GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender to Ardminish pier — no cruise berth

Walk to centre: Ardminish village is right at the pier; Achamore Gardens ~20 min

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Achamore Gardens** — A celebrated west-coast island garden established in 1944 by Sir James Horlick, growing rhododendrons, camellias, New...
- **Twin Beaches (An Dòirlinn)** — Two white-sand coves either side of a narrow tombolo linking Gigha to the islet of Eilean Garbh — turquoise water, no...
- **Kilchattan Chapel & Standing Stones** — The ruins of a 13th-century chapel sit uphill near Ardminish, with the inscribed Ogham Stone just to its west.
- **Kayak & Paddleboard Hire** — Gigha Boats and Activity Centre rents kayaks, paddleboards, wetsuits, and snorkels.
- **Wildlife Walk** — Otters, seals, red deer, and a variety of seabirds are regulars on Gigha.

BEST WALKS

- **Ardminish to Achamore Gardens** 1.5 miles · ~20 min · Easy — Follow the single-track road south from the pier through Ardminish village and into the gardens.
- **Village to Twin Beaches** ~5 miles · ~1.5–2 hrs · Long (bike recommended) — Head north from the pier along the island's single main road to the northern end, then take the signed path west to An Dòirlinn.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Watch the tender schedule. The ship will not delay departure for late tenders. Gigha has no comms office — know your last tender time before you leave the pier.
- Bring cash. There is no ATM on the island. GBP notes are useful for garden admission (~£8 honesty box), the Wee Isle Cafe, and bike hire.
