
 - Machrie Moor Standing Stones** — Six Neolithic and Bronze Age stone circles on an atmospheric moorland plateau —

 - Kildonan Beach & Seal Colony** — A sandy south-coast beach famous for its resident harbour seals, which can almost always be spotted basking on offshore...
 - Goatfell Summit Hike** — Arran's highest peak at 874m (2,867ft) offers panoramic views across the Firth of Clyde to the Scottish mainland — and...

BEST WALKS

- Fisherman's Walk: Brodick to Brodick Castle** 2 miles one way · Flat · ~40-50 min · Free — The best walk from the tender pontoon.
- Glen Rosa Valley Walk** 2-4 miles · Easy to moderate · 1.5-2.5 hrs — A classic Scottish glaciated glen walk starting about 30 minutes on foot from Brodick village.

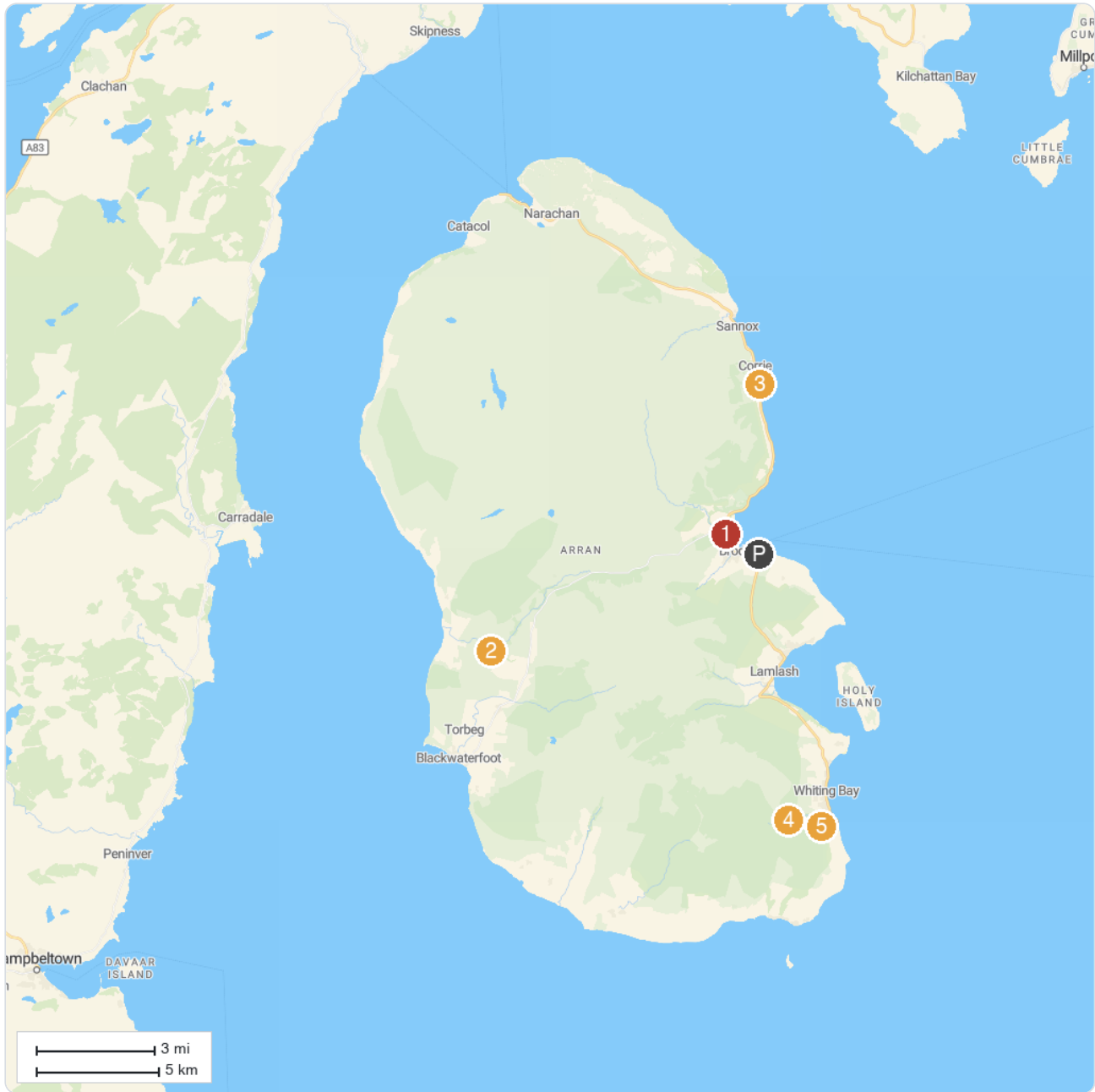
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

2 Machrie Moor Standing Stones Ancient stone circles on a moor, dating back millennia.

4 Eas a' Chrannaig A beautiful, cascading waterfall hidden in a scenic glen.
